

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Wong Chuk Hang

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate drainage works, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Wong Chuk Hang from 1.00 am to 5.00 am daily on Mondays to Saturdays (except Public Holidays) from 16 to 30 September 2026:

A. Road and Lane Closure

The following road section and traffic lanes will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (a) The section of Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound between Yip Kan Street and Gee Chang Hong Centre;
- (b) The section of left lane of Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound near Nam Long Shan Road;
- (c) The section of right lane of Wong Chuk Hang Road westbound near Yip Hing Street;
- (d) The section of right lane of Nam Long Shan Road northbound between Heung Yip Road and Wong Chuk Hang Road; and
- (e) The section of right lane of Nam Long Shan Road northbound outside Nam Long Shan Road Cooked Food Market.

B. Turning Movement Arrangements

- (a) All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making right turns from Wong Chuk Hang Road westbound onto Yip Hing Street westbound;
- (b) All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making left turns from Yip Hing Street eastbound onto Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound;
- (c) All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making U-turns from Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound onto Wong Chuk Hang Road westbound; and
- (d) The existing banning of all vehicles (except franchised buses) from making right turns from Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound onto Nam Long Shan Road southbound will be temporarily rescinded.

C. Traffic Diversion

- (a) Affected vehicles on Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound will be diverted via Nam Long Shan Road southbound, Heung Yip Road eastbound, Ocean Park Road northbound and the slip road leading to Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound;
- (b) Affected vehicles on Nam Long Shan Road northbound heading for Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound will be diverted via Heung Yip Road westbound, U-turn, Heung Yip Road eastbound, Ocean Park Road northbound and the slip road leading to Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound;
- (c) Affected vehicles on Yip Hing Street eastbound heading for Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound will be diverted via Wong Chuk Hang Road westbound, Nam Long Shan Road southbound, Heung Yip Road eastbound, Ocean Park Road northbound and the slip road leading to Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound; and
- (d) Affected vehicles on Wong Chuk Hang Road westbound heading for Yip Hing Street westbound will be diverted via the unnamed road leading to Heung Yip Road eastbound, Heung Yip Road eastbound, Nam Long Shan Road northbound and Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound.

D. Bus and Green Minibus (“GMB”) Services Arrangements

The following stops of CTB Route Nos. N72, N90, Cross Harbour Route Nos. N170, N171, HKI GMB Route Nos. N4A, N4C and N4X on Wong Chuk Hang Road eastbound will be suspended. A temporary stop will be designated on Heung Yip Road eastbound outside Marina 8 and the routes will be diverted as follows:
