#### **Traffic Advice**

### Temporary Traffic and Public Transport Arrangements at Kai Tak Tunnel

Motorists are advised that to facilitate construction works of the Central Kowloon Route, the following temporary traffic and public transport arrangements will be implemented at Kai Tak Tunnel from 1.00 am to 6.00 am (Tuesday to Saturday) daily from 27 February to 28 March 2024:

## (I) Road Closure

- (i) On 27 February and 19 21 & 26 March 2024
  - (a) The Kwun Tong bound tunnel tube of the Kai Tak tunnel, from the To Kwa Wan Portal to its junction with Kai Cheung Road southbound; and
  - (b) The slip road from Kwun Tong bound tunnel tube of the Kai Tak tunnel to Kai Cheung Road northbound

will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic.

#### (ii) On 28 - 29 February and 1 - 2, 5 - 9, 12 - 16, 22 - 23, 27 - 28 March 2024

- (a) Tsim Sha Tsui bound tunnel tube of the Kai Tak Tunnel;
- (b) The slow lane of Kwun Tong bound tube of Kai Tak Tunnel and its slip road to Sung Wong Tai Road;
- (c) The fast lane of East Kowloon Way Kwun Tong bound between Lok Shan Road and To Kwa Wan Portal of Kai Tak Tunnel;
- (d) The section of Kai Fuk Road Kwun Tong bound from its junction with Kowloon Bay Portal of Kai Tak Tunnel, to its junction with Kai Cheung Road southbound; and
- (e) The slip road from Kwun Tong bound tunnel tube of the Kai Tak tunnel to Kai Cheung Road northbound

will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic.

#### (II) Traffic Diversion

#### (i) On 27 February and 19 – 21 & 26 March 2024

Affected motorists heading to Kowloon City and Kowloon East are advised to divert via Kowloon City Road.

# (ii) On 28 - 29 February and 1 - 2, 5 - 9, 12 - 16, 22 - 23, 27 - 28 March 2024

Affected motorists heading to Tsim Sha Tsui are advised to use the remaining traffic lane along Kai Fuk Road Tsim Sha Tsui bound, then travel via Kwun Tong bound tunnel tube of Kai Tak Tunnel with implementation of one-tube-one-way operation; while affected motorists heading to Kowloon City and Kowloon East are advised to use the remaining traffic lane along East Kowloon Way Kwun Tong bound and divert via Kowloon City Road.

## (III) Public Transport Service Arrangements

During the above mentioned road and traffic lane closures, Kowloon Green Minibus route no. 62S heading to Lam Tin (Kwong Tin Estate) will be re-routed via Kowloon City Road northbound, Sung Wong Toi Road westbound, Ma Tau Chung Road northbound, Prince Edward Road East eastbound, Kwun Tong Road eastbound, Wai Yip Street southbound, Kai Cheung Road westbound and Wang Kwong Road northbound, before resuming its original routeing.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists.
