TRAFFIC ADVICE

Service Adjustments of CTB Route No. 75 (Shum Wan Road Public Transport Terminus – Central (Exchange Square))

Members of the public are advised that, with effect from 11 September 2023 (Monday), CTB Route No. 75 will be adjusted to provide 4 departures from Shum Wan Road Public Transport Terminus during the period from 7.00 am to 8.30 am and 4 departures from Central (Exchange Square) during the period from 5.20 pm to 7.00 pm on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays) only. Meanwhile, CTB Route No. 72A (Shum Wan Road Public Transport Terminus – Causeway Bay (Moreton Terrace)) will advance the first departure from Shum Wan Road Public Transport Terminus and Causeway Bay (Moreton Terrace) to 5.10 am and 5.50 am respectively, and strengthen the service in most of the non-peak periods. The service details of the concerned routes after the adjustments are as follows:-

In addition, the bus company will introduce a new bus-bus interchange concession between CTB Route No. 72A and CTB Route No. N90 to cope with the demand of passengers travelling from Shum Wan to Wan Chai/ Central in the early morning.

Existing passengers of CTB Route No. 75 may switch to CTB Route Nos. 37A, 37B, 37X, 70, 72A, 90 and 97 as the alternative services, and the bus-bus interchange arrangements between CTB Route No. 72A and CTB Route Nos. 37A, 37B, 37X, 70, 90, 97 and N90.

The bus company will display notices to inform passengers of the above arrangements.
