

Transport Department Notice

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements for Chinese New Year's Eve and Chinese New Year Holidays 2026

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories during the Chinese New Year's Eve and Chinese New Year Holidays 2026:

I. SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS

HONG KONG ISLAND (CAUSEWAY BAY, VICTORIA PARK AND TIN HAU)

(A) Road Closures

Depending on the on-site crowd and traffic conditions, the following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic on 16 February 2026 at the times specified below:

- (a) From 4.00 pm to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:**
 - (i) Sugar Street; and
 - (ii) Gloucester Road northbound between Causeway Road and Great George Street.

- (b) From 7.30 pm to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:**
 - (i) Great George Street between Paterson Street and Gloucester Road;
 - (ii) Kingston Street;
 - (iii) Paterson Street; and
 - (iv) Cleveland Street.

Subject to the prevailing traffic and crowd situation, the road closure area may be extended from 8.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to cover the following road sections:

- (a) Gloucester Road southbound between Cleveland Street and Causeway Road;
- (b) Gloucester Road northbound between Gloucester Road Flyover and Victoria Park Road;
- (c) Hing Fat Street between Causeway Road and Lau Li Street (except franchised buses and Green Minibus ('GMB'));
- (d) Electric Road between Yacht Street and Hing Fat Street;
- (e) Hennessy Road eastbound between Percival Street and Yee Wo Street (except franchised buses, Green Minibus ('GMB') and trams);
- (f) Yee Wo Street eastbound between Hennessy Road and Causeway Road (except franchised buses, Green Minibus ('GMB') and trams);
- (g) Causeway Road eastbound between Yee Wo Street and Tung Lo Wan Road (except franchised buses, Green Minibus ('GMB') and trams); and
- (h) Causeway Road westbound between Tung Lo Wan Road and Moreton Terrace (except franchised buses, Green Minibus ('GMB') and trams).

(B) Pedestrian Precinct

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic for designation as pedestrian precinct from 12.00 noon to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:

- (a) Lockhart Road between Cannon Street and East Point Road;
- (b) East Point Road; and
- (c) Great George Street between East Point Road and Paterson Street.

(C) Prohibition to learner drivers

Learner drivers will be prohibited from entering the following roads from 4.00 pm to 8.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:

- (a) Leighton Road;
- (b) Tin Lok Lane;
- (c) Caroline Hill Road;
- (d) Eastern Hospital Road;
- (e) Tai Hang Road north of Lai Tak Tsuen Road;
- (f) Tung Lo Wan Road;
- (g) Electric Road south of Gordon Road;
- (h) Morrison Hill Road north of Queen's Road East;
- (i) Hennessy Road;
- (j) Yee Wo Street;
- (k) Causeway Road;
- (l) King's Road;
- (m) Gloucester Road service road;
- (n) Hing Fat Street;
- (o) Tin Hau Temple Road westbound west of Cloud View Road; and
- (p) Wan Chai Road eastbound.

(D) Suspension of parking spaces, car parks and restriction of vehicle access

- (a) All vehicles parked in car parks at the above closed roads will not be permitted to enter or leave the car parks until the roads are re-opened for normal traffic;
- (b) The on-street parking spaces, including motorcycle parking spaces, metered parking spaces and parking spaces designated for the disabled, on Lau Li Street between Hing Fat Street and Ngan Mok Street; and the parking spaces designated for the disabled on Gloucester Road northbound near Sugar Street will be suspended from 8.00 am to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026;

- (c) The on-street parking spaces, including motorcycle parking spaces, metered parking spaces and parking spaces designated for the disabled, on Tung Lo Wan Road will be suspended from 8.00 pm to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026; and
- (d) All parking spaces at Hing Fat Street Public Car Park (including parking spaces designated for the disabled) will be suspended from 8.00 am to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026.

(E) Temporary closure of Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange

Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange will be suspended from 6.00 pm on 16 February 2026. The following arrangement for franchised buses and GMB routes will be implemented:

- (a) XHT route nos. 914, 948, 968 and CTB route no. E11 will terminate on Ngan Mok Street near Ernest Court;
- (b) XHT route no. 307P will depart from Ngan Mok Street near Ernest Court;
- (c) XHT route no. 914 will depart from Tung Lo Wan Road opposite to Queen's College;
- (d) XHT route no. 948, CTB route nos. E11A and E11B will depart from King's Road westbound outside Hing Hon Building ;
- (e) XHT route nos. 968 and P968 will depart from Causeway Road westbound outside Causeway Bay Sports Ground;
- (f) CTB route no. 25 will omit the stop in Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange;
- (g) HKI GMB route no. 49M will omit Hing Fat Street, Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange, King's Road, Ngan Mok Street, Lau Li Street, and terminate at King's Road westbound near Lau Sin Street; and
- (h) HKI GMB route nos. 56A and 56B will be converted to circular route and omit the stop at Tin Hau Public Transport Interchange. A temporary stop will be set up at Ngan Mok Street.

