## **Transport Department Notice**

# Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Lunar New Year's Eve and Lunar New Year Holidays 2023

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories during the Lunar New Year's Eve and Lunar New Year Holidays 2023:

#### I. SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS

## HONG KONG ISLAND (CAUSEWAY BAY, VICTORIA PARK AND TIN HAU)

## (A) Road Closures

Subject to the prevailing traffic and crowd situation, the following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 21 January 2023 at different times specified below. The implementation time may be varied if necessary:

## (a) From 10.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:

- (i) The unnamed road section at the northern entrance of Park Towers car park (except vehicles accessing to Park Towers car park);
- (ii) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Lau Li Street (except franchised buses and Green Minibuses ('GMB'));
- (iii) Lau Li Street between Hing Fat Street and Ngan Mok Street (except parking spaces designated for the disabled); and
- (iv) Part of the traffic lanes of Electric Road between Mercury Street and Yacht Street.

#### (b) From 4.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:

- (i) Sugar Street; and
- (ii) Gloucester Road northbound between Causeway Road and Great George Street.

#### (c) From 5.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:

- (i) Cleveland Street;
- (ii) Paterson Street;
- (iii) Kingston Street;
- (iv) Great George Street between Paterson Street and Gloucester Road; and

(v) Jardine's Bazaar.

# (d) <u>From 7.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards (except franchised buses,</u> green minibuses (GMB) and trams):

- (i) Hennessy Road eastbound between Percival Street and East Point Road;
- (ii) Yee Wo Street;
- (iii) The leftmost lane of Pennington Street between Irving Street and Yee Wo Street;
- (iv) Causeway Road eastbound between King's Road and Moreton Terrace;
- (v) Hennessy Road westbound between Jardine's Bazaar and Percival Street; and
- (vi) Irving Street.

## (e) <u>From 8.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:</u>

- (i) Lockhart Road east of Percival Street;
- (ii) Jaffe Road east of Percival Street;
- (iii) Cannon Street; and
- (iv) Shelter Street.

#### (f) From 9.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:

- (i) The leftmost lane of Causeway Road westbound between King's Road (near Queen's College) and Tung Lo Wan Road (near St. Paul's Convent School);
- (ii) Gloucester Road southbound between the down ramp of Victoria Park Road flyover and Causeway Road;
- (iii) Tai Hang Road flyover;
- (iv) Causeway Bay Flyover northbound; and
- (v) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Lau Li Street (except franchised buses and GMB).

#### (B) Traffic Diversions

To tie in with the road closures above, the following traffic diversions will be implemented:

#### (a) From 5.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:

(i) Lau Li Street between Electric Road and Hing Fat Street will be re-routed as one-way westbound and closed to public light buses ('PLB').

#### (b) **From 9.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards**:

- (i) Vehicles heading for Tai Hang Road flyover southbound will be diverted to Victoria Park eastbound, Wing Hing Street and King's Road; and
- (ii) Vehicles heading for Tai Hang Road flyover northbound to Central will be diverted to Tung Lo Wan Road, Moreton Terrace and Leighton Road.

## (C) <u>Pedestrian Precinct</u>

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic for designation as pedestrian precinct from 12.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 3.00 a.m. of the following day:

- (i) Lockhart Road east of Cannon Street:
- (ii) East Point Road; and
- (iii) Great George Street west of Paterson Street.

## (D) <u>Prohibition to learner drivers</u>

Learner drivers will be prohibited from entering the following roads from 4.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 8.00 a.m. of the following day:

- (i) Leighton Road;
- (ii) Tin Lok Lane;
- (iii) Caroline Hill Road;
- (iv) Eastern Hospital Road;
- (v) Tai Hang Road north of Lai Tak Tsuen Road;
- (vi) Tung Lo Wan Road;
- (vii) Electric Road south of Gordon Road;
- (viii)Morrison Hill Road north of Queen's Road East;
- (ix) Hennessy Road;
- (x) Yee Wo Street;
- (xi) Causeway Road;
- (xii) King's Road;
- (xiii)Gloucester Road service road;
- (xiv)Hing Fat Street;
- (xv) Tin Hau Temple Road westbound west of Cloud View Road; and
- (xvi)Wan Chai Road eastbound.

