

Important Notice

This Department received the Police's notification that its investigation has revealed that there are swindlers imitating to be insurance agent and selling fake motor vehicle third party risks insurance policies through advertisements on the internet. According to the Police's preliminary investigation, swindlers would fabricate motor vehicle insurance policies of different insurance companies, and those have been revealed so far include **China Ping An Insurance (Hong Kong) Limited (Hotline: 2827 1883)**, **Direct Asia Insurance (Hong Kong) Limited (Hotline: 2884 8888)**, **QBE HongKong & Shanghai Insurance Limited (Hotline: 2877 8488)**, **Tokio Marine and Fire Insurance Company (Hong Kong) Limited (Hotline: 2529 4401)** and **Zurich Insurance Company Limited (Hotline: 2968 2222)**. Some policies also involved a "**Lip Shing Insurance Brokers Limited**".

If you have any doubts about the insurance cover that you have purchased for your vehicle, you should contact and confirm with the relevant insurer direct for verification immediately.

Please note that according to the Motor Vehicles Insurance (Third Party Risks) Ordinance, Cap 272, any person (including the registered vehicle owner) has the responsibility of ensuring the presence of a valid third party risks insurance policy for the vehicle concerned whilst using it on roads.

If a vehicle is used on a road without a valid third party risks insurance, the persons concerned (including the registered vehicle owner) commit an offence and are liable to a fine of \$10,000 and to imprisonment for 12 months, and will also be disqualified from holding or obtaining a driving licence (for a period of 12 months to 3 years). The Commissioner for Transport may also refuse to license the vehicle concerned or cancel the vehicle licence concerned in accordance with the Road Traffic Ordinance, Cap 374.

Please ensure that your vehicle has valid third party risks insurance whilst being used on roads.

Notes for Attention

1. The Cross Boundary Unit of Transport Department is responsible for handling applications for the Ad Hoc Quotas for Cross Boundary Private Cars and Closed Road Permit (CRP).
2. Applicants must reserve a quota through Internet or by phone before submitting the Application for Ad Hoc Quotas for Cross Boundary Private Cars and CRP (“the Application”) through Internet or by post or delivery to the following address: **Room 1032, 10/F, Harbour Building, 38 Pier Road, Central, Hong Kong.**
3. The Application must be submitted within 5 calendar days of quota reservation (the day of reservation is also counted as 1 day). Late or incomplete applications will NOT be processed and will render the reserved quota cancelled automatically. Under such circumstance, or if the vehicle does not depart as scheduled after the quota is approved, the vehicle owner will not be able to reserve another ad hoc quota for a specified period of time. For details, please refer to the “Application Guide for Ad Hoc Quotas for Crossing Boundary Private Cars” (“the Application Guide”).
4. **Supporting Documents** – The application form must be submitted together with the following supporting documents:

