

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Tsim Sha Tsui on 30 August 2015

Members of the public are advised in order to facilitate the holding of a parade in Tsim Sha Tsui, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from around 9.30am to 11.30am on 30 August 2015 (Sunday) :-

I. Parade Route

The parade (around 700 participants) will follow the routeing below:-

Kowloon Park (Starting Point), Haiphong Road eastbound, Canton Road southbound, Salisury Road eastbound, Nathan Road northbound, Haiphong Road eastbound , Kowloon Park (Finishing point)

II. Temporary Lane/Road Closures

Traffic lanes on the following road sections will be intermittently closed by phases:

- (i) All lanes of Haiphong Road eastbound between Nathan Road and Canton Road;
- (ii) The slow and middle lanes of Canton Road southbound between Haiphong Road and Salisbury Road;
- (iii) The slow and middle lanes of Salisbury Road eastbound between Canton Road and Nathan Road; and
- (iv) All lanes of Nathan Road northbound between Salisbury Road and Haiphong Road.

III. Temporary Bus Diversion and Relocation of Bus Terminus

A total of 29 bus routes will be temporarily diverted as follows: -

IV. Green Minibus Diversion

A total of 7 GMB routes will be temporarily diverted as follows: -

6 and 6A	convert to a circular route via Canton Road northbound and Austin Road.

Attention and Appeal

Actual implementation of the road closure, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by police officers on site at the time depending on the traffic and crowd situation. Notices will be displayed by the public transport operators at the affected stops in advance to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.

Members of the public who plan to go to the affected area are advised to plan their journey early, use alternative routes, and allow more traveling time to cater for unexpected delay. Motorists are also advised to avoid driving to the affected areas. Members of the public planning to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport as far as possible. They should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion, take heed of instruction given by the Police; and watch out for the latest traffic news broadcasts by the media.