(F) Suspension of GMB stops

To tie in with the above road closures, the stop of HKI GMB route no. 25 in Paterson Street will be suspended and it will be converted into circular service from 7.30 pm to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026.

(G) Suspension of PLB stands

The PLB stands on Sugar Street and Paterson Street will be suspended from 12.00 noon to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026.

(H) Suspension of taxi stands

- (a) The taxi stand at Lau Li Street will be suspended from 8.00 am to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026; and
- (b) The taxi stands at Paterson Street will be suspended from 12.00 noon to 7.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026.

(I) Central-Mid-levels Escalator

The services of the Central to Mid-Levels Escalator and Walkway System will be extended to 3.00 am on 17 February 2026

KOWLOON

(1) Wong Tai Sin Temple

The following special traffic arrangements will be implemented from 6.00 pm on 16 February to 9.00 pm on 17 February 2026, from 7.00 am to 7.00 pm daily from 18 February 2026 to 23 February 2026, from 28 February 2026 to 1 March 2026; and from 7.00 am to 9.00 pm on 3 March 2026 to facilitate traffic and crowd control at Wong Tai Sin Temple during the Chinese New Year:

(A) Road closures

The following roads will be closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (a) Shatin Pass Road between Lung Cheung Road and Fung Tak Road (except for GMB services and designated vehicles); and
- (b) The unnamed road leading from Wong Tai Sin Road to Wong Tai Sin Temple (except for designated vehicles).

(B) Traffic Control

All vehicles will be prohibited from parking or waiting at Wong Tai Sin Road (both directions) between Shatin Pass Road and Nga Chuk Street.

(2) Sham Shui Po Kwan Tai Temple

The following special traffic arrangement will be implemented from 2.00 pm to 3.00 pm on 18 February 2026, depending on actual traffic and crowd conditions:

(A) Road Closures

The following sections of roads will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (a) Wong Chuk Street between Yu Chau Street and Cheung Sha Wan Road;
- (b) Apliu Street between Nam Cheong Street and Wong Chuk Street;

- (c) Nam Cheong Street southbound between Cheung Sha Wan Road and Hai Tan Street;
- (d) Hai Tan Street between Nam Cheong Street and Boundary Street;
- (e) Yee Kuk Street between Boundary Street and Shek Kip Mei Street; and
- (f) Shek Kip Mei Street between Yee Kuk Street and Apliu Street.

(B) Traffic Diversion

Motorists heading for Nam Cheong Street southbound and Shek Kip Mei Street southbound are advised to be diverted via Yen Chow Street southbound and Lai Chi Kok Road eastbound.

(3) Kwun Tong Hoi Bun Road

(A) Suspension of Parking Spaces

The following parking spaces will be suspended from 3.00 pm on 18 February 2026 to 1.00 am the following day:-

- (a) All metered parking spaces on Hoi Bun Road will be suspended;
- (b) 2 nos. of parking spaces designated for people with disabilities on Hoi Bun Road eastbound near Hoi Bun Road Park will be suspended; and
- (c) 10 nos. of motorcycle parking spaces on Hoi Bun Road westbound near Kwun Tong Promenade will be suspended.

(B) Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand on Hoi Bun Road eastbound near Hoi Bun Road Park will be suspended from 3.00 pm on 18 February 2026 to 1.00 am the following day.

(4) Kwun Tong Recreation Ground

(A) Road Closure

From 8.00 pm on 14 February 2026 to 4.00 am on 17 February 2026, the following roads will be temporarily closed on the dates and at the time specified below:

- (1) From 8.00 pm on 14 February 2026 to 2.00 am of the following day; from 3.00 pm on 15 February 2026 to 2.00 am of the following day; and from 3.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 4.00 am of the following day, Kai Lim Road will be temporarily closed; and
- (2) From 3.00 pm on 15 February 2026 to 2.00 am of the following day; and from 3.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 4.00 am of the following day, Fuk Ning Road and Fuk Tong Road will be temporarily closed.

The Police will implement road closure and road re-opening subject to the actual situation and on a need basis.

