#### **Transport Department Notice**

## Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements on Fanling Highway

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate road works, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on Fanling Highway from 01.00 a.m. to 05.30 a.m. daily on 26, 28 February 2025 and 26 March 2025:

# (1) ROAD CLOSURE

The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic:

- i. The slip road (Exit 7B) leading from Fanling Highway northbound to Pak Wo Road;
- ii. The fast lane of Fanling Highway northbound from a point about 553 metres south of its junction with Heung Yuen Wai Highway near Nam Wa Po to a point about 353 metres south of the same junction;
- iii. The two rightmost lanes of Fanling Highway northbound from a point about 353 metres south of its junction with Heung Yuen Wai Highway near Nam Wa Po to a point about 153 metres south of the same junction;
- iv. The three rightmost lanes of Fanling Highway northbound from a point about 153 metres south of its junction with Heung Yuen Wai Highway near Nam Wa Po to a point about 315 metres north of the same junction;
- v. Three traffic lanes of Fanling Highway northbound from a point about 113 metres south of its junction with Heung Yuen Wai Highway near Kiu Tau Road to a point about 224 metres north of the same junction;
- vi. The slow lane of Fanling Highway northbound from a point about 108 metres north of its junction with Heung Yuen Wai Highway near Kiu Tau Road to a point about 230 metres north of the same junction; and
- vii. The three leftmost lanes of Fanling Highway northbound from a point about 230 metres north of its junction with Heung Yuen Wai Highway near Kiu Tau Road to a point about 950 metres north of the same junction.

#### (2) TRAFFIC DIVERSION

Vehicles on Fanling Highway northbound heading for Pak Wo Road westbound will be diverted via slip road (Exit 7C), Pak Wo Road northbound, Jockey Club Road northbound, Sha Tau Kok Road – Lung Yeuk Tau roundabout, Jockey Club Road southbound and Pak Wo Road southbound.

#### (3) PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES ARRANGEMENTS

#### (A) Franchised Bus Service

i. KMB Route Nos. 270A (Sheung Shui bound), 270S (Luen Wo Hui bound) and 278X (Sheung Shui bound) will be diverted via Lam Kam Road Interchange, Tai Wo Service Road West northbound, Wo Hing Road southbound, Wah Ming Road roundabout and Wah Ming Road northbound before resuming their original routeing; and

ii. KMB Route No. 277X (Luen Wo Hui bound) will be diverted via Lam Kam Road Interchange, Tai Wo Service Road West northbound, Wo Hing Road southbound and Wah Ming Road roundabout before resuming its original routeing. The en-route stop at Wah Ming Road southbound outside Wo Hing Tsuen will be temporarily relocated to Wo Hing Road westbound near Hop Shing Stoneworks.

### (B) Green Minibus Service

i. GMB Route No. 501S (Sheung Shui bound) will be diverted via slip road (Exit 7C), Pak Wo Road northbound, Jockey Club Road northbound, Sha Tau Kok Road – Lung Yeuk Tau roundabout, Jockey Club Road southbound and Pak Wo Road southbound before resuming its original routeing.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. Motorists are advised to follow the instructions on site and drive in utmost care. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.
