

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Central

Notice is hereby given that, to facilitate holding of an event, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from 6.00 pm on 23 November 2017 to 11.59 pm on 25 November 2017 in Central:

(A) Traffic Arrangements

I. Road Closure

- (a) Lan Kwai Fong Pedestrian Precinct will be implemented from 7.00 pm to 5.00 am of the following day on 23 November 2017; and
- (b) The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic between 6.00 pm and 11.59 pm daily from 23 November 2017 to 25 November 2017:
 - (i) the western layby of Edinburgh Place west of Star Ferry Multi-storey Car Park;
 - (ii) part of the eastern and western pick-up / drop-off and loading / unloading area in Bank Street; and
 - (iii) the layby outside Man Mo Temple on Hollywood Road.

II. Suspension of On-street Metered Parking Spaces

The on-street metered parking spaces No. 3634A and No. 3634B on Hollywood Road outside Man Mo Temple will be suspended between 6.00 pm and 11.59 pm daily from 23 November 2017 to 25 November 2017.

III. Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand on the northern Edinburgh Place west of Star Ferry Multi-storey Car Park will be suspended between 6.00 pm and 11.59 pm daily from 23 November 2017 to 25 November 2017.

IV. Suspension and Relocation of Bus Stop

The bus stop of NWFB route nos. 26 and H1 outside Man Mo Temple, Hollywood Road will be suspended and temporarily relocated about 30 metres westward to outside 157 – 163 Hollywood Road between 6.00 pm and 11.59 pm daily from 23 November 2017 to 25 November 2017.

(B) Removal of Illegal Parking Vehicles

Any vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic

arrangements specified above will be towed away by the Police without prior notice.

(C) Enforcement and Appeals

- I. Appropriate traffic signs will be provided on-site to guide motorists.
- II. Bus companies will display notices to advise passengers of the above public transport arrangements.
- III. Actual implementation of the above road closures, traffic and bus diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on conditions in the area.
- IV. Motorists should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion, and take heed of instruction of the Police.
