# <u>SPECIAL TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS FOR</u> <u>THE COMMUNITY CHEST 55<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY WALK FOR MILLIONS</u> (HONG KONG-ZHUHAI-MACAO BRIDGE - HONG KONG LINK ROAD)

Notice is hereby given that special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge ("HZMB") Hong Kong Link Road ("HKLR") on 6 January 2024 (Saturday) and 7 January 2024 (Sunday) to facilitate the holding of The Community Chest 55<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Walk for Millions:

## I. <u>TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS</u>

Depending on the actual finishing time of the event and subsequent re-opening of the roads for traffic, the following temporary traffic arrangements will be implemented on the section of HKLR between the eastern portal of Scenic Hill Tunnel and San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility to all vehicles at the time specified below (except vehicles relevant to the event):

I (Fig. 1)	From 8.00 pm on 6 January to about 00.30 am on 7 January 2024	<ul> <li>The left and middle lanes of the section of HKLR (Hong Kong bound) between the eastern portal of Scenic Hill Tunnel and San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility;</li> <li>The three leftmost lanes of Scenic Hill Tunnel (Zhuhai and Macao bound); and</li> <li>The left and middle lanes of the section of HKLR (Zhuhai and Macao bound) between the western portal of Scenic Hill Tunnel and San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility.</li> </ul>	• Motorists on both bounds of HKLR have to use the rightmost lane of the respective road sections.
II (Fig. 2)	From 00.30 am to about 6.00 pm on 7 January 2024	<ul> <li>All traffic lanes of the section of HKLR (Hong Kong bound) between the eastern portal of Scenic Hill Tunnel and San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility;</li> <li>The second right lane and the leftmost lane of Scenic Hill Tunnel (the original Zhuhai and Macao bound);</li> <li>The middle lane of the section of HKLR (original Zhuhai and Macao bound) between the western portal of Scenic Hill Tunnel and San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility; and</li> <li>The slip road leading to/from San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The section of HKLR (original Zhuhai and Macao bound) between the eastern portal of Scenic Hill Tunnel and San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility will be converted into two-way traffic; and</li> <li>Motorists heading for Hong Kong will be diverted to use the original Zhuhai and Macao bound road section.</li> </ul>

III (Fig. 3)	From 6.00 pm to about 8.00 pm on 7 January 2024	<ul> <li>The three leftmost lanes of Scenic Hill Tunnel (Zhuhai and Macao bound); and</li> <li>The left and middle lanes of the section of HKLR (Zhuhai and Macao bound) between the western portal of Scenic Hill Tunnel and San Shek Wan Turnaround Facility.</li> </ul>	• Motorists heading for Zhuhai and Macao have to use the rightmost lane of the road section.

# II. <u>PUBLIC TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS</u>

To facilitate walkers going to AsiaWorld-Expo, the services of the following public transport services will be temporarily adjusted on 7 January 2024 (Sunday):

#### (A) Mass Transit Railway (MTR) Services

The service of Airport Express Line will be enhanced in the morning of 7 January 2024 (Sunday). Details are as follows:-

## (C) HZMB Shuttle Bus, Cross-boundary Coaches and Cross- boundary Hire Car

HZMB Shuttle Bus, cross-boundary coaches and cross-boundary hire cars will remain in operation during the event. The routings of these services will be diverted subject to the temporary traffic arrangements implemented on site.

# III. ATTENTION AND APPEAL

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists, and notices will be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the temporary transport arrangements.

Members of the public and tourists are advised to plan their journeys early to avoid any delays caused by the expected lengthened journey time on the HZMB HKLR (both directions) during the respective phases of temporary road closures and traffic diversions.

Depending on the prevailing circumstances, other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including further closures of roads, traffic diversion, alterations and suspension of public transport services, may be implemented by the Police at short notice. Members of the public are advised to stay alert to the latest traffic news through the media.
