

## **Transport Department Notice**

### **Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Lunar New Year's Eve and Lunar New Year Holidays 2024**

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories during the Lunar New Year's Eve and Lunar New Year Holidays 2024:

#### **I. SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS**

##### **HONG KONG ISLAND (CAUSEWAY BAY, VICTORIA PARK AND TIN HAU)**

###### **(A) Road Closures**

Subject to the prevailing traffic and crowd situation, the following road sections may be closed to all vehicular traffic on 9 February 2024 at different times specified below. The implementation time may be varied if necessary:

###### **(a) From 8.00 am onwards:**

- (i) Electric Road between Lau Li Street and Hing Fat Street (except vehicles accessing to Park Towers car park);
- (ii) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Lau Li Street (except franchised buses ("FBs") and Green Minibuses ("GMBs"));
- (iii) Lau Li Street between Hing Fat Street and Ngan Mok Street; and
- (iv) Part of the traffic lanes of Electric Road between Gordon Road and Yacht Street.

###### **(b) From 4.00 pm onwards:**

- (i) Sugar Street; and
- (ii) Gloucester Road northbound between Causeway Road and Great George Street.

###### **(c) From 5.00 pm onwards:**

- (i) Cleveland Street;
- (ii) Paterson Street;
- (iii) Kingston Street;
- (iv) Great George Street between Paterson Street and Gloucester Road; and
- (v) Jardine's Bazaar.

###### **(d) From 7.00 pm onwards (except FBs, GMBs and trams):**

- (i) Hennessy Road eastbound between Percival Street and East Point Road;
- (ii) Yee Wo Street;
- (iii) The leftmost lane of Pennington Street between Irving Street and Yee Wo Street;
- (iv) Causeway Road eastbound between King's Road and Moreton Terrace;
- (v) Hennessy Road westbound between Jardine's Bazaar and Percival Street;

and

(vi) Irving Street.

**(e) From 8.00 pm onwards:**

- (i) Lockhart Road, east of Percival Street;
- (ii) Jaffe Road, east of Percival Street;
- (iii) Cannon Street; and
- (iv) Shelter Street.

**(f) From 9.00 pm onwards:**

- (i) The leftmost lane of Causeway Road westbound between King's Road (near Queen's College) and Tung Lo Wan Road (near St. Paul's Convent School);
- (ii) Gloucester Road southbound between the down ramp of Victoria Park Road flyover and Causeway Road;
- (iii) Tai Hang Road flyover southbound;
- (iv) Causeway Bay Flyover northbound; and
- (v) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Lau Li Street (except FBs and GMBs).

**(B) Traffic Diversions**

To tie in with the road closures above, the following traffic diversions will be implemented in phases on 9 February 2024 until the closed roads reopen:

**(a) From 5.00 pm onwards:**

- (i) Lau Li Street between Electric Road and Hing Fat Street will be re-routed as one-way westbound and closed to public light buses ("PLB").

**(b) From 9.00 pm onwards:**

- (i) Vehicles heading for Tai Hang Road flyover southbound will be diverted to Victoria Park eastbound, Wing Hing Street and King's Road; and
- (ii) Vehicles heading for Tai Hang Road flyover northbound to Central will be diverted to Tung Lo Wan Road, Moreton Terrace and Leighton Road.

**(C) Pedestrian Precinct**

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic for designation as pedestrian precinct from 4.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 7.00 am the following day:

- (a) Lockhart Road east of Cannon Street;
- (b) East Point Road; and
- (c) Great George Street west of Paterson Street.

**(D) Prohibition to learner drivers**

Learner drivers will be prohibited from entering the following roads from 4.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 8.00 am the following day:

- (a) Leighton Road;
- (b) Tin Lok Lane;
- (c) Caroline Hill Road;
- (d) Eastern Hospital Road;
- (e) Tai Hang Road north of Lai Tak Tsuen Road;
- (f) Tung Lo Wan Road;
- (g) Electric Road south of Gordon Road;
- (h) Morrison Hill Road north of Queen's Road East;
- (i) Hennessy Road;
- (j) Yee Wo Street;
- (k) Causeway Road;
- (l) King's Road;
- (m) Gloucester Road service road;
- (n) Hing Fat Street;
- (o) Tin Hau Temple Road westbound west of Cloud View Road; and
- (p) Wan Chai Road eastbound.

