“Water Taxi” Licensed Ferry Service

Launch of “Tsim Sha Tsui East – Wan Chai – Central – West Kowloon – Central – Wan Chai – Tsim Sha Tsui East” Short-working Route

Members of the public are advised that a new short-working route of “Water Taxi” licensed ferry service will commence operation. “Tsim Sha Tsui East – Wan Chai – Central – West Kowloon – Central – Wan Chai – Tsim Sha Tsui East” short-working route will be operated on Saturdays with effect from 14 January 2023 and on a daily basis during the period from 22 January to 5 February 2023. (i.e. waterfront outside the Golden Bauhinia Square)

Central: Central Ferry Pier No. 9

West Kowloon: Yau Ma Tei Typhoon Shelter Landing No. 2 (i.e. waterfront outside the West Harbour Tunnel Toll Plaza northbound bus stops, near the Hong Kong Palace Museum in the West Kowloon Cultural District)
