Transport Department Notice

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for a Concert in Kai Tak

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate the holding of a concert in Kai Tak, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from 21 January 2017 to 22 January 2017:-

I. Special Traffic Arrangements

(A) Road Closures and Traffic Diversions

The following road closures and traffic diversions will be implemented on 21 and 22 January 2017 respectively at the same times specified below:

Phase 1: From 11:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.

(a) Traffic Re-routeing

- (i) Lam Chak Street will be converted from one-way westbound to one-way eastbound; and
- (ii) Kai Hing Road between Hoi Bun Road and Lam Chak Street will be converted from one-way southbound to one-way northbound.

(b) Road Closures

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicles except permitted vehicles:

- (i) Hoi Bun Road westbound between Shun Yip Street and Kai Hing Road;
- (ii) Kai Hing Road to the south of Lam Chak Street (except vehicles access to Kerry D. G. Warehouse (Kowloon Bay)); and
- (iii) The unnamed road leading to Kai Tak Runway Park.

(c) Traffic Diversions

- (i) Vehicles on Hoi Bun Road eastbound will be prohibited from turning right onto Kai Hing Road southbound;
- (ii) Vehicles on Hoi Bun Road westbound will be prohibited from going straight along Hoi Bun Road westbound at its junction with Shun Yip Street; and
- (iii) Vehicles on Hoi Bun Road westbound heading to Kowloon Bay will be diverted to Shun Yip Street northbound.

Phase 2: From 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(a) Road Closures

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicles except taxis, franchised buses, green minibuses and permitted vehicles:

- (i) Cheung Yip Street (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) between Lam Chak Street and Shing Cheong Road;
- (ii) Shing Cheong Road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound);
- (iii) the unnamed road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) connecting Shing Cheong Road and Shing Fung Road; and
- (iv) Shing Fung Road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound).

(b) Traffic Diversions

Vehicles on Cheung Yip Street (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) will be diverted via Lam Chak Street eastbound and Kai Hing Road northbound.

Phase 3: From 2:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

(a) Road Closures

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicles except franchised buses, green minibuses and permitted vehicles:

- (i) Cheung Yip Street (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) between Lam Chak Street and Shing Cheong Road;
- (ii) Shing Cheong Road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound);
- (iii) the unnamed road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) connecting Shing Cheong Road and Shing Fung Road; and
- (iv) Shing Fung Road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound).

(b) <u>Traffic Diversions</u>

Vehicles on Cheung Yip Street (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) will be diverted via Lam Chak Street eastbound and Kai Hing Road northbound.

Phase 4: From 6:30 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.

(a) Road Closures

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicles except taxis, franchised buses, green minibuses and permitted vehicles:

- (i) Cheung Yip Street (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) between Lam Chak Street and Shing Cheong Road;
- (ii) Shing Cheong Road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound);
- (iii) the unnamed road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) connecting Shing Cheong Road and Shing Fung Road; and
- (iv) Shing Fung Road (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound).

(b) <u>Traffic Diversions</u>

Vehicles on Cheung Yip Street (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal bound) will be diverted via Lam Chak Street eastbound and Kai Hing Road northbound.

(B) Temporary Private Car Drop Off Point

A private car drop off point will be temporarily designated at Lam Chak Street from 11:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on 21 January 2017 and from 11:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on 22 January 2017.

(C) Temporary Taxi Drop Off Point

A taxi drop off point will be temporarily designated at Kai Hing Road from 11:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on 21 January 2017 and from 11:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on 22 January 2017.

(D) Temporary Shuttle Bus Drop Off Point

A shuttle bus drop off point will be temporarily designated at the unnamed road leading to Kai Tak Runway Park outside the venue from 11:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on 21 January 2017 and from 11:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on 22 January 2017.

(E) Suspension of Parking Spaces

All goods vehicle parking spaces on Lam Chak Street will be suspended from 8:00 p.m. on 20 January 2017 to 11:59 p.m. on 22 January 2017.

II. Special Transport Arrangements

Free shuttle bus and ferry services (for ticket holders only) will be provided at the times specified below:

(A) Free Shuttle Bus (for ticket holders only)

The following free shuttle bus route services will be operated on 21 January 2017 and 22 January 2017 respectively at the times specified below:

The service level of the above free shuttle ferry services may be adjusted subject to passenger demand.

(C) Special Bus Services

The service level of KMB Route No. 5R (Kai Tak Cruise Terminal to Ngau Tau Kok Station (Circular)) may be adjusted subject to the passenger demand during the event period.

(D) **Bus Services Arrangements**

(a) Re-location of Bus Stop

The bus stop of KMB Route No. 15A (Tsz Wan Shan (North)) at Hoi Bun Road westbound near Shun Yip Street will be temporarily re-located to Wai Yip Street westbound near Shun Yip Street during its whole day operation from 21 January 2017 to 22 January 2017.

(b) <u>Bus Diversion</u>

In connection with the above road closures, KMB Route No. 15A (Tsz Wan Shan (North) bound) will be diverted to route via Hoi Bun Road westbound, Shun Yip Street northbound, Wai Yip Street westbound, Sheung Yee Street westbound and Wang Chiu Road northbound before resuming to its normal routeing during its whole day operation from 21 January 2017 to 22 January 2017.

(E) Green Minibus (GMB) Arrangements

(a) Re-location of GMB Stop

The stop of Kowloon GMB Route No. 68 (Choi Wan Estate - Kowloon Bay (Circular)) at Hoi Bun Road westbound near Pacific Trade Centre will be temporarily re-located to Wai Yip Street westbound near Shun Yip Street during its whole day operation from 21 January 2017 to 22 January 2017.

(b) GMB Diversion

In connection with the road closures, Kowloon GMB Route No. 68 (Kowloon Bay bound) will be diverted to route via Hoi Bun Road westbound, Shun Yip Street northbound, Wai Yip Street westbound, Sheung Yee Street westbound and Wang Chiu Road northbound before resuming to its normal routeing during its whole day operation from 21 January 2017 to 22 January 2017.

III. Attention and Appeal

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. Public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements. Motorists are advised that any vehicles found illegally parked within the precincts of the above affected areas will be towed away without prior notice. Actual implementation of the road closure, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on the prevailing circumstances, traffic and crowd conditions in the areas.

Concert participants are advised to use the free shuttle bus and ferry services provided by the organizer (For details please visit: https://elf-asia.eventbrite.com). Members of the public please call 1823 or visit Transport Department web-page www.td.gov.hk to obtain the details of the special traffic and transport arrangements.

At the same time, members of the public should pay attention to the road closures, traffic diversions and special transport arrangements in the above areas at Kai Tak and Kowloon Bay. They are advised

to plan their journey early and allow more travelling time to cater for unexpected delay. Members of the public should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion, take heed of instruction of the Police and watch out for the latest traffic news through media. Public transport commuters should pay attention to the arrangements of route diversions and suspension of stops. Motorists are advised to avoid driving to the above affected areas.

Taxi and public light bus drivers who will go to Cheung Yip Street for refilling are advised to take note of the road closures and traffic diversion arrangements implemented surrounding that area.