**(E) Suspension of parking spaces, car parks and restriction of vehicle access**

- (a) All vehicles parked in car parks at the above closed roads will not be permitted to enter or leave the car parks until the roads are re-opened for normal traffic;
- (b) The on-street parking spaces, including motorcycle parking spaces, metered parking spaces and parking spaces designated for the disabled, on the following roads will be suspended from 2.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 8.00 am the following day:-
  - (i) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Lau Li Street;
  - (ii) Lau Li Street between Hing Fat Street and Ngan Mok Street;
  - (iii) Electric Road between Gordon Street and Yacht Street;
  - (iv) Tung Lo Wan Road;
  - (v) Lockhart Road between Canal Road East and Cannon Street; and
  - (vi) Jaffe Road between Canal Road East and Cannon Street.
- (c) All parking spaces at Hing Fat Street Public Car Park (except parking spaces designated for the disabled) will be suspended from 8.00 am on 9 February 2024 to 8.00 am the following day.

**(F) Temporary closure of Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange**

Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange will be suspended from 6.00 pm on 9 February 2024. The following arrangement for franchised buses and GMB routes will be implemented:

- (a) XHT route nos. 914, 948, 968 and CTB route no. E11 will terminate on Ngan Mok Street near Ernest Court;
- (b) XHT route no. 307P will depart from Ngan Mok Street near Ernest Court;
- (c) XHT route no. 914 will depart from Tung Lo Wan Road opposite to Queen's College;
- (d) XHT route nos. 948, 968, P968, CTB route nos. E11A and E11B will depart from Causeway Road westbound outside Causeway Bay Sports Ground;
- (e) CTB route no. 25 will omit the stop in Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange;
- (f) HKI GMB route no. 49M will omit Hing Fat Street, Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange, King's Road, Ngan Mok Street, Lau Li Street, and terminate at King's Road westbound near Lau Sin Street; and
- (g) HKI GMB route nos. 56A and 56B will be converted to circular route and omit the stop at Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange. A temporary stop will be set up at Ngan Mok Street.

**(G) Temporary bus stop arrangements**

The bus stops on Victoria Park Road eastbound outside Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter will be suspended from 8.00 pm on 9 February 2024 when necessary.

**(H) Suspension of tram stops**

The following tram stops will be suspended from 8.00 pm onwards on 9 February 2024 when necessary:

- (a) Victoria Park (#42W and #57E);
- (b) Shelter Street (#44W and #55E),
- (c) Pennington Street (#46W), and
- (d) Paterson Street (#48W and #53E).

**(I) Suspension and relocation of GMB stops**

To tie in with the above road closures, the following GMB stands will be suspended as necessary on 9 February 2024:

- (a) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 4C, N4A and N4C on Cannon Street will be relocated to Gloucester Road service road near Percival Street and Gloucester Road service road near Cannon Street respectively;
- (b) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 5 and 69X on Lockhart Road will be relocated to Gloucester Road service road near Cannon Street;

- (c) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 36X, 40, 40X, N40, 56A and 56B on Jardine's Bazaar will be relocated to Pennington Street outside Dragon Rise;
- (d) The stops of HKI GMB route nos. 10, 31 and N31 on Jaffe Road east of Percival Street will be relocated to Jaffe Road eastbound between Canal Road East and Percival Street; and
- (e) The stop of HKI GMB route no. 25 in Paterson Street will be suspended and it will be converted into circular service.

**(J) Suspension of PLB stands**

The PLB stands on Sugar Street and Paterson Street will be suspended from 12.00 pm on 9 February 2024 onwards.

**(K) Suspension of taxi stands**

The following taxi stands will be suspended on 9 February 2024 at the different times specified below:

**(a) From 8.00 am onwards:**

- (i) Lau Li Street; and
- (ii) Electric Road.

**(b) From 12.00 pm onwards:**

- (i) Paterson Street near Great George Street;
- (ii) Paterson Street between Gloucester Road Service Road and Kingston Street;
- (iii) Jaffe Road near Percival Street; and
- (iv) Lockhart Road near Cannon Street.

**(L) Central-Mid-levels Escalator**

The services of the Central to Mid-Levels Escalator and Walkway System will be extended to 3.00 am on 10 February 2024.

