

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Victoria Park Lunar New Year Fair 2026 (Phase I)

Notice is hereby given that Phase I of the special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in the vicinities of Causeway Bay and Tin Hau to facilitate the holding of the Victoria Park Lunar New Year Fair 2026 from 11 February 2026 to 15 February 2026:-

I. Traffic Arrangements

(A) Road Closure

Depending on the on-site crowd and traffic conditions, the following road closures may be implemented from 8.00 am to 12.01 am on the following day daily between 11 February 2026 and 12 February 2026; and from 8.00 am to 3.00 am on the following day daily between 13 February 2026 and 15 February 2026:

- (a) The unnamed road section at the northern entrance of Park Towers car park (except vehicles accessing to Park Towers carpark);
- (b) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Lau Li Street (except franchised buses and Green Minibuses ('GMB'));
- (c) Lau Li Street between Hing Fat Street and Ngan Mok Street; and
- (d) Part of the traffic lanes of Electric Road between Gordon Road and Yacht Street.

Depending on the on-site crowd and traffic conditions, the road closure area may be extended from 4.00 pm to 12.01 am on the following day daily between 11 February 2026 and 12 February 2026; and from 4.00 pm to 3.00 am on the following day daily between 13 February 2026 and 15 February 2026 to cover the following road sections:

- (a) Paterson Street;
- (b) Great George Street;
- (c) Sugar Street;
- (d) Cleveland Street;
- (e) Kingston Street;
- (f) Gloucester Road northbound between Causeway Road and Great George Street;
- (g) Gloucester Road northbound between Great George Street and Moreton Terrace flyover;
- (h) Gloucester Road southbound between Causeway Road and Causeway Bay flyover;
- (i) Gloucester Road northbound between Great George Street and Gloucester Road westbound (between 13 and 15 February 2026 only);
- (j) Lockhart Road between Percival Street and Cannon Street (between 13 and 15 February 2026 only);

- (k) Jaffe Road between Percival Street and Cannon Street (between 13 and 15 February 2026 only);
- (l) Cannon Street (between 13 and 15 February 2026 only); and
- (m) Gloucester Road southbound (between 13 and 15 February 2026 only).

(B) Implementation of Pedestrianization

Pedestrianization will be implemented on the following road sections from 4.00 pm to 12.01 am on the following day daily between 11 February 2026 and 12 February 2026; and from 12.00 noon to 3.00 am on the following day daily between 13 February 2026 and 15 February 2026:

- (a) Lockhart Road between Cannon Street and East Point Road;
- (b) East Point Road; and
- (c) Great George Street between East Point Road and Paterson Street.

II. Transport Arrangements

(A) Bus Stop Arrangements

The stopping points of the following bus routes will be arranged from 10.00 am on 10 February 2026 to 10.00 am on 17 February 2026:-

- (a) The bus stops at Causeway Road outside Victoria Park will be temporarily re-arranged. The bus routes involved are as follows:

Citybus Routes	2, 2A, 2X, 5X, 8, 8H, 8P, 8X, 10, 15B, 18, 23, 25, 38, 42, 42C, 63, 65, 77, 81, 99, N8, N8P, N8X and N72.
Cross Harbour Routes	103, 112, 116, 170, 600, 601, 601P, 603, 603A, 619, 619X, 621, 671, 673, 673A, 678, 680, 680X, 681, 681P, 690, 690S, 914, 914P, 914X, 948, 948A, 948B, 948P, 948X, 960C, 960P, 960S, 961, 961P, 961S, 968, 968A, A11, E11, E11A, E11B, E11S, N122, N170, N307, N373, N368, N600, N603, N619, N680, N691 and NA11.

- (b) The bus stop for Cross Harbour Route Nos. 102 and 106 (Eastern District bound) at Causeway Road outside Victoria Park will be suspended ; and
- (c) An additional bus stop will be provided for Cross Harbour Route No. 307 (Tai Po Centre bound) at Causeway Road outside Victoria Park.

(B) Suspension and Relocation of Green Minibus (GMB) Stops

The following GMB stops will be suspended / relocated during the above mentioned road closure period:

- (a) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 4A and 4C on Cannon Street will be relocated to Gloucester Road service road near Percival Street and Gloucester Road service road near Cannon Street respectively;
- (b) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 5 and 69X on Lockhart Road will be relocated to Gloucester Road service road near Cannon Street;
- (c) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 10 and 31 on Jaffe Road east of Percival Street will be relocated to Jaffe Road eastbound between Canal Road East and Percival Street; and
- (d) The stop of HKI GMB route no. 25 in Paterson Street will be suspended and it will be converted into circular service.

(C) Suspension of Taxi Stands

- (a) The taxi stand at Lau Li Street will be suspended from 8.00 am to 12.01 am on the following day daily between 11 February 2026 and 12 February 2026; and
- (b) The taxi stands at Lau Li Street and Electric Road will be suspended from 8.00 am to 3.00 am on the following day daily between 13 February 2026 and 15 February 2026.

(D) Suspension of Parking Spaces

- (a) The metered parking spaces on Lau Li Street between Hing Fat Street and Ngan Mok Street will be suspended from 8.00 am to 12.01 am on the following day daily between 11 February 2026 and 12 February 2026; and from 8.00 am to 3.00 am on the following day daily between 13 February 2026 and 15 February 2026; and
- (b) The designated metered parking spaces at Hing Fat Street Public Carpark (except motorcycle parking spaces and parking spaces designated for the disabled) will be suspended at the times specified below (except for authorised vehicles) :-

Parking spaces to be suspended	Periods of suspension
54 metered parking spaces (nos. 1604AB to 1629AB; and 1657AB)	From 8.00 am to 12.00 am daily between 11 and 12 February 2026
85 metered parking spaces (nos. 1604AB to 1657AB)	From 8.00 am to 1.00 am on the following day daily between 13 and 15 February 2026

(E) Restrictions on Access to / Exit from Carparks

Vehicles access to and from all carparks along the above road closure areas may be restricted at short notice during implementation of the above road closure by the Police. Vehicles parked in carparks within the road closure areas may not be permitted to leave the car parks until the road closure is lifted.

III. Attention and Appeal

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected to guide motorists. Notices will also be displayed by public transport operators to advise passengers of the above temporary public transport arrangements. The actual implementation of road closures, traffic control and diversion measures will be exercised or altered by the Police depending on the prevailing crowd and traffic conditions. Strict enforcement on illegal parking, including multiple ticketing and towing, will be taken by Police when necessary. Motorists are advised to be patient when driving in the vicinities and follow the Police's instructions.

The Transport Department anticipates that the traffic in the vicinities of Causeway Bay and Tin Hau will be relatively busy during the holding of the above event. Members of the public are advised to use public transport services as far as possible and avoid driving to the affected areas. Public transport passengers are advised to pay attention to the special public transport arrangements.
