

Traffic Advice

Temporary Traffic and Public Transport Arrangements at Kai Tak Tunnel and Kai Fuk Road

Motorists are advised that to facilitate the regular maintenance and tunnel system equipment replacement works of Kai Tak Tunnel, the following temporary traffic and public transport arrangements will be implemented from 1.00 am to 5.00 am daily at Kai Tak Tunnel and Kai Fuk Road on the following dates:

(I) Road Closure and Traffic Diversion

(i) 26 - 27 May 2025

The Kwun Tong bound of Kai Tak Tunnel will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic. Affected motorists on East Kowloon Corridor Kwun Tong bound heading for Sung Wong Toi Road and Kowloon East are advised to travel via Kowloon City Road.

(ii) 28 May 2025

The Tsim Sha Tsui bound of Kai Tak Tunnel will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic. One-tube-two-way operation will be implemented at its Kwun Tong bound.

(iii) 29 - 30 May 2025

(a) Road Closure

The slip road leading from Kai Cheung Road westbound to Kai Fuk Road westbound will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic.

(b) Traffic Diversion

Affected vehicles on Kai Cheung Road westbound heading for East Kowloon Corridor southbound via Kai Fuk Road westbound and Kai Tak Tunnel Tsim Sha Tsui bound will be diverted via Kai Fuk Road eastbound, Wang Kwong Road northbound, Kai Shun Road westbound, Kai Shing Street northbound, Shing Kai Road westbound, To Kwa Wan Road southbound, San Shan Road westbound and slip road to East Kowloon Corridor southbound.

(II) Public Transport Service Arrangement

26 - 27 May 2025

During the above-mentioned road closure period, Kowloon Green Minibus route no. 62S heading to Lam Tin (Kwong Tin Estate) will be re-routed via Kowloon City Road northbound, Sung Wong Toi Road westbound, Ma Tau Chung Road northbound, Prince Edward Road East eastbound, Kwun Tong Road eastbound, Wai Yip Street southbound, Kai Cheung Road westbound and Wang Kwong Road northbound, before resuming its original routing.

Motorists are advised to drive with utmost care and patience. Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.