**KOWLOON**

**(1) Wong Tai Sin Morse Park**

The following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from 5.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 7.00 am the following day:

**(A) Road closures**

- (a) The eastern egress of Ching Tak Street public light bus and taxi stands near Wong Tai Sin Government Primary School will be closed. Vehicles will be required to use the western egress and turn left into Ching Tak Street westbound for leaving; and
- (b) The section of Ching Tak Street between Lung Cheung Road and Tung Tau Tsuen Road may be closed according to traffic condition, affected vehicles will be diverted to Shatin Pass Road or Junction Road.

**(B) Traffic Control**

- (a) The Police will implement no-stopping restriction in the vicinity of Morse Park No. 3 including Ching Tak Street, Tung Tau Tsuen Road, Shatin Pass Road, Fung Mo Street, Fu Mei Street, Wang Tau Hom East Road, Wang Tau Hom South Road and Wang Tau Hom Central Road; and
- (b) The Police may ban the left-turn movement from Lung Cheung Road westbound into Ching Tak Street southbound and Fung Mo Street southbound depending on traffic condition, affected vehicles will be diverted to Lung Yin Road.

**(C) Suspension of bus and GMB stops**

The bus and GMB stops on Fung Mo Street southbound outside Morse Park Sports Centre for KMB route nos. 1, 7, 11K and 891, XHT route no. 113 and Kowloon GMB route no. 54 will be suspended.

**(D) Taxi stand/drop-off point locations**

- (a) Temporary taxi stand will be provided on Wang Tau Hom East Road southbound outside Wang Hau House;
- (b) The lay-by in Ching Tak Street outside Lung Hei House will be converted to temporary taxi drop-off point; and
- (c) The single lane of the taxi stand at Ching Tak Street outside Lung Hing House will be divided into two lanes, the left lane will be allowed for boarding and alighting passengers whilst the right lane will be allowed for alighting passengers only.

Traffic at the above road sections will be very congested and the number of parking spaces is limited in the vicinity. Members of the public should use public transport services as far as possible. MTR passengers travel to/from Morse Park Lunar New Year's Fair should make use of Lok Fu Station.

**(2) Wong Tai Sin Temple**

The following special traffic arrangements will be implemented from 9 February 2024 to 26 February 2024 to facilitate traffic and crowd control at Wong Tai Sin Temple during the Lunar New Year:

**(A) Road closures**

The following roads will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 7.00 am on 9 February 2024 to 12.01 am on 26 February 2024:

- (a) Shatin Pass Road between Lung Cheung Road and Fung Tak Road (except for GMB services and designated vehicles); and
- (b) The unnamed road connecting Wong Tai Sin Road and Wong Tai Sin Temple will (except for designated vehicles).

**(B) Traffic Control**

All vehicles will be prohibited from parking or waiting at Wong Tai Sin Road (both directions) between Shatin Pass Road and Nga Chuk Street from 7.00 am on 9 February 2024 to 12.01 am on 26 February 2024.

**(C) Suspension of Car Park**

Wong Tai Sin Car Park will be temporarily closed from 12.01 am on 9 February 2024 to 11.59 pm on 13 February 2024 and from 12.01 am on 23 February 2024 to 11.59 pm on 25 February 2024.

**(3) Cheung Sha Wan**

**(A) Temporary relocation of bus stops and GMB stops**

The bus stops and GMB stops on Cheung Sha Wan Road westbound outside Cheung Sha Wan Playground will be temporarily relocated forward for about 150 metres outside SKH Kei Fook Primary School from 10.00 am on 7 February 2024 to 7.00 am on 10 February 2024.

**(B) Suspension of parking spaces**

All metered parking spaces in Hang Cheung Street will be suspended from 8.00 am on 7 February 2024 to 7.00 am on 10 February 2024.

**(C) No parking or waiting**

All vehicles will be temporarily prohibited from parking or waiting (except for picking up/setting off passengers and loading/unloading goods) in Fortune Street, Hang Cheung Street and Fat Tseung Street from 10.00 am on 7 February 2024 to 7.00 am on 10 February 2024.

