

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Tai Wai

Motorists are advised that to facilitate the Tai Wai Ta Chiu Event, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented during the following periods:

Stage I – From 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm on 25 November 2017; from 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm on 26 November 2017; and from 6:45 pm to 8:15 pm on 29 November 2017

a) Lane closure

During the above period, the following traffic lanes will be intermittently closed:

- (i) Some traffic lanes of Tai Wai Road northbound;
- (ii) Some traffic lanes of Chik Chuen Street eastbound;
- (iii) Some traffic lanes of Shing Ho Road southbound;
- (iv) Some traffic lanes of Chik Fuk Street southbound;
- (v) Some traffic lanes of Chik Luk Lane southbound; and
- (vi) Some traffic lanes of Tsuen Nam Road westbound between Tai Wai Road and Chik Luk Lane.

Stage II – From 8:30 am to 2:00 pm on 26 November 2017

a) Road closure

During the above period, the section of Chik Fuk Street near T.W.G. Hs. Sin Chu Wan Primary School will be closed to all vehicular traffic.

b) Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Chik Fuk Street southbound heading for Chik Luk Lane will be diverted via Shing Ho Road southbound, Chik Shun Street westbound, Chik Fu Street southbound, Chik Fuk Street eastbound and Chik Luk Lane; and
- (ii) Vehicles on Chik Fuk Street northbound heading for Chik Shun Street will be diverted via Chik Luk Lane southbound, Tsuen Nam Road westbound, Tai Wai Road northbound, Chik Chuen Street eastbound, Shing Ho Road southbound and Chik Shun Street.

c) Temporary Transport Arrangements

During the above period, NT GMB Route Nos. 63K, 63A and 63B on its journey to Tai Wai Station will be diverted via Mei Tin Road southbound, Chik Fai Street eastbound, Tai Wai Road southbound, Chik Fuk Street eastbound and Chik Luk Lane southbound before resuming to its original routeing.

Actual implementation of the road closure and public transport diversions may be adjusted by the Police at the time depending on the prevailing circumstances, traffic and crowd conditions in the areas. Notices will be put up by public transport operators to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.
