TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for a Public Procession on Hong Kong Island on 17 November 2018

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate the holding of a public procession on Hong Kong Island, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on 17 November 2018 (Saturday):

A. <u>Traffic Arrangements</u>

I. Lane Closure

The traffic lanes of the following roads will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic from about 2.00 pm onwards until the crowd is dispersed and the traffic resumes normal:

- (a) The U-turn slip road between Gloucester Road southbound and Gloucester Road northbound:
- (b) The section of Gloucester Road southbound between Victoria Park Road flyover and Causeway Road;
- (c) Sugar Street;
- (d) Jardine's Bazaar;
- (e) Tang Lung Street;
- (f) The section of Canal Road East between Hennessy Road and Russell Street;
- (g) The section of Yee Wo Street westbound between Pennington Street and Hennessy Road;
- (h) The slow lane of Hennessy Road westbound between Yee Wo Street and Queensway;
- (i) The section of Yun Ping Road between Kai Chiu Road and Pak Sha Road;
- (i) Kai Chiu Road'
- (k) The section of Lee Garden Road between Kai Chiu Road and Hennessy Road;
- (l) The section of Canal Road West between Sharp Street West and Hennessy Road;
- (m) The section of Wan Chai Road between Canal Road West and Morrison Hill Road:
- (n) The section of Bowrington Road between Sharp Street West and Hennessy Road;
- (o) The slow lane of Queensway eastbound between Rodney Street and Hennessy Road:
- (p) Rodney Street southbound;
- (q) The section of Edinburgh Place northbound between Lung Wo Road and Connaught Road Central;
- (r) The section of Edinburgh Place southbound between Lung Wo Road and Harcourt Road:
- (s) The section of Connaught Road Central eastbound outside Hong Kong City Hall:
- (t) The section of Harcourt Road westbound between Rodney Street and Cotton Tree Drive;
- (u) Unnamed road outside Ex-Hong Kong Red Cross Headquarters; and
- (v) The section of Harcourt Road eastbound between Tim Wa Avenue and Edinburgh Place (if necessary).

II. Traffic Diversions

The following traffic diversions will be implemented from about 2.00 pm onwards until the crowd is dispersed and the traffic resumes normal:

- (a) Traffic along Gloucester Road southbound will prohibited from turning right onto Gloucester Road northbound:
- (b) Traffic along Victoria Park flyover southbound will be diverted to turn right onto Gloucester Road westbound (if necessary);
- (c) Traffic along Gloucester Road southbound heading for Causeway Road will be diverted via Tai Hang Road flyover southbound (if necessary);
- (d) Traffic along Great George Street eastbound will be diverted to turn left onto Gloucester Road northbound (except traffic heading for Tai Hang Road flyover southbound);
- (e) Traffic along Yee Wo Street eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Sugar Street;
- (f) Traffic along Irving Street will be diverted to turn right onto Pennington Street northbound;
- (g) Traffic along Russell Street westbound will be diverted to turn left onto Canal Road East southbound;
- (h) Traffic along Hennessy Road westbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Canal Road East southbound;
- (i) Traffic along Pennington Street northbound will be diverted to turn right onto Yee Wo Street;
- (j) Traffic along Yun Ping Road will be diverted to turn left onto Lan Fong Road;
- (i) Traffic along Yun Ping Road will be diverted to turn left onto Lan Fong Road;
- (k) Traffic along Canal Road West northbound near the junction with Sharp Street West will be diverted to the up-ramp leading to Canal Road flyover northbound;
- (l) Traffic along Sharp Street West eastbound will be diverted to the up-ramp leading to Canal Road flyover northbound;
- (m) Traffic along Sharp Street West eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Bowrington Road northbound;
- (n) Traffic along Bowrington Road northbound must turn right onto Sharp Street West eastbound;
- (o) Traffic along Wan Chai Road eastbound must turn right onto Morrison Hill Road southbound;
- (p) Traffic along Hennessy Road westbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Canal Road East southbound;
- (q) Traffic along Queensway eastbound will be prohibited from turning left onto Rodney Street northbound;
- (r) Traffic from Admiralty (East) Public Transport Interchange will be diverted to turn left onto Drake Street;
- (s) Traffic along Harcourt Road westbound must divert via the Harcourt Road flyover westbound (if necessary);
- (t) Traffic along Connaught Road Central eastbound will be prohibited from entering at-grade Harcourt Road eastbound and must divert via the Harcourt Road flyover eastbound;
- (u) Traffic along Garden Road northbound heading for Harcourt Road eastbound and Tim Wa Avenue northbound, must turn left onto Lambeth Walk or turn right onto Cotton Tree Drive southbound via the U-turn slip road.
- (v) Traffic along Harcourt Road westbound heading for Queensway eastbound and Cotton Tree Drive southbound will be diverted via the Harcourt Road flyover westbound and Murray Road southbound; and
- (w) Vehicles along Connaught Road Central eastbound heading for Queensway eastbound and Cotton Tree Drive southbound will be diverted via the Harcourt

Road flyover eastbound, Gloucester Road eastbound, Fenwick Street, Fenwick Pier Street westbound, the Fenwick Pier Street flyover westbound, Harcourt Road flyover westbound and Murray Road.

B. Public Transport Arrangements

I. Bus Diversions

II. Temporary Bus Stop Arrangements

The bus stop at Rodney Street southbound will be suspended from about 2.30 pm until the crowd is dispersed and the road closure is lifted.

In connection with the above bus diversions, temporary bus stop arrangements will be implemented for the affected bus routes. In addition, subject to actual traffic conditions and instructions by the Police on site, bus companies may erect temporary bus stops or suspend existing bus stops to cope with the bus diversion.

III. Green Minibus (GMB) Diversions

The following GMB routes will be temporarily diverted from about 2.00 pm onwards until crowd is dispersed and the traffic resumes normal:

IV. Suspension of Public Light Bus (PLB) Stand and GMB Stand

The PLB stand at Sugar Street and the GMB stand at Jardine's Bazaar will be suspended from about 2.00 pm until the crowd is dispersed and the road closure is lifted.

C. Suspension of Parking Spaces

The disabled parking spaces at Gloucester Road northbound near Sugar Street will be suspended from about 1.00 pm to 5.00 pm.

D. Restriction on Access to / Exit from Car Parks

To ensure public safety throughout the procession, vehicles in car parks along the procession route may not be permitted to leave or enter the car parks during the road closure period until crowd is dispersed and road closures are lifted.

E. Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles

Any vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic arrangements specified above will be towed away by the Police without prior notice.

Attention and Appeals

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices at the stops and inside vehicle compartments to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.

The Transport Department (TD) anticipates that the traffic in the vicinity of Causeway Bay, Wan Chai, Admiralty and Central will be significantly congested. Motorists are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas. They should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion, and follow the instruction given by the Police.

Depending on the actual traffic conditions in the areas, other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including road closures, traffic diversion, alteration and suspension of public transport services may be implemented by the Police.

Members of the public who plan to go to the affected areas are advised to plan their routes early, allow more travelling time to cater for unexpected delay, use public transport services as far as possible and watch out for the latest traffic news through the media. Public transport commuters are advised to pay attention to the arrangements of route diversions and suspension / relocation of stops.
