

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Pok Fu Lam, Aberdeen and Happy Valley for Ching Ming Festival 2026

Notice is hereby given that, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Pok Fu Lam, Aberdeen and Happy Valley during the Ching Ming Festival 2026 to facilitate grave-sweeping activities.

(A) Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements

(I) Pok Fu Lam

(i) Traffic direction

The section of Consort Rise between Victoria Road and Bisney Road will be converted to one-way southbound by the Police from 7.00 am to 5.30 pm daily on 21, 22, 28 and 29 March, 3 to 7, 11, 12, 18 and 19 April depending on the traffic conditions in the vicinity of the cemeteries.

(ii) Bus services

(a) Provision of special bus services

Special bus routes will be operated on the following dates and the bus services will be strengthened subject to passenger demand and traffic conditions:-

(b) Enhancement of bus services

Service of CTB Route No. 43M (Tin Wan Estate to Shek Tong Tsui (Des Voeux Road West Near Hill Road) (Circular)) will be strengthened subject to passenger demand and traffic conditions on 28 and 29 March, 3 to 7, 11 and 12 April.

(c) Bus stop arrangement

Additional bus stops at Pok Fu Lam Road outside and opposite to HKCCCU Pok Fu Lam Road Cemetery will be provided for CTB Route No. 33X on 28 and 29 March, 3 to 7, 11 and 12 April.

(iii) Suspension of parking spaces

4 metered parking spaces (meter nos. 3941A, 3941B, 3942A and 3942B) and 3 motorcycle parking spaces at Victoria Road near Consort Rise will be temporarily suspended from 7.00 am to 5.30 pm daily on 21, 22, 28 and 29 March, 3 to 7, 11, 12, 18 and 19 April.

(II) Aberdeen

(i) Road closures

Peel Rise in the vicinity of Aberdeen Chinese Permanent Cemetery and the slip road leading from Shek Pai Wan Road to Aberdeen Chinese Permanent Cemetery will be closed to all vehicular traffic by the Police depending on the traffic conditions in the vicinity of the cemetery during the following periods:

- (a) from 7.00 am to 5.30 pm daily on 21, 22, 28 and 29 March, 3, 4, 6, 7, 11, 12, 18 and 19 April; and
- (b) from 7.30 am to 6.30 pm on 5 April.

(ii) Bus services

(a) Provision of special bus services

CTB Route No. 347 (Admiralty Station (West) Bus Terminus to Chinese Christian Cemetery / Aberdeen (Circular)) will be operated from 3 to 7 April and the service may be strengthened subject to passenger demand and traffic conditions.

(b) Enhancement of bus services

Services of CTB Route No. 43M will be strengthened subject to passenger demand and traffic conditions.

(III) Happy Valley

Relocation of tram stop

The tram stop on Wong Nai Chung Road northbound opposite to the Hong Kong Jockey Club will be relocated about 30 meters northward from 7.00 am to 7.00 pm on 5 April.

(B) Attention and Appeal

1. Appropriate traffic aids or signs will be erected to guide motorists.
2. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.
3. Actual implementation and adjustments to road closures, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by the Police during Ching Ming Festival depending on road condition. Police officers will be on-site to guide the motorists.
4. Motorists are advised not to drive to the congested and affected areas. In case of traffic congestion, motorists should exercise tolerance and patience and observe the instruction given by the Police, and watch out for the latest traffic news through the media.
5. Motorists are advised that, any vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic arrangements may be towed away by the Police without prior notice.
6. Grave-sweepers are advised to plan their journey early and allow more travelling time, and use public transport services as far as possible.
