When approaching a zebra crossing,

motorists should look out for pedestrians waiting to cross,

particularly children, the elderly and the disabled.

Motorists should be ready to slow down and stop behind the "Give way" line.

They must give way to anyone who has stepped onto a zebra crossing.

As for pedestrians, before they cross,

they should allow motorists plenty of time to see them, slow down their vehicles and stop. When necessary,

pedestrians should put a small step on the zebra crossing

and ensure the traffic has completely stopped before starting to cross.

Both motorists and pedestrians should always

be attentive, patient and law-abiding

and work together to reduce the risk of traffic accidents.
