

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements at Central Harbourfront

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate the holding of an event at Central Harbourfront, the following temporary traffic arrangements will be implemented on 30 April, 1, 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8 May 2024:

A. Temporary Traffic Arrangement

- i. The leftmost lane of Lung Wo Road eastbound between Edinburgh Place and Tim Wa Avenue will be temporarily converted to franchised bus stop from 9.00 pm until the end of crowd dispersal; and
- ii. The goods vehicle parking spaces at Man Kwong Street outside Central Pier No. 8 will be suspended from 9.00 pm until the end of crowd dispersal.

B. Temporary Transport Arrangements

II. MTR Services

The last train to Lo Wu Station on the MTR East Rail Line will depart from Admiralty Station at 11.32 pm.

III. Cross-boundary Coach Services

- i. The short-haul cross-boundary coach services plying between Wan Chai and Huanggang Port will add a temporary pick-up point at Connaught Road Central (westbound) outside World Wide House for northbound departures during the period between 10.00 pm and 2.00 am of the following days; and
- ii. Lok Ma Chau – Huanggang cross-boundary shuttle bus service will be enhanced subject to passenger demand.

C. Attention and Appeal

The Transport Department anticipates that there may be a number of cross-boundary passengers using public transport services to travel via the land boundary control points during the above-mentioned period. Passengers are advised to plan their journeys in advance and make their journeys during non-peak hours. As the waiting time for public transport services may be longer, passengers should observe order and heed advice from the on-site Police and staff of the concerned public transport service operators. Cross-boundary coach passengers are also advised to plan their journeys and reserve coach tickets ahead.

Subject to the prevailing traffic conditions, there may be special traffic arrangements implemented for Shenzhen Bay Port and Lok Ma Chau Control Point during the above-mentioned period to facilitate public transport vehicles to enter the Control Points more smoothly. Motorists are advised to pay extra attention to the traffic signs along the road. Motorists are also appealed to be patient in case of traffic congestion, and follow instructions of the Police Officers on site.