(B) Suspension of GMB Stops, Parking Spaces and Taxi Stand

The Green Mini-bus (GMB) stand, Public Light Bus stand, metered parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces, disabled parking space and cross harbour taxi stand on Kai Lim Road will be suspended from 8.00 am on 14 February 2026 to 4.00 am on 17 February 2026.

Vehicles parked on the above roadside parking spaces (including the disabled parking space), the metered parking spaces and other offending vehicles during the above period will be towed away.

(C) Public Transport Arrangement

Stage 1

From 7.30 am on 14 February 2026 to 4.00 am on 17 February 2026:

- GMB Route No. 59 will omit Kai Lim Road for Kwun Tong Town Centre bound journeys.

Stage 2

From 3.00 pm on 15 February 2026 to 2.00 am of the following day; and from 3.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 4.00 am of the following day:

- The GMB layby on the new unnamed road between Fuk Tong Road and Kwun Tong Road will be closed. During the above period, the following temporary service arrangements will be implemented:
 - (a) Kowloon GMB Route No. 47 will not observe the new unnamed road between Fuk Tong Road and Kwun Tong Road and a temporary pick-up / drop-off point will be provided at the layby on Tsui Ping Road southbound outside Tsui Lau House. For Shun Lee bound journeys, the GMB will be diverted via Tsui Ping Road southbound, roundabout outside Tsui Ping South Estate entrance and Tsui Ping Road northbound before resuming its original routing;
 - (b) Kowloon GMB Route No. 59 will continue to omit Kai Lim Road for Kwun Tong Town Centre bound journeys, and will not observe the new unnamed road between Fuk Tong Road and Kwun Tong Road for Tsui Ping bound journeys. A temporary pick-up / drop-off point will be provided outside Hong Kong Public Records Building on Tsui Ping Road northbound; and
 - (c) Kowloon GMB Supplementary Route No. 59M (Tsui Ping South Estate – Kwun Tong Station) will be suspended.
- The en-route stop of KMB Route Nos. 11B, 11C, 13M, 89, 89C and 89X near Kwun Tong Swimming Pool on Tsui Ping Road northbound will be suspended;
- The en-route stop of KMB Route Nos. 11B, 11C, 89C, 234C and 234D near Kwun Tong Swimming Pool on Tsui Ping Road southbound will be suspended; and
- The bus stops and GMB pick-up/drop-off points on Tsui Ping Road northbound near Fuk Tong Road and Tsui Ping Road southbound outside Kwun Tong Swimming Pool

will be suspended.

Stage 3

From 6.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 4.00 am of the following day:

- The en-route stops of the following bus and GMB routes on Lei Yue Mun Road eastbound outside Kwun Tong Swimming Pool will be suspended:

I. Bus Routes

(5) Kai Tak Shing Fung Road

(A) Suspension of Parking Spaces

All metered parking spaces and parking space designated for people with disabilities at Runway Park Pier, Kai Tak will be suspended from 3.00 pm on 18 February 2026 to 1.00 am on the following day.

NEW TERRITORIES

(1) Tsuen Wan

(A) Road closures

The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 15 February and 16 February 2026:

- (a) Kai Hong Close;
- (b) Kai Chi Close;
- (c) The section of Hoi Pa Street between its junction with Lo Tak Court and Tai Ho Road.

(B) Suspension of motorcycle parking spaces

The motorcycle parking spaces at Kai Hong Close will be suspended from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 15 February and 16 February 2026.

(C) Suspension of public light bus stand

The public light bus stand on Hoi Pa Street outside Wing Tai House will be suspended from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 15 February and 16 February 2026.

(D) Suspension of bus stop

The bus stop on Tai Ho Road northbound outside Princess Alexandra Community Centre will be suspended from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 15 February and 16 February 2026.

(E) Suspension of metered parking spaces

To facilitate the crowd control operation, the metered parking spaces (nos. 20177A&B, 20178A&B, 20179A&B, 20180A, 20183B, 20184A and 20184B) at Hoi Pa Street will be temporarily suspended from 3.00 pm to 5.00 am the following day daily on 15 February and 16 February 2026.

(2) Sheung Shui

(A) Pedestrian precinct

The following road sections will be closed for designation as pedestrian precinct from 11.00 am to 7.00 pm daily from 14 to 16 February 2026:

- (a) San Kung Street; and
- (b) the section of San Hong Street between Tsun Fu Street and Fu Hing Street.

All vehicles, except emergency vehicles and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from entering the above roads from 11.00 am to 7.00 pm daily from 14 to 16 February 2026.