**(4) Sham Shui Po**

The following special traffic arrangement will be implemented from 11.00 am to 12.00 noon on 11 February 2024, depending on actual traffic and crowd conditions:

**(A) Road Closures**

The following sections of roads will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (a) Wong Chuk Street between Yu Chau Street and Cheung Sha Wan Road;
- (b) Apliu Street between Nam Cheong Street and Wong Chuk Street;
- (c) Nam Cheong Street southbound between Cheung Sha Wan Road and Hai Tan Street;
- (d) Hai Tan Street between Nam Cheong Street and Boundary Street;
- (e) Boundary Street between Hai Tan Street and Yee Kuk Street;
- (f) Yee Kuk Street between Boundary Street and Shek Kip Mei Street; and
- (g) Shek Kip Mei Street between Yee Kuk Street and Apliu Street.

**(B) Traffic Diversion**

Motorists heading for Nam Cheong Street southbound and Shek Kip Mei Street southbound are advised to be diverted via Yen Chow Street southbound and Lai Chi Kok Road eastbound.

**(5) Mong Kok Fa Hui Park**

**(A) Suspension of bus stops**

The bus stops at the following locations will be temporarily suspended on the dates and at the time specified below:

- (a) Boundary Street eastbound outside Fa Hui Park**
  - (i) from 6.00 pm on 7 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day;
  - (ii) from 6.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day; and
  - (iii) from 2.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 12.00 noon the following day.
- (b) Boundary Street eastbound outside Police Sports & Recreation Club**
  - (i) from 6.00 pm on 7 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day;
  - (ii) from 6.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day; and
  - (iii) from 2.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 7.00 am the following day.
- (c) Embankment Road northbound**
  - (i) from 10.00 am on 7 February 2024 to 3.00 am the following day;
  - (ii) from 10.00 am on 8 February 2024 to 3.00 am the following day; and
  - (iii) from 10.00 am on 9 February 2024 to 7.00 am the following day.

**(B) Suspension of GMB pick up/drop-off points**

The GMB pick-up/drop-off points at the following locations will be temporarily suspended on the dates and at the time specified below:

**(a) Boundary Street eastbound outside Fa Hui Park**

- (i) from 6.00 pm on 7 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day;
- (ii) from 6.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day; and
- (iii) from 2.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 12.00 noon the following day.

**(b) Boundary Street eastbound outside Hong Kong Soka Gakkai Institution**

- (i) from 6.00 pm on 7 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day;
- (ii) from 6.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 6.00 am the following day; and
- (iii) from 2.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 7.00 am the following day.

**(c) Embankment Road northbound**

- (i) from 10.00 am on 7 February 2024 to 3.00 am the following day;
- (ii) from 10.00 am on 8 February 2024 to 3.00 am the following day; and
- (iii) from 10.00 am on 9 February 2024 to 7.00 am the following day.

**(C) Temporary PLB pick-up / drop-off point**

A temporary PLB pick-up / drop-off point will be designated at Lincoln Road near Cumberland Road from 7.00 am on 7 February 2024 to 12.00 noon on 10 February 2024.

**(D) Temporary taxi stand**

Temporary taxi stands will be set up on Cumberland Road southbound between Lincoln Road and Boundary Street from 3.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 7.00 am on 10 February 2024.

**(E) Suspension of parking spaces**

The following parking spaces will be temporarily suspended from 8.00 am on 8 February 2024 to 8.00 am on 10 February 2024:

- (a) Metered parking spaces nos. 9607 and 9608 on Tong Yam Street;
- (b) All metered and motorcycle parking spaces on Duke Street between Embankment Road and Knight Street;
- (c) All motorcycle parking spaces on Knight Street near its junction with Duke Street;
- (d) Metered parking space no.13413 on Belfran Road; and
- (e) All metered parking spaces on Lincoln Road between Cumberland Road and Waterloo Road.

**(6) Kwun Tong Recreation Ground**

**(A) Road closures**

The following roads will be closed to all vehicular traffic on the dates and at the time specified below:

**(a) Kai Lim Road**

- (i) from 8.00 pm on 7 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day;
- (ii) from 3.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day; and
- (iii) from 3.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day.

**(b) Fuk Ning Road and Fuk Tong Road**

- (i) from 3.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day; and
- (ii) from 3.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day.

The Police will implement road closure and road re-opening subject to the actual situation and on a need basis.

**(B) Suspension of GMB Stops, Parking Spaces and Taxi Stand**

- (a) The GMB stand, metered parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces, disabled parking space and cross harbour taxi stand on Kai Lim Road will be suspended from 8.00 am on 7 February 2024 to 4.00 am on 10 February 2024; and
- (b) Vehicles parked on the above roadside parking spaces (including the parking spaces designated for the disabled), the metered parking spaces and other offending vehicles during the above period will be towed away.