5. A fee of HK\$45 is payable at the time of application. The Application, together with a crossed cheque (payable to: “**The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region**” or the “**The Government of the HKSAR**”) can be sent to the Cross Boundary Unit of Transport Department or delivered to the drop-in box at the Cross Boundary Unit. Please write down the applicant’s name and daytime contact telephone number on the back of the cheque. The Cross Boundary Unit also accepts submission of application in person. For online applications, payments can be made by PPS or credit cards. Unless the application for ad hoc quota is rejected, the fee is not refundable under any other circumstances.
6. If the Application is accepted, the Cross Boundary Unit will send the CRP to the applicant by post in about 10 working days after the Application is received irrespective of the mode of application.
7. Any approved ad hoc quota is not transferable.
8. The validity period of the ad hoc quota is 5 calendar days. The vehicle to which the CRP is issued can only travel to Guangdong Province from Hong Kong via the specified crossing once within these 5 days and stay in Guangdong Province for not more than 7 days (the day of departure also counted as 1 day) and return to Hong Kong within these 7 days.
9. For application for **duplicate** CRP, please tick the box on the top part of Page 1 and fill in Part I, Part II (Particulars of Applicant only) and Part IV. The fee payable is HK\$75. Besides, the reporting loss memo from the Police or the damaged permit has to be attached. Applications for duplicate CRP can only be processed at the Cross Boundary Unit of Transport Department.
10. Applications will be assessed in accordance with the terms and conditions as detailed in the “Application Guide”. Authorities of Hong Kong SAR and the Guangdong Province will also take into account the following vetting criteria when assessing new applications from applicants or drivers concerned-
 - (i) For vehicles involved in illegal or unauthorized activities, such as smuggling, transporting illegal immigrants, illegal operations, and illegal carriage of prohibited, restricted or undeclared items which should be subject to quarantine and inspection, new application would not be accepted.
 - (ii) For vehicles involving the obtaining of any licence/permit for ad hoc quota by improper practices such as deception, new application would not be accepted for 3 years from the day following the date of conviction.
 - (iii) For vehicles involving overstay in or non-departure from the Guangdong Province without justified reasons, new application would not be accepted for 3 years from the day following the date of departure from the Guangdong Province.
 - (iv) For vehicles involving travelling beyond the boundary of the Guangdong Province or driven by a person other than the designated driver(s), new application would not be accepted for 1 year from the day following the date of departure from the Guangdong Province.
 - (v) For vehicles involved in traffic incidents or traffic offences in the Guangdong Province, new application would not be accepted before the completion of the processing or relevant legal procedures.
 - (vi) Other situations that restrict or prohibit the applications for entry to Guangdong as stipulated in the laws, regulations or rules. Applications may also not be accepted under certain circumstances. These include but are not limited to -
 - (i) The applicant fails to provide relevant documentary proof.
 - (ii) The company which authorizes the application has been dissolved or is being wound up.
 - (iii) The driving licence of any designated driver is invalid or its remaining validity period is inadequate.
 - (iv) Any designated driver is subject to a traffic related outstanding court order or arrest warrant.
 - (v) The vehicle does not have a valid vehicle licence or the validity period of the vehicle licence is inadequate.
 - (vi) The vehicle has a valid Hong Kong hire car permit.
 - (vii) The vehicle is not a right-hand drive private car or its seating capacity (including driver’s seat) exceeds 5.
 - (viii) There is an outstanding inspection order on the vehicle concerned.

Notes from the Public Security Department of Guangdong Province to Applicants

1. After the issue of a CRP and before departure of the vehicle to the Guangdong Province, the applicant must procure the Mainland Compulsory Traffic Accident Liability Insurance for Motor Vehicles and apply for the “Mainland Approval Notice” and Temporary-entry Vehicle Licence Plate and Licence at the office designated by the Public Security Department of Guangdong Province and complete the formalities required by Mainland Customs, Inspection and Quarantine authorities. Please refer to the Application Guide for more details.
2. Private cars entering the Mainland with ad hoc quotas are only permitted to be driven within the Guangdong Province in accordance with laws and rules of the People’s Republic of China.
3. Private cars under ad hoc quotas can only be driven by pre-approved designated drivers (i.e. Driver (1) and Driver (2) at Part III of this form if approved), who must possess valid “Home Visit Permit” and P.R.C. Motor Vehicle Driving Licence.

Notes About Personal Data

Purposes of Collection

1. The personal data and other information provided in this application and obtained during the use of the vehicle under the CRP (if issued) will be used for the following purposes:
 - (a) coordination with the Public Security Department of Guangdong Province on matters relating to and in connection with this application and cross-border traffic regulation;
 - (b) activities relating to and in connection with the processing of the application;
 - (c) activities relating to and in connection with cross-border traffic and transport matters;
 - (d) facilitating communication between Transport Department and the applicant; and
 - (e) matters relating to and in connection with the implementation and enforcement of the requirement of Ad Hoc Quotas and the Road Traffic Ordinance (Cap. 374).

Classes of Transferees

2. The personal data and other information provided in the application and obtained during the use of the vehicle under the CRP (if issued) may be disclosed to:
 - (a) the Public Security Department of Guangdong Province;
 - (b) other Government bureaux and departments (including different sections of the Transport Department and the Police);
 - (c) any other person, including tunnel companies, Tsing Ma Control Area operator and Tsing Sha Control Area operator; and for any purposes as set out in paragraph 1 (Purposes of Collection) above.

Disclosure by Other Government Departments

3. Other Government departments may disclose to the Commissioner for Transport any information or record obtained during discharge of their official duties concerning your non-compliance with or contravention of any requirement of Ad Hoc Quotas and the Laws of Hong Kong.

Enquiries and Access to Personal Data

4. You have a right of access and correction with respect to personal data as provided for in sections 18 and 22 and principle 6 of Schedule 1 of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486). Your right of access includes the right to obtain a copy of your personal data provided in this form.
