

## Transport Department Notice

### Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements on Tsuen Wan Road, Kwai Chung

Members of the public are advised that to facilitate vehicular bridge construction works, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented on Tsuen Wan Road during the periods as specified below:

(A) From 0.01 am to 1.00 am on 24 May 2026

(I) Road Closure

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic:

- The fast lane of Tsuen Wan Road eastbound from about chainage marker 15.3 to about chainage marker 14.8; and
- The middle lane of Tsuen Wan Road eastbound from about chainage marker 15.2 to about chainage marker 14.8.

(B) From 1.01 am to 6.00 am on 24 May 2026

(I) Road Closure

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic:

- The flyover section of Tsuen Wan Road eastbound from about chainage marker 15.0 to about chainage marker 14.6;
- Part of the traffic lanes of Tsuen Wan Road eastbound from about chainage marker 15.3 to about chainage marker 15.0; and
- The slow lane of Tsuen Wan Road eastbound from a point about 164 metres east of its junction with Tsuen Tsing Interchange to a point about 474 metres east of the same junction.

(II) Traffic Diversion

- Affected vehicles on Tsuen Wan Road eastbound heading for Kowloon will be diverted to travel via Hing Fong Road northbound, Kwai Fuk Road eastbound, roundabout, Kwai Fuk Road westbound, Hing Fong Road southbound, slip road and Tsuen Wan Road eastbound;
- Affected vehicles on Tsuen Wan Road eastbound heading for Lai Chi Kok and Mong Kok will be diverted to travel via Kwai Tsing Road southbound, Kwai King Road eastbound, Kwai Tai Road eastbound, Container Port Road South southbound, Kwai Chung Interchange, Kwai Chung Road southbound and Cheung Sha Wan Road eastbound;
- Affected vehicles on Tsuen Wan Road eastbound heading for Kwun Tong and Sha Tin will be diverted to travel via Kwai Tsing Road southbound, Kwai King Road eastbound, Kwai Tai Road eastbound, Container Port Road South southbound and Ching Cheung Road eastbound; and
- Affected vehicles on Tsuen Wan Road eastbound heading for Tsim Sha Tsui and Hong Kong (West) will be diverted to travel via Kwai Tsing Road southbound, Kwai King Road eastbound, Kwai Tai Road eastbound, Container Port Road South southbound, Mei Ching Road eastbound, Lin Cheung Road eastbound and West Kowloon Highway eastbound.

(III) Public Transport Arrangements

In connection with the temporary road closures and traffic diversions, the following bus and green minibus (“GMB”) routes will be diverted with details as follows:
