

Transport Department Notice

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Kwai Tsing District for Ching Ming Festival 2026

Notice is hereby given that the following traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in the vicinity of the Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery and Crematorium for the Ching Ming Festival 2026:

(A) Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements

I. Traffic Arrangements

From 7.00 am to 5.00 pm on 29 March, 5, 6 and 12 April 2026, the following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (a) Wing Tak Street southbound from entrance of City Point to its junction with Wing Shun Street, Wing Yin Street and the section of Wing Shun Street between Wing Tak Street and Kwai Hei Street will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic (except for hearses, franchised buses, taxi, green minibuses and emergency vehicles).
- (b) The section of Wing Kei Road between Kwai Hei Street and Wing Kin Road will be converted into one-way southbound. Vehicles will be prohibited to enter Wing Kei Road from Kwai Hei Street.
- (c) Wing Hau Street will be closed to all vehicular traffic (except for emergency vehicles).

In addition, Wing Yin Street and Wing Hau Street will be closed to all vehicular traffic (except for hearses, franchised buses and emergency vehicles) from 7.00 am to 5.00 pm on 28 March, 3, 4, 7, 11 and 18 April 2026.

II. Temporary Taxi Stands

From 7.00 am to 5.00 pm on 29 March, 5, 6 and 12 April 2026, temporary taxi stands will be provided at the following locations:

- (a) Wing Kin Road near its junction with Wing Kei Road;
- (b) Kwai Hei Street near its junction with Wing Shun Street;
- (c) Wing Shun Street near its junction with Wing Yin Street; and
- (d) Wing Shun Street near its junction with Yi Lok Street.

The above arrangements in I and II will be implemented on any other dates if traffic situation so requires.

III. Public Transport Services

- (a) KMB route no. 38S

A special bus service of route no. 38S will be operated from 7.15 am to 6.00 pm on 29 March, 5 and 12 April 2026 between Kwai Fong Station (Kwai Yan Road) and Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery.

(b) GMB routs no. 404M

A short-working GMB service of route no. 404M will be operated from 7.00 am to 5.00 pm on 22, 29 March, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 19 and 26 April 2026 between Kwai Fong Station (Hing Ning Road) and Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery (Wing Shun Street).

(B) Attention and Appeal

During the festive period, grave-sweepers are advised to use public transport services to Tsuen Wan Chinese Permanent Cemetery and Crematorium. No parking will be permitted on any approach roads in the vicinity of the Cemetery and Crematorium. Any vehicle found parking on these roads will be towed away without prior notice.

Appropriate traffic signs will be provided on-site to guide motorists. Depending on the crowd and traffic conditions in the area, the Police may vary the implementation details of the above traffic and transport arrangements.
