## Temporary Traffic Arrangements on North Lantau Highway

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate the road works of Tuen Mun – Chek Lap Kok Link – Southern Connection Viaduct Section, the following temporary traffic arrangements will be implemented during the time periods specified below:

## (A) Road Closure

- (i) A section of slow lane of North Lantau Highway Kowloon bound from a point about 2350 metres west of its junction with the slip road leading to Siu Ho Wan Depot to the same junction will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on 12 March 2018, from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on 13 to 15, 17 and 18 March 2018, and from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on 16 March 2018:
- (ii) A section of fast lane of North Lantau Highway Tung Chung bound from a point about 700 metres east of its junction with slip road leading from Siu Ho Wan Depot to a point about 4300 metres west of the same junction will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 10.00 p.m. on 12 March 2018 to 5.30 a.m of the following day;
- (iii) A section of fast lane of North Lantau Highway Kowloon bound from a point about 4150 metres west of its junction with the slip road leading to Siu Ho Wan Depot to a point about 700 metres west of the same junction will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 10.00 p.m. on 12 March 2018 to 5.30 a.m of the following day; and
- (iv) A section of slow lane of North Lantau Highway Tung Chung bound from a point about 550 metres west of its junction with slip road leading from Siu Ho Wan Depot to a point about 1900 metres west of the same junction will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 10.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on 16 and 17 March 2018.

## (B) Traffic Arrangements

Motorists are advised to travel via the remaining traffic lane(s) of North Lantau Highway during the time periods specified in paragraph (A).

Appropriate traffic aids will be erected on site. Motorists are advised to follow the instructions on site and drive with utmost care.
