Public Transport Service Arrangements for Concert Event at Kai Tak Sports Park

A concert event will take place at the Kai Tak Sports Park ("KTSP") on 24 to 27 April. Audiences of the event are advised to use the MTR Sung Wong Toi Station or Kai Tak Station to get to / from the KTSP as far as possible.

There will be no parking space or pick-up/drop-off area for private cars at the KTSP on the event days, motorists are advised to avoid driving to the affected areas and follow the instructions given by the Police on site.

Railway services

The service headway of the MTR Tuen Ma Line and East Rail Line will be enhanced during the dispersal period on the event days. Empty trains will be arranged to meet the additional demand.

Of note, for cross-boundary travellers, the last train to Lo Wu Station via interchanging at Tai Wai Station on the East Rail Line will depart from Sung Wong Toi Station at 10.59 pm and Kai Tak Station at 11.01 pm. Travellers who miss the last train to Lo Wu Station may take the East Rail Line to Sheung Shui Station and then the KMB route no. 276B or N73 to Lok Ma Chau (San Tin) Public Transport Interchange, and transfer to the Lok Ma Chau-Huanggang cross-boundary shuttle bus ("Yellow Bus") for their journey to Mainland.

Special bus route services

After the event on each day, a total of 11 special bus routes will be provided at the Sung Wong Toi Road Special Bus/Taxi Pick-up/Drop-off Area, service will be provided from about 15 minutes after event finishes and the last departure will depart about one hour after event finishes:

Cross-boundary travellers can take Route No. SP12 to Lok Ma Chau (San Tin) Public Transport Interchange and transfer to the Yellow Bus for their journey to the Mainland; or take Route No. A25S to HZMB Hong Kong Port and transfer to HZMB shuttle bus (Gold Bus) for their return to Macao or Zhuhai, or departing from Hong Kong via the airport respectively.

Temporary Suspension of Bus Stop

To facilitate the implementation of temporary traffic arrangements by Police, the bus stop at To Kwa Wan Road near Grand Waterfront Plaza will be temporarily suspended from 9.30 pm to 11.59 pm daily on the event days. Affected bus routes are as follows:

Cross-boundary coach services

Cross-boundary travellers can take cross-boundary coach services to Lok Ma Chau / Huanggang Port after the event on each day and passengers could board their coach at the coach pick-up/set-down zone on G/F of Kai Tak Stadium, via the escalator outside Gate H, 2/F.

The tickets for cross-boundary coach services to Lok Ma Chau / Huanggang Port will only be sold in advance and the sale of tickets will cease at 9 p.m. on the event date, and there will be no on-site ticketing after the event. Passengers who will make use of cross-boundary coach services travel to the Mainland after concerts should purchase tickets in advance.

Port traffic arrangement

Subject to actual traffic conditions, special traffic arrangements may be implemented at Lok Ma Chau Control Point / Shenzhen Bay Port from 24 April to early morning of 28 April 2025 to allow smooth access of public transport vehicles to above control points. Cross-boundary private cars may need to queue up for crossing the control points.

Motorists are advised to pay extra attention to variable message signs and traffic signs along the road. They are also advised to be patient in case of traffic congestion, and follow the instructions of the on-site Police.

Taxi services

On the event days, the Sung Wong Toi Road Special Bus/Taxi Pick-up/Drop-off Area will be opened from 2.00 pm to 12.00 midnight for taxi pick-up/drop-off. The waiting time will be longer amid an outflux of spectators during dispersal and passengers' patience is appreciated. The KTSP Limited will open the Taxi Drop-off Area at Kai Tak Stadium and Kai Tak Arena during admission phase for drop-off only.

Depending on the actual traffic and crowd conditions, Police may implement temporary traffic arrangements in the area. Members of the public are advised to exercise tolerance and patience and take heed of the instructions given by the Police.

Special appeal to cross-boundary travellers

In anticipation of the large number of cross-boundary travellers returning to the Mainland after the concert, the Lok Ma Chau / Huanggang Port is expected to be very busy and the clearance time will be longer. The TD urges travellers returning to the Mainland to take the MTR trains departing from Sung Wong Toi Station before 10.59 pm and Kai Tak Station before 11.01 pm to Lo Wu Station on the ERL via interchanging at Tai Wai Station if possible.

Members of the public may use the “HKeMobility” mobile application for pre-trip planning and point to point public transport, driving and walking route enquiry.

On the event days, spectators are advised to take heed of the real-time information via on-site broadcast and the "Easy Leave" (easyleave.police.gov.hk) as well as the latest traffic news through the TD's website (www.td.gov.hk), the "HKeMobility" mobile application, radio and television broadcasts.
