Replacement of Operator and Fare Revision

Members of the public are advised that the N.T. GMB Route Nos. 65A, 65K, 65S, 66K, 67A and 67K will be taken over by a new operator, Easywell Industrial Limited (“Easywell”), on 1 April 2017 (Saturday). The operational arrangements (including the routing, boarding and alighting points, operating hours, frequency and full fares) of the above routes are in general remain unchanged. Besides, Easywell will offer the following fare concessions :

Concession for the elderly, eligible persons with disabilities & students

1. Easywell will join the Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities, concessionary fare of \$2 per trip will be offered to beneficiaries;
2. Free ride will be offered to the elderly aged 65 or above using Elder Octopus on the first Sunday of the month (until 3 September 2017);
3. Half fare will be offered to students using Student Octopus and paying **full fare** (until 30 September 2017);

Section Fare Concessions

4. Routes 65A & 65K
 - Two-way section fare of \$2.6 will be offered to the journey between Wong Nai Tau and Siu Lek Yuen Road Bowling Green;
5. Route 65S
 - New section fare of \$3.3 will be offered to the journey from Siu Lek Yuen Road Bowling Green to Wong Nai Tau;
6. Route 67K
 - Two-way section fare of \$3.1 will be offered to the journey between Sha Tin Hospital and A Kung Kok Shan; and
 - Two-way section fare of \$3.1 will be offered to the journey between Sha Tin Station and Tai Chung Kiu Road Ravana Garden.

The new operator will put up notices at major stops to advise passengers of the operation details.