**(C) Suspension of bus and GMB stops**

The following bus and GMB stops will be suspended from 3.00 pm on 8 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day; and from 3.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day:

- (a) The en-route stop of KMB Route Nos. 11B, 11C, 13M, 89, 89C and 89X near Kwun Tong Swimming Pool on Tsui Ping Road northbound will be suspended;
- (b) The en-route stop of KMB Route Nos. 11B, 11C, 89C, 234C and 234D near Kwun Tong Swimming Pool on Tsui Ping Road southbound will be suspended;
- (c) The bus stops and GMB pick-up/drop-off points on Tsui Ping Road northbound near Fuk Tong Road and Tsui Ping Road southbound outside Kwun Tong Swimming Pool will be suspended;
- (d) The GMB layby on Fuk Tong Road will be closed. During the above period, the following temporary service arrangements will be implemented:

- (i) Kowloon GMB Route No. 47 will not observe Fuk Tong Road and a temporary pick-up / drop-off point will be provided at the layby on Tsui Ping Road southbound outside Tsui Lau House. For Shun Lee bound journeys, the GMB will be diverted via Tsui Ping Road southbound, roundabout outside Tsui Ping South Estate entrance and Tsui Ping Road northbound before resuming its original routeing;
- (ii) Kowloon GMB Route No. 59 will continue to omit Kai Lim Road for Kwun Tong Town Centre bound journeys, and will not observe Fuk Tong Road for Tsui Ping bound journeys. A temporary pick-up / drop-off point will be provided outside Hong Kong Public Records Building on Tsui Ping Road northbound); and
- (iii) Kowloon GMB Supplementary Route No. 59M (Tsui Ping South Estate – Kwun Tong Station) will be suspended.

The en-route stops of the following bus and GMB routes on Lei Yue Mun Road eastbound outside Kwun Tong Swimming Pool will be suspended from 6.00 pm on 9 February 2024 to 4.00 am the following day:

**(a) Bus Routes**

KMB Route Nos. 14, 14B, 14H, 14X, 15, 15A, 15X, 16, 16M, 38, 40A, 42C, 62X, 89D, 93K, 98, 98A, 215R, 215X, 258D, 259D, 277E, 277X, 296A, 296C, X42C and W2, CTB Route Nos. A22 and 796S and XHT Route Nos. 601, 606, 606X, 619, 641, 671 and N619.

**(b) GMB Routes**

Hong Kong GMB route no. 61, Kowloon GMB route no. 62S, New Territories GMB route nos. 10M, 13, 102, 102B, 102S and 103.

**(7) Kwun Tong Hoi Bun Road**

**(A) Suspension of General Pick-up/Drop-off Area**

The general pick-up/drop-off area on Hoi Bun Road westbound near D J Building will be suspended from 10.00 am to 10.00 pm on 11 February 2024.

**(B) Suspension of Parking Spaces**

The following parking spaces will be suspended from 10.00 am to 10.00 pm on 11 February 2024:-

- (a) The metered, motorcycle and disabled parking spaces on Hoi Bun Road westbound near Hoi Bun Road Park; and
- (b) The metered parking spaces on Hoi Bun Road westbound near D J Building.

**(C) Suspension of Bus and GMB Stops**

The en-route stops of the following bus and GMB routes on Hoi Bun Road will be suspended from 7.00 pm to 10.00 pm on 11 February 2024:

**(a) Bus Routes**

The en-route stops of KMB Route Nos. 14X, 15A, CTB Route Nos. 78C and 797 on Hoi Bun Road westbound opposite to Neo and One Bay East.

**(b) GMB Routes**

- (i) The en-route stops of Kowloon GMB Route No. 22A on Hoi Bun Road westbound near Kwun Tong Public Pier and opposite to China Aerospace Centre;
- (ii) The en-route stop of Kowloon GMB Route No. 68 on Hoi Bun Road westbound opposite to Neo; and
- (iii) The en-route stops of Kowloon GMB Route No. 90B on Hoi Bun Road westbound opposite to Neo, opposite to One Bay East and on Hoi Bun Road eastbound near One Bay East.

**(D) Temporary Bus Stop**

A temporary en-route stop will be provided for CTB Route No. 78C on Kwun Tong Road westbound near Meyer Industrial Building from 7.00 pm to 10.00 pm on 11 February 2024.