(B) Road closures

The following road sections will be closed from 6.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 4.00 am of the following day:

- (a) San Lok Street (except for access to Pearl Vista);
- (b) San Tsoi Street; and
- (c) the section of Fu Hing Street between San Hong Street and San Tsoi Street.

All vehicles, except emergency vehicles and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from entering the above roads from 6.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 4.00 am of the following day.

(C) Suspension of metered parking spaces

To facilitate the setting up of the pedestrian precinct at Sheung Shui Shek Wu Hui, the metered parking spaces (nos. 25343A&B, 25342 A&B, 25341A and 25344B) at San Hong Street will be temporarily suspended from 11.00 am on 14 February 2026 to 7.00 pm on 16 February 2026.

(D) Suspension of motorcycle parking spaces

The motorcycle parking spaces at San Lok Street will be suspended from 6.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 4.00 am the following day.

(3) Tuen Mun

(A) Road closures

The following sections of roads will be intermittently closed to all vehicular traffic from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026, except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police on site:

- (a) The section of Tin Hau Road from its junction with Pui To Road to its junction with the vehicular access of Yip Wong Shopping Centre;
- (b) San Hop Lane;
- (c) The section of Hung Cheung Road from its junction with Tin Hau Road to its southern junction with San Ping Circuit;
- (d) The section of Hung Cheung Road southbound between its northern and southern junction with San Ping Circuit;
- (e) The section of San On Street from its southern junction with Hung Cheung Road to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction; and
- (f) The section of Hing Wong Street from its junction with Hung Cheung Road to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction.

(B) Traffic diversions

The following temporary traffic arrangements will be intermittently implemented from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026, except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police on site:

- (a) All vehicles on Yip Wong Road will be banned from entering the section of Tin Hau Road northbound north of its junction with the vehicle access of Yip Wong Shopping Centre;
- (b) All vehicles on Pui To Road will be banned from entering Tin Hau Road southbound; and
- (c) The section of Hung Cheung Road between its northern and southern junction with San Ping Circuit will be converted to one-way northbound.

(C) Temporary bus routes arrangement

In connection with the temporary road closures and traffic diversions, the following temporary bus routes arrangement will be implemented from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:

In connection with the temporary road closures and traffic diversions, the following temporary bus stops arrangement will be implemented from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:

(E) Suspension of overnight parking spaces

In connection with the temporary road closures, the overnight on-street parking spaces on the following roads will be suspended from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026, except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police on site:

- (a) Tin Hau Road; and
- (b) The section of Hung Cheung Road from its junction with Tin Hau Road to its southern junction with San Ping Circuit.

(F) Prohibition of illegal parking

Illegally parked vehicles on the following roads will be prosecuted or towed without prior notice by police from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026, except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police on site:

- (a) The section of Tin Hau Road from its junction with Pui To Road to its junction with the vehicular access of Yip Wong Shopping Centre ;
- (b) San Hop Lane;
- (c) Hung Cheung Road ;
- (d) The section of San On Street from its southern junction with Hung Cheung Road to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction; and
- (e) The section of Hing Wong Street from its junction with Hung Cheung Road to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction.

(G) Provision of temporary vehicle pick-up and drop-off point

The following temporary pick-up and drop-off points will be provided from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:

- (a) Tin Hau Road near its junction with San Hop Lane; and
- (b) Tin Hau Road near its junction with Yip Wong Road,

(H) Closure of cycle track

The section of cycle track along the western riverside of Tuen Mun River Channel between Pui To Road and Yau Oi Bridge will be closed from 6.00 pm to 6.00 am of the following day on 16 February 2026.

(4) Kwai Tsing

(A) Suspension of parking spaces

The metered parking spaces and parking spaces designated for the disabled at Ko Fong Street will be suspended from 2.00 pm on 15 February to 8.00 am on 17 February 2026.

(5) Tai Po

(A) Closure of cycle track

The cycle track on Ting Kok Road between Ting Tai Road and On Chee Road will be temporarily closed from 6.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 7.00 am the following day.

(B) Road Closures

Part of the road sections of Ting Kok Road southbound between Ting Tai Road and On Chee Road will be temporarily closed from 6.00 pm on 15 February 2026 to 12.00 midnight the following day, and from 6.00 pm on 16 February 2026 to 7.00 am the following day.

