

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Flag Raising Ceremonies to Celebrate the 29th Anniversary of the Establishment of the HKSAR

Notice is hereby given that the following traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Wan Chai North and Tin Hau to facilitate the holding of the Flag Raising Ceremonies to mark the celebration of the 29th Anniversary of the Establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

A. Road Closures

The following sections of roads will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic (except for authorized vehicles) at the times specified below:

(i) From 9.30 am to 12.30 pm on 29 June 2026 and from 0.01 am on 30 June 2026 to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026

- (a) Expo Drive;
- (b) The section of Expo Drive East outside Golden Bauhinia Square;
- (c) Expo Drive Central; and
- (d) The slip road leading from the Central – Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel to Expo Drive.

(ii) From 0.01 am on 30 June 2026 to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026

- (a) The section of Expo Drive East between Expo Drive and Hung Hing Road; and
- (b) The section of Lung Wo Road eastbound between the Wan Chai portal of the Central - Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel and Fleming Road.

(iii) From 5.30 am to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026

- (a) The section of Lung Wo Road westbound between the Wan Chai portal of Central – Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel and Fleming Road; and
- (b) Lung Tat Path.

(iv) From 6.30 am to 8.00 am on 1 July 2026

The section of Tung Lo Wan Road between Causeway Road and Lai Yin Lane.

B. Traffic Diversions

(i) From 9.30 am to 12.30 pm on 29 June 2026 and from 0.01 am on 30 June 2026 to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026

Vehicles from Central heading for Wan Chai will be diverted via Man Po Street, Yiu Sing Street eastbound and Lung Wo Road eastbound.

(ii) From 0.01 am on 30 June 2026 to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026

- (a) Vehicles along Lung Wo Road eastbound heading for Fleming Road and Hung Hing Road will be diverted onto Lung Hop Street southbound or heading for Island Eastern Corridor will continue travelling along Lung Wo Road eastbound to enter Central – Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound; and
- (b) Vehicles making right turn from Lung Hop Street northbound can only enter Central – Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel eastbound via Lung Wo Road eastbound.

(iii) From 5.30 am to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026

Vehicles along Hung Hing Road westbound heading for Lung Wo Road westbound will be diverted via Fleming Road southbound, Fleming Road northbound, Harbour Road westbound, Fenwick Pier Street roundabout, Fenwick Pier Street westbound and Lung Hop Street northbound.

(iv) From 6.30 am to 8.00 am on 1 July 2026

Vehicles along King's Road westbound will be diverted to Causeway Road westbound.

C. Special Public Transport Arrangements

- (i) In connection of the road closures in Wan Chai North, the following bus routes will be temporarily diverted; and the bus terminus at Expo Drive East will be temporarily suspended from 9.30 am to 12.30 pm on 29 June 2026 and from 0.01 am on 30 June 2026 to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026:

D. Suspension of Parking Spaces, Taxi Stands, Fleet Taxi Stopping Place and Pick-up/Drop-off Areas

(i) All metered parking spaces, on-street parking spaces, taxi stand, fleet taxi stopping place and pick-up/drop-off areas at Expo Drive and Expo Drive East

- will be suspended from 9.30 am to 12.30 pm on 29 June 2026 and from 0.01 am on 30 June 2026 to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026;
- (ii) The cross-harbour taxi stand at Harbour Road westbound opposite Harbour Centre will be suspended from 5.30 am to 1.00 pm on 1 July 2026; and
 - (iii) All on-street metered parking spaces (including disabled parking spaces) on Tung Lung Wo Road between Causeway Road and Lai Yin Lane will be suspended from 10.00 pm on 30 June 2026 to 8.00 am on 1 July 2026.

Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles

Motorists are advised that strict enforcements will be taken by the Police, including multiple ticketing and towing of vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic arrangements specified above, without prior notice.

Attention and Appeal

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.

In addition, other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including additional road closures, traffic diversion, alteration and suspension of public transport services may be implemented by the Police at anytime depending on actual traffic and crowd conditions in the areas. Members of the public are advised to avoid driving to the affected or congested areas. Public transport commuters are advised to pay attention to the arrangements of route diversions and suspension or relocation of stops.
