

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Shau Kei Wan for Tam Kung Festival

Notice is hereby given that, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Shau Kei Wan on 25 May (Thursday) and 26 May 2023 (Friday) in connection with the Tam Kung Festival:

(I) **Road Closure**

The following sections of roads will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 6.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on 26 May 2023:

- (a) The section of Shau Kei Wan Road between Factory Street and Aldrich Street (except tram service);
- (b) The section of Shau Kei Wan Main Street East between Factory Street and Tung Hei Road (except tram service);
- (c) Tam Kung Temple Road;
- (d) The section of A Kung Ngam Village Road between Tung Hei Road and A Kung Ngam Road;
- (e) The section of Tung Hei Road westbound between its eastern junction with A Kung Ngam Village Road and Mong Lung Street;
- (f) The section of Tung Hei Road eastbound between Oi Lai Street and its eastern junction with A Kung Ngam Village Road;
- (g) The section of Oi Lai Street eastbound between Oi Yin Street and Tung Hei Road;
- (h) Wang Wa Street;
- (i) The section of Factory Street between Shau Kei Wan Main Street East and Wang Wa Street;
- (j) The section of Factory Street eastbound between Mong Lung Street and Shau Kei Wan Main Street East;
- (k) The section of Kam Wa Street between Mong Lung Street and Wang Wa Street; and
- (l) Basel Road.

(II) Traffic Diversion

Vehicles on Tung Hei Road eastbound and Aldrich Bay Road heading for A Kung Ngam and Chai Wan will be diverted via Mong Lung Street, Factory Street, Aldrich Street and Chai Wan Road.

(III) Temporary Arrangements of Bus Service

The following temporary arrangements will be implemented for NWFB Route No. 82X (Siu Sai Wan bound service) from 6.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on 26 May 2023:

(IV) Temporary Arrangement of Shuttle Bus Service

The shuttle buses from Ming Wah Dai Ha to Shau Kei Wan MTR Station will be diverted via A Kung Ngam Road northbound, A Kung Ngam Village Road, Tung Wong Road, A Kung Ngam Road southbound, Chai Wan Road, Aldrich Street, Po Man Street, Mong Lung Street northbound, Tung Hei Road, Oi Lai Street, Oi Yin Street, Aldrich Bay Road and Mong Lung Street southbound from 6.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on 26 May 2023.

(V) Suspension of Public Light Bus Stand and Public Light Bus Parking Space

The public light bus stand and public light bus parking space on Kam Wa Street between Shau Kei Wan Main Street East and Mong Lung Street will be suspended from 8.00 a.m. on 25 May to 6.30 p.m. on 26 May 2023.

(VI) Suspension of Parking Spaces

The parking spaces at the following locations will be suspended from 10.00 p.m. on 25 May to 6.30 p.m. on 26 May 2023:

- (a) The metered parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces and disabled parking spaces on Tung Hei Road between its eastern junction with A Kung Ngam Village Road and Mong Lung Street;

- (b) The metered parking spaces on Shau Kei Wan Main Street East;
- (c) The metered parking spaces on Wang Wa Street; and
- (d) The metered parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces and disabled parking spaces on Kam Wa Street.

(VII) Restriction on Vehicular Access to/from Car Parks on Closed Roads

Vehicular access to and from car parks within the affected areas may not be allowed during the period of road closure.

Attention and appeal

1. Appropriate traffic signs will be provided on site to guide motorists.
2. Actual implementation of and adjustments to road closures, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by the Police depending on condition.
3. Vehicles parked illegally within the affected areas may be towed away by the Police without prior notice.
4. Motorists are advised not to drive to the congested/affected areas, and to drive with utmost care and patience.
5. Motorists should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion, observe the instruction given by the Police; and watch out for the latest traffic news through the media.
