

Transport Department Notice

Invitation for Operating the Package of Public Light Bus (Scheduled) Route

Notice is hereby given that applications are invited under regulation 4(2) of the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Regulations (Chapter 374D) for the issue of passenger service licence for the operation of the following package of public light bus (scheduled) route. The particulars are set out below:

Package No.	New Territories Public Light Bus (Scheduled) Route	Maximum Full Fare (\$)	Minimum Vehicle Requirement
1	Fanling North to Kwu Tung North	12.8	6

All public light buses to be deployed for the provision of the scheduled service in respect of the above route must have passenger seat belts and high back passenger seats complying with the applicable requirements stipulated in the Road Traffic (Construction and Maintenance of Vehicles) Regulations (Cap. 374A) and Road Traffic (Safety Equipment) Regulations (Cap. 374F) installed before the date of service commencement.

The application document is obtainable, free of charge, on request from the following Transport Department (“TD”) offices, and available for download from the TD website (https://www.td.gov.hk/en/transport_in_hong_kong/public_transport/minibuses/index.html) as from **2 January 2026**:

- (1) The TD New Territories Regional Office, 7th Floor, Mongkok Government Offices, 30 Luen Wan Street, Mong Kok, Kowloon;
- (2) The TD Public Light Bus Section, 11th Floor, South Tower, West Kowloon Government Offices, 11 Hoi Ting Road, Yau Ma Tei, Kowloon;
- (3) The TD Urban Regional Office (Hong Kong), 37th Floor, Immigration Tower, 7 Gloucester Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong; and
- (4) The TD Hong Kong Licensing Office, 3rd Floor, United Centre, 95 Queensway, Hong Kong

Applications must be made by way of the appropriate application form (“**Application for Passenger Service Licence in respect of the Package of Public Light Bus (Scheduled) Route Gazetted in January 2026**”). Completed application forms and relevant supporting documents (one (1) original and three (3) legible photocopies) must be submitted in a plain envelope sealed and marked on the outside of the envelope with “**Application for Passenger Service Licence in respect of the Package of Public Light Bus (Scheduled) Route Gazetted in January 2026**” and placed in the **TD Tender Box** situated at the reception counter of the Transport Department Headquarters on the 10th Floor of South Tower, West Kowloon Government Offices, 11 Hoi Ting Road, Yau Ma Tei,

Kowloon before **12:00 noon on 27 February 2026 (Friday)**. If a black rainstorm warning signal, tropical cyclone warning signal no. 8 or above, or “extreme conditions after super typhoons” announced by the Government is/are in force for any duration between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on 27 February 2026, the application closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the next working day. Applications made by other means or late submissions will not be considered.

The Government reserves the right to modify the routes and details of operation contained in the relevant Gazette notice and does not bind itself to accept any such application received.