#### (E) Suspension of parking spaces, car parks and restriction of vehicle access

- (a) All vehicles parked in car parks at the above closed roads will not be permitted to enter or leave the car parks until the roads are re-opened for normal traffic;
- (b) The on-street parking spaces, including metered parking spaces and motorcycle

parking spaces, on the following roads will be suspended from 2.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 8.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023:

- (i) All the above closed roads on 21 January 2023;
- (ii) Tung Lo Wan Road;
- (iii) Lockhart Road between Canal Road East and Cannon Street:
- (iv) Jaffe Road between Canal Road East and Cannon Street;
- (v) Tsing Fung Street; and
- (vi) Lau Li Street.
- (c) All parking spaces at Hing Fat Street Public Car Park (except parking spaces designated for the disabled) will be suspended from 8.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023 to 3.00 a.m. of the following day.

## (F) <u>Temporary closure of Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange</u>

Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange will be suspended from 6.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023. During the above period, the following arrangement of the stops will be implemented:

- (i) XHT route nos. 914, 948, 968 and CTB route no. E11 will terminate on Ngan Mok Street near Ernest Court;
- (ii) XHT route nos. 914 and 968 will depart from Tung Lo Wan Road opposite to Queen's College;
- (iii) XHT route no. 948, CTB route nos. E11A and E11B will depart from Causeway Road westbound near Queen's College;
- (iv) NWFB route no. 25 will omit the stop in Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange;
- (v) HKI GMB route no. 49M will omit Hing Fat Street, Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange, King's Road, Ngan Mok Street, Lau Li Street, and terminate at King's Road westbound near Lau Sin Street; and
- (vi) HKI GMB route nos. 56A and 56B will be converted to circular route and omit the stop at Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange. A temporary stop will be set up at Ngan Mok Street.

## (G) Temporary bus stops arrangements

The bus stop on Victoria Park Road eastbound outside Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter will be suspended from 8.00 p.m. as necessary on 21 January 2023.

## (H) Suspension of tram stops

The following tram stops will be suspended from 8.00 p.m. onwards as necessary on 21 January 2023:

- (a) Victoria Park (#42W and #57E);
- (b) Shelter Street (#44W and #55E),
- (c) Pennington Street (#46W), and
- (d) Paterson Street (#48W and #53E).

#### (I) Suspension and relocation of GMB stops

To tie in with the above road closures, the following GMB stands will be suspended as necessary on 21 January 2023:

- (i) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 4C, N4A and N4C on Cannon Street will be relocated to Gloucester Road service road near Percival Street and Gloucester Road service road near Cannon Street respectively;
- (ii) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 5 and 69X on Lockhart Road will be relocated to Gloucester Road service road near Cannon Street;
- (iii) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 36X, 40, 40X, N40, 56A and 56B on Jardine's Bazaar will be relocated to Pennington Street outside Dragon Rise;
- (iv) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 10, 31 and N31 on Jaffe Road east of Percival Street will be relocated to Jaffe Road eastbound between Canal Road East and Percival Street; and
- (v) The stop of HKI GMB route no. 25 in Paterson Street will be suspended and it will be converted into circular service.

#### (J) Suspension of PLB stands

The PLB stands on Sugar Street and Paterson Street will be suspended from 12.00 p.m. onwards on 21 January 2023.

#### (K) <u>Suspension of taxi stands</u>

The following Taxi stands will be suspended from on 21 January 2023 at the different times specified below:

#### (a) From 10.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:

- (i) Lau Li Street; and
- (ii) Electric Road.

## (b) <u>From 12.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 onwards:</u>

- (i) Paterson Street near Great George Street;
- (ii) Paterson Street between Gloucester Road Service Road and Kingston Street:
- (iii) Jaffe Road near Percival Street; and
- (iv) Lockhart Road near Cannon Street.

#### (L) Central-Mid-levels Escalator

The services of the Central to Mid-Levels Escalator and Walkway System will be extended to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023.

## **KOWLOON**

#### (1) Wong Tai Sin Morse Park

The following special traffic arrangements will be implemented from 5.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 6.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023:

#### (A) <u>Traffic arrangements</u>

#### (a) Road closures

The eastern egress of Ching Tak Street public light bus and taxi stands near Wong Tai Sin Government Primary School will be closed. Vehicles will be required to use the western egress and turn left into Ching Tak Street westbound for leaving. The section of Ching Tak Street between Lung Cheung Road and Tung Tau Tsuen Road may be closed according to traffic condition.

#### (b) <u>Traffic Control</u>

- (i) The Police may ban the left-turn movement from Lung Cheung Road westbound into Ching Tak Street and Fung Mo Street depending on traffic condition; and
- (ii) The Police will implement no-stopping restriction in the vicinity of Morse Park No. 3 including Ching Tak Street, Tung Tau Tsuen Road, Shatin Pass Road, Fung Mo Street, Fu Mei Street, Wang Tau Hom East Road, Wang Tau Hom South Road and Wang Tau Hom Central Road.

