## **Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Sha Tin**

Notice is hereby given that the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm on 8 November 2015 (Sun), 15 November 2015 (Sun) and 22 November 2015 (Sun) daily to facilitate the road works:

## (a) <u>Road and Lane Closure</u>

During the above period, the following road and lane sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (i) Yat Tai Street;
- (ii) a traffic lane of Sha Kok Street westbound near Yat Tai Street; and
- (iii) a traffic lane of Shui Chuen Au Street northbound near Yat Tai Street.
- (b) <u>Banning of Turning Movement</u>
  - (i) During the above period, all vehicles will be prohibited from turning right from Sha Kok Street eastbound onto Yat Tai Street; and
  - (ii) During the above period, all vehicles will be prohibited from turning left from Sha Kok Street westbound onto Yat Tai Street.
- (c) <u>Temporary Transport Arrangement</u>
  - During the above period, KMB route no. 288 and GMB route no. 812 on its journey to Shui Chuen O will be diverted via Tai Chung Kiu Road eastbound, Sha Tin Wai Road southbound, Sha Kok Street westbound and Shui Chuen Au Street southbound before resuming its original routing;
  - (ii) During the above period, the terminal point of LW route no. E42 will be relocated to Sha Kok Street westbound near Sha Tin Wai Station, and LW route no. E42 will be diverted via Sha Kok Street westbound, Jat Ming Chuen Street, Sha Kok Street eastbound before resuming its original routing; and
  - (iii) During the above period, LW route no. E42 on its journey to the Pok Hong will be diverted via Sha Tin Wai Road southbound and Sha Kok Street westbound, and terminate at Sha Kok Street westbound near Sha Tin Wai Station; and
  - (iv) During the above period, the terminal point of KMB route no. 287X will be relocated to Sha Kok Street eastbound near Sha Kok Community Hall.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. Public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary transport arrangements.