**NEW TERRITORIES**

**(1) Tsuen Wan**

**(A) Road closures**

The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 8 February and 9 February 2024:

- (a) Kai Hong Close;
- (b) Kai Chi Close;
- (c) The section of Hoi Pa Street between its junction with Lo Tak Court and Tai Ho Road.

**(B) Suspension of motorcycle parking spaces**

The motorcycle parking spaces at Kai Hong Close will be suspended from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 8 February and 9 February 2024.

**(C) Suspension of public light bus stand**

The public light bus stand on Hoi Pa Street outside Wing Tai House will be suspended from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 8 February and 9 February 2024.

**(D) Temporary Relocation/ Suspension of bus stop**

The bus stop on Tai Ho Road northbound outside Princess Alexandra Community Centre will be suspended from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 8 February and 9 February 2024.

**(2) Sheung Shui**

**(A) Pedestrian precinct**

The following road sections will be closed for designation as pedestrian precinct from 11.00 am to 7.00 pm daily on 8 February and 9 February 2024:

- (a) San Kung Street; and
- (b) the section of San Hong Street between Tsun Fu Street and Fu Hing Street.

All vehicles, except emergency vehicles and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from entering the above roads from 11.00 am to 7.00 pm daily on 8 February and 9 February 2024.

**(B) Road closures**

To facilitate the Lunar New Year Fair at Shek Wu Hui, Sheung Shui, the following road sections will be closed from 6.00 pm on 9 February to 4.00 am the following day:

- (a) San Lok Street (except for access to Pearl Vista);
- (b) San Tsoi Street; and
- (c) the section of Fu Hing Street between San Hong Street and San Tsoi Street.

All vehicles, except emergency vehicles and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from entering the above roads from 6.00 pm on 9 February to 4.00 am the following day.

**(C) Suspension of metered parking spaces**

To facilitate the setting up of the pedestrian precinct at Sheung Shui Shek Wu Hui, the metered parking spaces (nos. 25343A&B, 25342 A&B, 25341A and 25344B) at San Hong Street will be temporarily suspended from 11.00 am to 7.00 pm daily on 8 February and 9 February 2024.

### **(B) Cross-boundary Coach Service**

In response to the implementation of 24-hour passenger clearance services at Shenzhen Bay Port from 6.30 am on 9 February 2024 to 12.00 midnight on 14 February 2024, cross-boundary coach operators will arrange additional services via the Shenzhen Bay Port at urban areas (including Prince Edward, Yau Ma Tei, Tsim Sha Tsui and Wan Chai) during early-morning hours.

### **III. REMOVAL OF ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES**

Motorists are advised that strict enforcements will be taken by the Police, including multiple ticketing and towing of vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic arrangements specified above, without prior notice.’

### **IV. ATTENTION AND APPEAL**

Appropriate traffic aids and signs will be provided to guide motorists. Public transport operators will also display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements. Actual implementation of and adjustments to road closures, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on conditions in the areas.

Members of the public who intend to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport services as far as possible, plan their journey early and allow more travelling time to cater for unexpected delay. Members of the public are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas. Motorists should exercise tolerance and patience in cases of traffic

congestion, observe the instructions given by the Police; and watch out for the latest traffic news through media.

#### **V. SPECIAL APPEAL OF SPECIAL BOUNDARY-CROSSING ARRANGEMENTS AND ASSOCIATED PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES**

On the evening of 11 February 2024 (the second day of the Lunar New Year), only the service of MTR East Rail Line plying between Admiralty and Lo Wu will be extended. Other MTR lines and the connecting public transport services will maintain their normal operating hours. Members of the public are advised to pay attention to the details of the public transport services concerned and plan their journeys ahead. They may contact the relevant public transport operators for assistance, if needed.

The Transport Department anticipates that there may be a number of cross-boundary passengers using public transport services to travel via the land boundary control points during Lunar New Year's Eve and Lunar New Year Holidays. As the waiting time for public transport services may be longer, passengers should observe order and heed advice from the on-site Police and staff of the concerned public transport service operators. Cross-boundary coach passengers are also advised to plan their journeys and reserve coach tickets ahead.

During the mentioned period, there may be special traffic arrangements implemented for Lok Ma Chau Control Point to facilitate public transport vehicles to enter the control point more smoothly.