## (B) <u>Transport arrangements</u>

#### (a) Suspension/relocation of bus and GMB stops

The bus and GMB stops in Fung Mo Street southbound outside Morse Park Indoor Game Hall for KMB route nos. 1, 7, 11K and 891, XHT route no. 113 and Kowloon GMB route no. 54 will be suspended. Temporary bus stop for KMB route nos. 1, 11K, 224R, XHT route no. 113 and GMB stop will be provided at Fung Mo Street southbound opposite to Morse Park No. 4.

#### (b) <u>Taxi stand/drop-off point locations</u>

- (i) Temporary taxi stand will be provided on Wang Tau Hom East Road southbound outside Wang Hau House;
- (ii) The lay-by in Ching Tak Street outside Lung Hei House will be converted to temporary taxi drop-off point; and
- (iii) The single lane of the taxi stand at Ching Tak Street outside Lung Hing House will be divided into two lanes, the left lane will be allowed for boarding and alighting passengers whilst the right lane will be allowed for alighting passengers only.

Traffic at the above road sections will be very congested and the number of parking spaces is limited in the vicinity. Members of the public should use public transport services as far as possible. MTR passengers travel to/from Morse Park Lunar New Year's Fair should make use of Lok Fu Station.

#### (2) Wong Tai Sin Temple

The following special traffic arrangements will be implemented from 7.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023 to 12.01 a.m. on 6 February 2023 in order to facilitate traffic and crowd control at Wong Tai Sin Temple during the Lunar New Year:

## (A) Road closures

- (i) Shatin Pass Road between Lung Cheung Road and Fung Tak Road will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic except for GMB services; and
- (ii) The unnamed road connecting Wong Tai Sin Road and Wong Tai Sin Temple will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic except for designated vehicles of Sik Sik Yuen.

#### (B) <u>Traffic Control</u>

All vehicles will be prohibited from parking or waiting at Wong Tai Sin Road (both directions) between Shatin Pass Road and Nga Chuk Street.

#### (C) Suspension of Car Park

Wong Tai Sin Public Transport Terminus Car Park will be temporarily closed from 7.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023 to 12.01 a.m. on 6 February 2023. Subject to the crowd situation in the vicinity and conditions permitted, the aforesaid Car Park might be temporarily reopened between 26 January 2023 and 5 February 2023.

## (3) Cheung Sha Wan

## (A) Temporary relocation of bus stops

The bus stops on Cheung Sha Wan Road westbound outside Cheung Sha Wan Playground will be temporarily relocated to a point near its junction with Hing Wah Street, from 10.00 a.m. on 20 January 2023 to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2022.

#### (B) No parking or waiting

All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from parking or waiting (except for picking up/ setting off passengers and loading/unloading goods) in Fortune Street, Hang Cheung Street and Fat Tseung Street from 10.00 a.m. on 20 January to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2022.

## (4) Sham Shui Po

The following temporary special traffic arrangement will be implemented from 1.30 p.m. to 2.30 p.m. on 23 January 2023, depending on actual traffic and crowd conditions:

#### (A) Road Closure

The following sections of roads will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic (except franchised buses):

- (a) Wong Chuk Street between Yu Chau Street and Cheung Sha Wan
- (b) Apliu Street between Nam Cheong Street and Wong Chuk Street;
- (c) Nam Cheong Street southbound between Cheung Sha Wan Road and Hai Tan Street:
- (d) Hai Tan Street between Nam Cheong Street and Boundary Street;
- (e) Boundary Street between Hai Tan Street and Yee Kuk Street;
- (f) Yee Kuk Street between Boundary Street and Shek Kip Mei Street; and
- (g) Shek Kip Mei Street between Yee Kuk Stret and Apliu Street.

#### (B) Traffic Diversion

Motorists heading for Nam Cheong Street southbound and Shek Kip Mei Street southbound are advised to be diverted via Yen Chow Street southbound and Lai Chi Kok Road eastbound

## (5) Mong Kok Fa Hui Park

## (A) Suspension of bus stops

The bus stops at the following locations will be temporarily suspended from 6.00 p.m. on 20 January 2023 to 6.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023; and from 2.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 7.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023 respectively:

- (a) Boundary Street eastbound outside Fa Hui Park;
- (b) Boundary Street eastbound outside Police Sports & Recreation Club;
- (c) Tai Hang Tung Road (both directions) near Tat Chee Avenue;
- (d) Tat Chee Avenue (both directions) near Osmanthus Road;
- (e) Embankment Road northbound; and
- (f) Knight Street southbound.

