

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TAI O ROAD, LANTAU ISLAND

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 30 April 2021, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily: -

- (i) the northern kerbside lane of Tai O Road from a point about 55 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road connecting Wang Hang Tsuen to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction.
- (ii) the southern kerbside lane of Tai O Road from a point about 45 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road connecting Wang Hang Tsuen to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
