

## **Traffic Advice**

### **Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Tram Track Renewal Works in Central District**

Members of the public are advised that to facilitate the tram track renewal works at Des Voeux Road Central near Morrison Street, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from about 10.00 am on 4 April 2020 to 6.00 am on 6 April 2020:

#### (I) Temporary Traffic Arrangements

##### (A) Traffic Lane Closure

Some traffic lanes of Morrison Street northbound near its junction of Des Voeux Road Central will be temporarily closed (except tram).

##### (B) Banning of Turning Movement

- (i) All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from going straight ahead from New Market Street eastbound onto Des Voeux Road Central;
- (ii) All vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length will be temporarily prohibited from turning right from Morrison Street northbound onto Des Voeux Road Central;
- (iii) All vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length will be temporarily prohibited from turning left from Morrison Street northbound onto New Market Street;
- (iv) All vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length will be temporarily prohibited from turning right from Cleverly Street southbound onto Des Voeux Road Central; and
- (v) All vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length will be temporarily prohibited from going straight ahead from Des Voeux Road Central westbound onto Des Voeux Road Central east of Hillier Street.

##### (C) Traffic Diversion

- (i) Vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length on New Market Street eastbound heading for Des Voeux Road Central will be diverted via Morrison Street, Connaught Road Central and Cleverly Street;
- (ii) Vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length on Morrison Street northbound heading for Des Voeux Road Central will be diverted via Connaught Road Central and Cleverly Street; and
- (iii) Vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length on Des Voeux Road Central westbound heading for Connaught Road Central will be diverted via Hillier Street.

#### (II) Temporary Transport Arrangements

##### (A) Bus Diversion

- (i) Citybus Route nos. 1 and 5B, NWFB Route no. 26 and Cross Harbour Route nos. 113 and 905, will be diverted via Wing Wo Street and Connaught Road Central starting from their first departures on 4 April 2020 to the last departure on 5 April 2020, before resuming their original routings;
- (ii) Cross Harbour Route nos. 914, 934, 935, 936, 960, 961, 969 and 978, will be diverted via Hillier Street and Connaught Road Central from their first departures on 4 April 2020 to the last departure on 5 April 2020, before resuming their original routings;

- (iii) Citybus Route no. N8X will be diverted via Wing Wo Street and Connaught Road Central starting from their first departures on 5 April 2020 to the last departure on 6 April 2020, before resuming their original routings; and
- (iv) Cross Harbour Route no. N969 will be diverted via Hillier Street and Connaught Road Central from their first departures on 5 April 2020 to the last departure on 6 April 2020, before resuming their original routings.

(B) Bus Stop Arrangements

In connection with the above bus diversions, the following bus stops will be suspended and temporarily provided:

Appropriate traffic signs and road markings will be erected on site to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.

The Transport Department anticipates that the traffic in the vicinity of the above road sections would be relatively busy. Motorists should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion. Members of the public are advised to watch out for the latest traffic news. Public transport commuters are advised to pay attention to the arrangements of relocation of stops.
