Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Wan Chai North and

Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel Westbound

Notice is hereby given that, in order to facilitate road works of Wan Chai Development Phase II, the junction of Fenwick Pier Street with Fenwick Street and Harbour Road will be permanently converted from a signalized junction to a roundabout with effect from 3.00 am on 28 November 2021. The following temporary and permanent traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented:

A. Temporary Road Closure

The following roads will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic at the time specified below:

(i) From 10.00 pm to 11.59 pm on 27 November 2021

Fast lane of Wan Chai (North) Exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound

(ii) <u>From 12.00 midnight to 3.00 am on 28 November 2021</u>

Lung King Street

(iii) From 12.00 midnight to 6.00 am on 28 November 2021

Slow lane of Wan Chai (North) Exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound

(iv) From 12.00 midnight on 28 November 2021 until further notice

The section of Fenwick Pier Street eastbound between Lung King Street northbound and Fenwick Street.

B. Permanent Road Closure

The unnamed road connecting the Wan Chai (North) exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound and Lung King Street will be permanently closed to all vehicular traffic from 12.00 midnight on 28 November 2021.

C. Temporary Traffic Diversions

(i) From 12.00 midnight to 3.00 am on 28 November 2021 (See Figure 1)

- (a) Affected vehicles on the Wan Chai (North) exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound heading for Fenwick Pier Street westbound and Admiralty will be diverted via Lung Wo Road westbound, Lung Hop Street southbound, Fenwick Pier Street southbound, Gloucester Road eastbound and Fenwick Street northbound.
- (b) Affected vehicles on Lung Wui Road eastbound heading for Fenwick Pier Street westbound and Admiralty will be diverted via Fenwick Pier Street southbound, Gloucester Road eastbound and Fenwick Street northbound.
- (c) Affected vehicles on the Wan Chai (North) exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound heading for Harbour Road will be diverted via Lung Wo Road westbound, Lung Hop Street southbound, Fenwick Pier Street southbound, Gloucester Road eastbound and Fleming Road northbound.
- (d) Affected vehicles on Lung Wui Road eastbound heading for Harbour Road will be diverted via Fenwick Pier Street southbound, Gloucester Road eastbound and Fleming Road northbound.

(ii) From 3.00 am to 6.00 am on 28 November 2021 (See Figure 2)

Affected vehicles on the Wan Chai North exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound heading for Fenwick Pier Street westbound, Admiralty and Harbour Road will be diverted via Lung Wo Road westbound, Lung Hop Street southbound, Fenwick Pier Street eastbound, Lung King Street and Fenwick Pier Street roundabout.

(iii) From 3.00 am on 28 November 2021 until further notice (See Figure 2)

Affected vehicles on Lung Wui Road eastbound heading for Fenwick Pier Street westbound, Admiralty and Harbour Road will be diverted via Fenwick Pier Street eastbound, Lung King Street and Fenwick Pier Street roundabout.

D. Permanent Traffic Diversion (See Figure 3)

With effect from 6.00 am on 28 November 2021, affected vehicles on the Wan Chai (North) exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound heading for Fenwick Pier Street westbound, Admiralty and Harbour Road will be diverted via the unnamed road connecting the Wan Chai (North) exit of Central-Wan Chai Bypass Tunnel westbound and Fenwick Pier Street roundabout and Fenwick Pier Street roundabout.
