Temporary Traffic and Public Transport Arrangements at the Kai Tak Tunnel

Motorists are advised that to facilitate the regular cleansing, inspection and maintenance works at the Kai Tak Tunnel, the following temporary traffic and public transport arrangements will be implemented on the specified days at the Kai Tak Tunnel:

(I) Road Closure and Traffic Diversion

(i) 5-7, 15, 20 and 27 October 2026

The Tsim Sha Tsui bound of Kai Tak Tunnel will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 1.00 am to 6.00 am daily. One-tube-two-way operation will be implemented at its Kwun Tong bound.

(ii) 8, 12-14, 21 and 26 October 2026

The Kwun Tong bound of Kai Tak Tunnel will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 1.00 am to 6.00 am daily. Affected motorists on East Kowloon Corridor Kwun Tong bound heading for Sung Wong Toi Road and Kowloon East are advised to travel via Kowloon City Road.

(II) Public Transport Service Arrangements

8, 12-14, 21 and 26 October 2026

During the road closure period, Kowloon Green Minibus route no. 62S heading to Lam Tin (Kwong Tin Estate) will be re-routed via Kowloon City Road northbound, Sung Wong Toi Road westbound, Ma Tau Chung Road northbound, Prince Edward Road East eastbound, Kwun Tong Road eastbound, Wai Yip Street southbound, Kai Cheung Road westbound and Wang Kwong Road northbound, before resuming its original routeing.

The tunnel operator may revise the tunnel closure timetable according to its operational needs. Motorists are advised to drive with care and patience. Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. The public transport operator will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.