## (B) Temporary relocation of bus stops and GMB stops

The bus stops on Prince Edward Road West eastbound outside Diocesan Boys' School will be temporarily relocated eastward to Prince Edward Road West eastbound outside No. 211-215 (except the bus stops of KMB route nos. 3C, 87D and 281A) from 5.00 p.m. on 20 January 2023 to 1.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023; and from 2.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023.

#### (C) Suspension of GMB pick up/drop-off points

The GMB pick-up/drop-off points at the following locations will be temporarily suspended from 5.00 p.m. on 20 January 2023 to 1.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023; and from 2.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023 respectively:

- (a) Boundary Street eastbound outside Fa Hui Park;
- (b) Boundary Street eastbound outside Hong Kong Soka Gakkai Institution;
- (c) Tai Hang Tung Road (both directions) near Tat Chee Avenue;
- (d) Tat Chee Avenue (both directions) near Osmanthus Road; and
- (e) Embankment Road northbound.

#### (D) Temporary PLB pick-up / drop-off point and taxi stand

A temporary PLB pick-up point will be designated at Lincoln Road near Cumberland Road from 3.00 p.m. on 20 January 2023 to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023.

#### (E) Temporary loading/unloading point

A temporary loading/ unloading point will be designated at Tong Yam Street near the junction with Tai Hang Tung Road from 3.00 p.m. on 20 January to 8.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023.

## (F) Temporary Taxi Stand

Temporary taxi stands will be set up on Cumberland Road southbound between Lincoln Road and Boundary Street and Fa Po Street near Chinese Rhenish Church Kowloon from 9.00 a.m. on 16 January to 7.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023.

## (G) Suspension of parking spaces

The following parking spaces will be temporarily suspended from 9.00 a.m. on 20 January 2023 to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023:

- (a) Metered parking spaces nos. 9607 and 9608 on Tong Yam Street;
- (b) All metered and motorcycle parking spaces on Duke Street between Embankment Road and Knight Street;
- (c) All motorcycle parking spaces on Knight Street near its junction with Duke Street:
- (d) Metered parking space no.13413 on Belfran Road; and
- (e) All metered parking spaces on Lincoln Road between Cumberland Road and Waterloo Road.

#### (H) Temporary road closure and traffic arrangements

The following temporary road closure and traffic arrangements will be implemented on the dates and at the time specified below:

- (a) From 5.00 p.m. on 20 January to 1.00 a.m. on 21 January 2023; and from 2.00 p.m. on 21 January to 3.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023:
  - (i) All vehicles on Lincoln Road westbound will be temporarily prohibited from making left turn onto Cumberland Road southbound (except for taxis); and
  - (ii) All vehicles on Essex Crescent will be temporarily prohibited from making left turn onto Cumberland Road southbound (except for residents).
- (b) From 10.00 p.m. on 21 January to 1.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023:
  - (i) The fifth lane of Prince Edward Road West, westbound, before the junction of Yuen Po Street to the ascending of the Flyover will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic.

#### (6) Kwun Tong

#### (A) Road closure

The following roads will be closed to all vehicular traffic on the dates and at the time specified below:

- (a) From 3.00 p.m. to 4.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 20 and 21 January 2023:
  - (i) Fuk Ning Road; and
  - (ii) Fuk Tong Road.
- (b) From 6.00 p.m. on 19 January 2023 to 4.00 a.m. of the following day; and from 3.00 p.m. to 4.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 20 and 21 January 2023:
  - (i) Kai Lim Road.

The Police will implement road closure and road re-opening subject to the actual situation and on a need basis.

#### (B) Suspension of GMB Stops, Parking Spaces and Taxi Stand

- (a) The Green Minibus (GMB) stand, metered parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces, parking spaces designated for the disabled and cross harbour taxi stand on Kai Lim Road will be suspended from 8.00 a.m. on 19 January 2023 to 4.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023.
- (b) The layby on Tsui Ping Road southbound outside Tsui Lau House will be converted to a temporary taxi pick-up / drop-off point from 3.00 p.m. on 19 January 2023 to 4.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023.
- (c) Vehicles parked on the above roadside parking spaces (including the parking spaces designated for the disabled), the metered parking spaces and other offending vehicles during the above period will be towed away.

#### (C) <u>Public Transport Arrangement</u>

#### Stage 1

From 7.30 a.m. on 19 January 2023 to 4.00 a.m. on 22 January 2023:

GMB route no. 59 on journeys to Kwun Tong Town Centre will omit Kai Lim Road.