(6) Sha Tin

(A) Traffic Diversions

The following temporary traffic arrangements will be implemented daily from 5.00 pm to 1.00 am the following day on 15 and 16 February 2026 (except for police vehicles, emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police on site):

- (a) The section of Fung Shun Street between Wo Che Street and Tak Hau Street will be converted from two-way traffic to one-way northbound traffic. Affected vehicles will be diverted via Tak Hau Street (eastbound), Yuen Wo Road (southbound) and Wo Che Street (westbound); and
- (b) All vehicles will be prohibited from heading straight from Tak Hau Street onto Sha Tin Sports Ground Car Park.

(B) Suspension of Taxi Stand

The taxi stand on Tak Hau Street near Wo Che Plaza will be suspended daily from 5.00 pm to 1.00 am the following day on 15 and 16 February 2026

(C) Suspension of Bus and Green Minibus (“GMB”) Stops

The following bus and/or GMB stops will be suspended daily from 5.00 pm to 1.00 am the following day on 15 and 16 February 2026:

- (a) The bus stop on Wo Che Street near Luk Chuen House; and
- (b) The bus and GMB stop on Fung Shun Street near Fung Wo Estate Wo Yue House.

The following bus and GMB stop will be suspended from 6.00 pm to 1.00 am the following day on 16 February 2026:

- (a) The bus and GMB stop on Yuen Wo Road (northbound) near Lek Yuen Estate.

(D) Public Transport Arrangements

The following public transport arrangements will be implemented daily from 5.00 pm to 1.00 am the following day on 15 and 16 February 2026:

- (a) KMB route nos. 48X (Tsuen Wan (Bayview Garden) bound) and 81 (Jordan (West Kowloon Station) bound) will be diverted via Tak Hau Street and Yuen Wo Road (southbound) before resuming to their original routings; and
- (b) The bus stop of KMB route nos. 89 (Lek Yuen bound) and 269D (Lek Yuen bound) on Wo Che Street will be temporarily relocated from Luk Chuen House, Lek Yuen Estate, to Sau Chuen House, Lek Yuen Estate.

(7) Tseung Kwan O

(A) **Suspension of parking spaces**

The parking spaces on Wan Lung Road will be suspended from 7.00 am on 16 February 2026 to 7.00 am on 17 February 2026.

(B) **Temporary Vehicle Pick-up and Drop-off Point**

A temporary vehicle pick-up and drop-off point will be set up at Hok Lam Lane from 7.00 am on 16 February 2026 to 7.00 am on 17 February 2026.

(E) Cross-boundary Coach Service

Short-haul cross-boundary coach services plying between Huanggang Port and major points in urban areas (such as Jordan, Prince Edward and Wan Chai etc.) will be enhanced during Chinese New Year’s Eve and Chinese New Year Holidays subject to passenger demand.

Members of the public can enquire about the details from relevant cross-boundary coach operators.

III. REMOVAL OF ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES

Motorists are advised that strict enforcements will be taken by the Police, including multiple ticketing and towing of vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic arrangements specified above, without prior notice.’

IV. ATTENTION AND APPEAL

Appropriate traffic aids and signs will be provided to guide motorists. Public transport operators will also display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements. Actual implementation of and adjustments to road closures, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on conditions in the areas.

Members of the public who intend to go to the affected areas are advised to use public transport services as far as possible, plan their journey early and allow more travelling time to cater for unexpected delay. Members of the public are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas. Motorists should exercise tolerance and patience in cases of traffic congestion, observe the instructions given by the Police; and watch out for the latest traffic news through media.

V. SPECIAL APPEAL OF CROSS-BOUNDARY PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES

The Transport Department anticipates that there may be a large number of cross-boundary passengers using public transport services to travel via the land-based boundary control points during Chinese New Year’s Eve and Chinese New Year Holidays. As the waiting

time for public transport services may be longer during peak periods of cross-boundary travel, passengers should avoid travelling during peak hours, observe order while queuing and heed advice from the on-site Police and staff of the concerned public transport service operators. Passengers intending to take cross-boundary coaches are also advised to plan their journeys and reserve coach tickets ahead.

During the mentioned period, there may be special traffic arrangements implemented at Lok Ma Chau Control Point and Shenzhen Bay Port to secure smooth access for public transport vehicles to the above control points.

VI. SPECIAL APPEAL OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES FOR THE AIRPORT AND HONG KONG PORT OF HONG KONG-ZHUHAI-MACAU BRIDGE (“HONG KONG PORT”)

The Transport Department anticipates that there may be a number of travelers travel to/from the Airport and the Hong Kong Port during Chinese New Year Holidays, therefore the public transport services concerned will be enhanced to cater for the passenger demand when necessary. Passengers are advised to plan their journeys ahead and travel by public transport services to the Airport and the Hong Kong Port.
