

Transport Department Notice

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Wo Hop Shek for Ching Ming Festival 2025

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Wo Hop Shek for Ching Ming Festival:

(A) Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements

I. Road Closures

From 6.00 am to 5.00 pm daily on 22, 23, 29, 30 March, 4, 5, 6, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20 and 21 April 2025, the following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic (except for emergency vehicles and those vehicles specified below):

- (a) Kiu Tau Road (except for hearses, coaches conveying people attending services at the crematorium, vehicles of the undertakers and franchised buses);
- (b) Ming Yin Road (except for franchised buses);
- (c) Wo Ka Lau Road; and
- (d) all access roads within Wo Hop Shek Cemetery.

Members of the public may drive to Wo Hop Shek Cemetery after reopening of the roads until closure of the cemetery (i.e. 7.30 pm) on the above-mentioned days.

II. Banning of Turning Movements

All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from making the following turning movements on 22, 23, 29, 30 March, 4, 5, 6, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20 and 21 April 2025:

- (a) right turning movements from Pak Wo Road northbound near Fung Ying Seen Koon onto Pak Wo Road southbound; and
- (b) right turning movements from Pak Wo Road southbound near MTR Fanling Station into the car park on Pak Wo Road near Fung Ying Seen Koon.

III. Suspension of Car Parks and Parking Spaces

The following car parks and parking spaces will be suspended (except emergency vehicles and those vehicles specified below) from 7.00 am to 5.00 pm daily on 22, 23, 29, 30 March, 4, 5, 6, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20 and 21 April 2025:

- (a) car park at Wo Hing Road near Wah Ming Road roundabout (urban and NT taxis may access to the car park to pick up and set down passengers);

- (b) car park at Pak Wo Road near Fung Ying Seen Koon (except for vehicles with valid disabled person's parking permit or parking certificate for drivers who carry people with mobility disabilities issued by the Transport Department to use the disabled parking space and the public buses operating the Residents' Service Route No. NR112 (Dawning View, Fanling - Fung Ying Seen Koon) to pick up and set down passengers);
- (c) all parking spaces at Wah Ming Lane; and
- (d) all parking spaces at Ming Yin Road between Wo Hop Shek Cemetery Office and Kiu Tau Road.

Depending on the actual situation, the Police may exercise discretion to allow vehicles carrying the elderly and disabled passengers to pick up and set down at the car park at Pak Wo Road near Fung Ying Seen Koon to facilitate interchange with the bus services to Wo Hop Shek Cemetery.

IV. Suspension of Taxi Stands

From 7.00 am to 5.00 pm daily on 22, 23, 29, 30 March, 4, 5, 6, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20 and 21 April 2025, the taxi stand on Lui Ming Road near Wah Ming Bus Terminus will be used by NT taxis only. The taxi stand inside the car park on Pak Wo Road near Fung Ying Seen Koon will be suspended.

Taxis will be allowed to pick up and set down passengers in the car park on Wo Hing Road near Ming Yin Road roundabout during the suspension period.

V. Temporary Bus Stop Arrangements

The following temporary bus stop arrangements will be implemented between 7.00 am and 5.00 pm daily on 30 March, 4, 6 and 13 April 2025:

KMB Route Nos. 73, 73A, 73B and 74D	North District bound	Tai Wo Service Road West northbound near Kiu Tau Road	Relocated about 40 metres northwards

VI. Public Transport Services

- (a) KMB Route No. 73S (Fanling Station – Wo Hop Shek (Kiu Tau Road)) and Route No. 76S (Fanling Station – Wo Hop Shek (Ming Yin Road)) will be operated on 23, 30 March, 4, 6 and 13 April 2025;

- (b) KMB Route No. 61S (Tuen Mun Town Centre – Wo Hop Shek (Ming Yin Road)), Route No. 70S (Hung Hom Station – Wo Hop Shek (Ming Yin Road)), Route No. 74S (Ping Tin – Wo Hop Shek (Ming Yin Road)) and Route No. 279S (Cheung Ching – Wo Hop Shek (Ming Yin Road)) will be operated on 4 April 2025;
- (c) Services of KMB Route Nos. 270A, 270B, 277X, 278X and 279X will be strengthened on 30 March, 4, 6 and 13 April 2025 subject to the passenger demand; and
- (d) Services of KMB Route Nos. 273 and 273A will be strengthened on 23, 30 March, 4, 6, 13, 18, 19, 20 and 21 April 2025 subject to the passenger demand

(B) Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles

Any vehicles found illegally parked in the vicinity of Wo Hop Shek may be towed away by the Police without prior notice.

(C) Attention and Appeal

Members of the public are advised that traffic congestion may occur on roads leading to Wo Hop Shek Cemetery during the festival period. Grave-sweepers are advised to exercise utmost care and patience and to go to the cemetery early or on other non-festival days. As parking facilities in the vicinity of Wo Hop Shek, Sheung Shui and Fanling are extremely limited, members of the public are advised to use public transport and not to drive to the cemetery as far as possible.

Grave-sweepers who wish to drive to the Wo Hop Shek Cemetery are advised to note the opening hours of the cemetery in addition to the road closure periods. The opening hours of the cemetery can be found in the following website:

Actual implementation of and adjustments to road closures, traffic control and traffic diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on conditions in the areas. If necessary, the Police may also implement ad hoc road closure and stopping restrictions on any days and periods not mentioned above.