#### Stage 2

From 3.00 p.m. on 20 January 2023 to 4.00 a.m. of the following day; and from 3.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 4.00 a.m. of the following day:

(a) The bus and GMB laybys located at the northern section of Kwun Tong Station Public Transport Interchange will be closed. During the above period, the following temporary service arrangements for bus and GMB routes observing Kwun Tong Station Public Transport Interchange ("the

#### PTI") will be implemented:

#### I) Bus Routes

- (i) the terminating point of KMB route no. 89 at the PTI will be temporarily relocated to the forth layby from the south of the PTI (i.e. the existing bus stop for KMB route no. 16M), journey to Lek Yuen will be diverted via Kwun Tong Road and Tsui Ping Road before resuming its original routeing;
- (ii) the en-route stop of KMB route no. 16M at the PTI will be temporarily relocated to the third layby from the south (i.e. to share use the layby of KMB route nos. 13M, 14B, 15A and 89X);
- (iii) the evening services of KMB route nos. 234C and 234D at the PTI will be temporarily relocated to the fifth layby from the south (i.e. to share use the layby of XHT route nos. 601, 606, 606X, 619, 641 and N619), journeys to Sham Tseng and Tsing Lung Tau will be diverted via Kwun Tong Road and Lei Yue Mun Road before resuming their original routeings; and
- (iv) the en-route stops of KMB route nos. 13M, 14B, 15A, 89X, 93K and 98A, CTB route nos. A22 and N29 and XHT route nos. 601, 606, 606X, 619, 641 and N619 at the PTI will not be affected.

#### II) GMB Routes

- (i) Kowloon GMB route no. 47 will be diverted via Tsui Ping Road southbound, roundabout outside Tsui Ping South Estate entrance and Tsui Ping Road northbound before resuming its original routeing, and will not observe Kwun Tong Station Public Transport Interchange and Fuk Tong Road. A temporary GMB stand will be designated outside Tsui Pak House on Tsui Ping Road northbound;
- (ii) Kowloon GMB route no. 59 on journeys to Kwun Tong Town Centre will continue to omit Kai Lim Road. For the Tsui Ping bound journey, the GMB route will be diverted via Kwun Tong Road eastbound and Tsui Ping Road northbound before resuming its original routeing, and will not observe Kwun Tong Station Public Transport Interchange and Fuk Tong Road. A temporary GMB stand will be designated outside Hong Kong Public Records Building on Tsui Ping Road northbound; and
- (iii) Service of Kowloon GMB Supplementary route no. 59M (Tsui Ping South Estate Kwun Tong Station) will be suspended.
- (b) The en-route stops of KMB route nos. 11B, 11C and 89C near Kwun Tong Swimming Pool on both bounds of Tsui Ping Road will be suspended; and
- (c) The bus and GMB pick-up/drop-off points on Tsui Ping Road northbound near Fuk Tong Road and Tsui Ping Road southbound outside Kwun Tong Swimming Pool will be suspended.

#### Stage 3

The en-route stops of the following bus and GMB routes on Lei Yue Mun Road eastbound outside Kwun Tong Swimming Pool will be suspended from 6.00 p.m. on 21 January 2023 to 4.00 a.m. of the following day:

## (A) Road closures

The following sections of roads will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 20 January and 21 January 2023:

- (a) Kai Hong Close;
- (b) Kai Chi Close;
- (c) The section of Hoi Pa Street between its junction with Lo Tak Court and Tai Ho Road.

#### (B) Suspension of motorcycle parking spaces

The motorcycle parking spaces at Kai Hong Close will be suspended from 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 20 January and 21 January 2023.

#### (C) Suspension of public light bus stand

The public light bus stand on Hoi Pa Street outside Wing Tai House will be suspended from 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 20 January and 21 January 2023.

#### (D) Temporary Relocation/Suspension of bus stop

The bus stop on Tai Ho Road northbound outside Princess Alexandra Community Centre will be suspended from 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 a.m. of the following day daily on 20 January and 21 January 2023.

#### IV. ATTENTION AND APPEAL

Appropriate traffic aids and signs will be provided to guide motorists. Public transport operators will also display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements. Actual implementation of and adjustments to road closures, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on conditions in the areas.

Members of the public who intend to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport services as far as possible, plan their journey early and allow more travelling time to cater for unexpected delay. Members of the public are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas. Motorists should exercise tolerance and patience in cases of traffic congestion, observe the instructions given by the Police; and watch out for the latest traffic news through media.

To boost the turnover rate of on-street parking spaces, motorists are advised to avoid long-term parking at designated parking spaces during Lunar New Year holidays. Moreover, motorists are further advised to pay parking fees for all vehicles parking at metered parking spaces on-street unless the vehicles are parked at designated parking spaces which are not charged on Sundays and public holidays.
