

## **Transport Department Notice**

### **Opening of Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus**

Notice is hereby given that Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus (Franchised bus area) will be opened on 27 April 2019. The following traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented as follows:

#### **(A) Bus stop arrangements**

- i. The en-route stop of New Lantao Bus Route B6 (to Hong Kong Port) will be relocated from the bus stop outside the Public Toilet on Tat Tung Road to Tung Chung Temporary Bus Terminus from 27 April 2019;
- ii. The terminal stops of New Lantao Bus Routes 3M, 13S (to/from Mui Wo), 11, 11S (to/from Tai O), 11A (to/from Shek Pik) and the en-route stops of New Lantao Bus Routes A35 (to/from Mui O and Hong Kong Port) and N35 (to Mui O) will be relocated from Tung Chung Temporary Bus Terminus to Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus from 27 April 2019;
- iii. The en-route stops of New Lantao Bus Routes 37 (to Ying Tung Estate), 37M (to/from Ying Tung Estate), B6 (to Mun Tung Estate) and N37 (to/from Ying Tung Estate) will be relocated from Tung Chung Station Bus Terminus to Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus from 27 April 2019; and
- iv. The terminal stop of New Lantao Bus Route 39M will be relocated from Mun Tung Estate to Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus from 27 April 2019.

#### **(B) Franchised bus operation**

- i. The ingress and egress of the Tung Chung Station Bus Terminus and Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus will be changed from Mei Tung Street to Tat Tung Road with effect from 27 April 2019. Buses are allowed to turn left or right from the two mentioned termini to Tat Tung Road.
- ii. To facilitate the road works on Tat Tung Road, only right turn is allowed for traffic from Tung Chung Station Bus Terminus and Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus to Tat Tung Road during the initial stage of the opening of Tung Chung Town Centre Bus Terminus. Bus routes observing the two mentioned termini (except New Lantao Bus Routes 3M, 11, 11A, 11S, 13S, A35 and N35) are required to re-route via Mei Tung Street and left turn to Tat Tung Road.

The public transport operators will put up notices to advise passengers of the above arrangements.
