### Public Transport Arrangement for Opening of Hoi Tat Public Transport Interchange

Members of the public are advised that the Hoi Tat Public Transport Interchange, which is located in Hoi Tat Estate, Sham Shui Po, will commence operation at 5.00 am on 23 April 2023 (Sunday) and implement the following public transport arrangements:

CTB Route No. 79X (to/from Queens Hill)	Relocating the terminating point from Sham Mong Road opposite Ying Wa College to Hoi Tat Public Transport Interchange
NWFB Route No. 795 (to/from Tseung Kwan O Industrial Estate)	
NWFB Route No. 795P (to/from Tseung Kwan O Industrial Estate)	
GMB Route No. 75C (to/from Sham Shui Po (Kweilin Street))	
GMB Route No. 75M (to/from Cheung Sha Wan (Castle Peak Road))	

The terminating point or bus stop at Cheung Sha Wan (Sham Mong Road) Temporary Bus Terminus for Cross Harbour Route Nos. 118, 118P and N118 (to/from Siu Sai Wan (Island Resort)); and KMB Route No. 296C (Cheung Sha Wan (Hoi Ying Estate) bound) will remain unchanged.
