

TRAFFIC ADVICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Rehearsal of Flag Raising Ceremony for the 19th Anniversary of the Establishment of HKSAR

Members of the public are advised that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in the vicinity of Wan Chai North on 30 June 2016 (Thursday) to facilitate the rehearsal of flag raising ceremony for the 19th anniversary of the establishment of HKSAR:

A. Special Traffic Arrangement:

Expo Drive East will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic from about 6.00 am to 12.30 pm.

B. Special Transport Arrangements:

(i) Suspension of bus terminus and temporary bus service arrangements

- (a) The bus terminus at Expo Drive East will be suspended from about 6.00 am to 12.30 pm;
- (b) During the period of suspension of bus terminus, Citybus Route no. 25A, Cross Harbour Routes nos. 961 and 961P will omit Expo Drive East, terminate at and depart from Wan Chai North Temporary Public Transport Interchange. The bus stop at Fleming Road northbound outside Renaissance Harbour View Hotel will also be suspended and temporary bus stops will be designated on Convention Avenue outside and opposite to Wan Chai Ferry Pier respectively ; and
- (c) During the period of suspension of bus terminus, NWFB Route no. H1 will omit Expo Drive and Expo Drive East and the bus stops thereat will also be suspended.

(ii) Suspension of taxi stand and coach parking spaces

- (a) The taxi stand at Expo Drive will be suspended from about 6.45 am to 12.30 pm; and
- (b) The coach parking spaces at Expo Drive East will be suspended from about 6.00 am to 12.30 pm.

Notices will be displayed by bus companies to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements. In addition, motorists are advised to be patient when driving at the vicinity of the above area and follow Police's instruction, and watch out for the latest traffic news through the media.
