

Traffic Advice

Service Enhancement of CTB Route Nos. 78X, 79X, 679 and 979

Members of the public are advised that Citybus Limited will enhance the services of CTB Route Nos. 78X (Queens Hill – Kai Tak) and 79X (Queens Hill – Nam Cheong Station) from 17 July 2022 (Sunday); and will enhance the services of CTB Route Nos. 679 (Queens Hill – Hong Kong Station Public Transport Interchange) and 979 (Queens Hill – Hong Kong Station Public Transport Interchange) from 18 July 2022 (Monday) with details as follows:

CTB Route No. 78X

(i) To extend the operating hours to half-day services on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays)

- The first departure from Queens Hill will be advanced to 5.40 am and the operating hours will be extended to 4.30 pm; and
- The first departure from Kai Tak will be advanced to 12.00 noon and the operating hours will be extended to 9.00 pm.

(ii) To introduce services on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays

- The departures from Queens Hill will be operated from 5.40 am to 7.30 pm; and
- The departures from Kai Tak will be operated from 11.20 am to 8.20 pm.

(iii) To add an en-route bus stop

- A new en-route bus stop at Kwun Tong Ferry Bus Terminus will be added for all departures of both bounds to facilitate passengers to commute to Kwun Tong area.

CTB Route No. 79X

(i) To extend the operating hours

- The first departure from Queens Hill daily will be advanced to 5.35 am; and
- The last departure from Queens Hill will be extended to 5.40 pm on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays).

(ii) To strengthen the services

- Departures from 9.00 am to 5.40 pm on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays) from Queens Hill will be strengthened to 30-40 minutes headway; and
- Departures from 10.00 am to 6.00 pm on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays) from Nam Cheong Station will be strengthened to 30 minutes headway.

CTB Route No. 679

(i) To strengthen the services

- An additional departure from Queens Hill will be provided at 7.30 am on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays). The first departure from Queens Hill will be advanced to 7.00 am.

(ii) To introduce return service

- A departure from Hong Kong Station Public Transport Interchange to Queens Hill will be introduced at 7.15 pm on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays).

CTB Route No. 979

(i) To introduce return service

- A departure from Hong Kong Station Public Transport Interchange to Queens Hill will be introduced at 6.10 pm on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays).
