<u>Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for</u> LIV Golf 2025 – Hong Kong in Fanling Golf Course

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from 7 March 2025 (Friday) to 9 March 2025 (Sunday) in the North District to facilitate the holding of LIV Golf 2025 - Hong Kong:

I TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS

The following temporary traffic arrangements will be implemented from 7 March 2025 (Friday) to 9 March 2025 (Sunday) when the traffic on Fan Kam Road is congested (See Annex):

In the morning:

- 1. All vehicles on Fanling Highway (westbound) will be banned from travelling onto Fan Kam Road (southbound) via Tai Tau Leng roundabout;
- 2. All vehicles on Po Shek Wu Road (southbound) will be banned from travelling onto Fan Kam Road (southbound) via Tai Tau Leng roundabout;
- 3. All vehicles on Castle Peak Road (Kwu Tong Section) (eastbound) will be banned from right turning onto Fan Kam Road (southbound);
- 4. All vehicles on Po Kin Road (westbound) will be banned from right turning onto Fan Kam Road (southbound); and
- 5. All vehicles on Fan Kam Road (northbound) will be banned from right turning onto Po Kin Road (eastbound).

All affected vehicles will be diverted to Tai Tau Leng roundabout, Fanling Highway (westbound), Pak Shek Au roundabout, Fanling Highway (eastbound) and Tai Tau Leng roundabout to Fan Kam Road (southbound).

In the afternoon:

1. All vehicles on Fan Kam Road (northbound) heading to Tai Tau Leng roundabout will be diverted via Po Kin Road (eastbound).

Police vehicles, emergency vehicles, franchised buses, green minibuses (GMB), taxis, dedicated vehicles arranged by the organizer and vehicles permitted by police on site will not be affected by the above temporary traffic arrangements.

II TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

(1) Shuttle Bus Services Arranged by the Organiser

To facilitate spectators going to Fanling Golf Course, the organiser will provide shuttle bus services plying between Hong Kong Golf Club, Fanling, and Sheung Shui Station and designated locations in urban areas from 7 March 2025 (Friday) to 9 March 2025 (Sunday). Pick-up and drop-off points of the shuttle bus services will be set up at the general lay-bys on Ching Shing Road (northbound) near Ching Hiu Road and Po Kin Road (northbound) near Fan Kam Road. (2) Taxi

Urban and N.T. taxis to and from the Fanling Golf Course, are advised to use the taxi pick-up and drop-off points temporarily set-up at the general lay-bys on Po Kin Road (northbound or southbound) near Fan Kam Road.

(3) Franchised Bus and GMB Services

The bus stop of KMB Route 77K (Sheung Shui Station – Yuen Long (Fung Cheung Road)) at Fanling Golf Course on Fan Kam Road (both bounds) will be suspended from 7 March 2025 (Friday) to 9 March 2025 (Sunday). Affected passengers are advised to use the bus stop at Ping Kong which is about 300 meters north of the original stop.

The service of KMB Route No. 77K and New Territories GMB Route No. 57K (Sheung Shui Station - Tong Kung Leng / Tsiu Keng) will be strengthened on the above-mentioned dates subject to passenger demand.

III. ATTENTION AND APPEAL

Appropriate traffic aids and signs will be provided to guide motorists.

Members of the public who intend to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport, plan their journey early and allow more travelling time to cater for unexpected delay. Motorists are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas. Motorists should also exercise tolerance and patience in cases of traffic congestion and observe the instructions given by the Police.

Depending on the prevailing circumstances, other ad-hoc traffic and public transport measures, including further closures of roads, traffic diversion, alterations and suspension of public transport services, may be implemented on the event dates by the Police at short notice. Members of the public are advised to stay alert to the latest traffic news through the media.
