TRAFFIC ADVICE

SPECIAL TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS IN SHA TIN FOR THE HOLDING OF THE 7TH HONG KONG GAMES THE JOCKEY CLUB VITALITY RUN

Members of the public are advised that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented to facilitate the holding of the 7th Hong Kong Games The Jockey Club Vitality Run hold on 10 March 2019 (Sunday):

I. SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENT

A. Road and Cycle Track Closure

(a) The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic (except for emergency vehicles) during the time specified below:

From 5.00 am to 10.30 am

- i. the section of Yuen Wo Road southbound between Sha Tin Rural Committee Road and Fo Tan Road;
- ii. the section of Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound between Yuen Wo Road and Tai Chung Kiu Road:
- iii. the section of Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound between Sha Tin Rural Committee Road and Fo Tan Road; and
- iv. the section of Fo Tan Road westbound between Yuen Wo Road and Tai Chung Kiu Road.

From 8.30 am to 9.30 am

- v. the sections of Yuen Wo Road north of New Territories Fire Command Headquarters (near Hong Kong Sports Institute).
 - (b) The following cycle track sections will be closed during the time specified below:

From 5.00 am to 10.30 am:

the section of cycle track along the western riverside of Shing Mun River Channel between the Twin Bridge (located near Sha Tin Sewage Treatment Works) and Sha Tin Rural Committee Road.

B. TRAFFIC DIVERSION

During the aforementioned road closure period, the following traffic diversions will be implemented:

- i. Motorists on Yuen Wo Road southbound or Fo Tan Road eastbound heading to Sha Tin Central will be diverted to travel via Fo Tan Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound and Yuen Wo Road northbound; and
- ii. Motorists on Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound or Yuen Wo Road northbound heading to Tai Chung Kiu Road / Sha Tin Wai Road are advised to travel via Yuen Wo Road Northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound, and Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound; and
- iii. Motorists on Sha Tin Wai Road westbound or Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound heading to Ma On Shan / City One Shatin / Kwong Yuen areas are advised to travel via Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound, Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound; and
- iv. Motorists on Sha Tin Road westbound or Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound heading to Fo Tan Road / Yuen Wo Road are advised to travel via Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound and Yuen Wo Road northbound.

During the above cycle track closure period, cyclist may use the cycle track along the Banyan Bridge, Tai Chung Kiu Road and Twing Bridge to travel between Sha Tin, Tai Po or Ma On Shan.

II. PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES ARRANGEMENTS

A. Bus and Green Minibus ("GMB") Route Diversion

During the aforementioned road closure period, the following bus and GMB route diversions will be implemented:

i. KMB routes no. 80M (Kowloon Tong bound), 85 (Kowloon City Ferry bound), 280X (Tsim Sha Tsui East bound) on Fo Tan Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound and Yuen Wo Road southbound before resuming their normal routeings;

- ii. KMB routes no. 81K (Sun Tin Wai bound) and 88K (Hin Keng bound) on Fo Tan Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road southbound and Sha Tin Central Bus Terminus before resuming their normal routeings;
- iii. KMB route no. 88X (Ping Tin bound) on Fo Tan Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound, Sha Tin Station Circuit, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound, Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road westbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound and Sha Tin Wai Road eastbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- iv. GMB routes no. 60K (Sha Tin Station bound) and 62K (Sha Tin Station bound) on Fo Tan Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road southbound and Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- v. KMB routes no. 48X (Bayview Garden bound) and 269D (Tin Fu bound) on Wo Che Street eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road westbound, Tai Po Road southbound and Sha Tin Central Bus Terminus before resuming their normal routeings;
- vi. KMB routes no. 81 (Jordan West Kowloon Station bound) and 89 (Kwun Tong Station bound) on Wo Che Street eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road westbound, Tai Po Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound and Yuen Wo Road southbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- vii. GMB route no. 61S (Mong Kok Station bound) on Tak Hau Street eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound and Sha Tin Road southbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- viii. KMB route no. 72 (Cheung Sha Wan bound) on Tai Po Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound and Yuen Wo Road southbound before resuming its normal routeing;
 - ix. KMB routes no. N73 (Sha Tin Central B/T bound) and N271 (Hung Hom Station bound) on Tai Po Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road southbound and Sha Tin Central Bus Terminus before resuming its normal routeing;
 - x. KMB routes no. 40X (Kwai Chung Estate bound), 80K (Sun Chui bound), 85K (Sha Tin Station bound) and LWB route no. NA40 (HZMB Hong Kong Port bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound and Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound before resuming its normal routeing;

- xi. KMB route no. 43X (Tsuen Wan bound) and LWB route no. A41P (Airport bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound and Tai Po Road southbound before resuming its normal routeing;
- xii. KMB route no. 72A (Tai Wai bound) and GMB route no. 501S (Kwun Tong bound) on Yuen Wo Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Fo Tan Road eastbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound before resuming its normal routeing;
- xiii. KMB route no. 73A (Fanling bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound, Tai Po Road northbound and Fo Tan Road westbound before resuming its normal routeing;
- xiv. KMB route no. 86 (Mei Foo bound) and GMB route no. 810 (Sha Tin Central bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound and Yuen Wo Road southbound before resuming its normal routeing;
- xv. GMB routes no. 65K (Fo Tan bound), 801 (Fo Tan Cheung Lek Mei Street bound), 811 (Sui Wo Court bound), 811A (Greenwood Terrace bound) and 811S (Sui Wo Court bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road southbound, Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound, Yuen Wo Road northbound and Fo Tan Road westbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- xvi. KMB routes no. 49X (Kwong Yuen bound), 284 (Ravana Garden bound), 299X (Sai Kung bound) and GMB route no. 65A (Wong Nai Tau bound) on Yuen Wo Road northbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- xvii. KMB routes no. 47X (Chun Shek bound), 81K (Sun Tin Wai bound), LWB route no. E42 (Pok Hong bound) and Cross Harbour bus route no. N170 (Wah Fu bound) on Wang Pok Street eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road southbound, Tam Kon Po Street westbound, Sha Tin Centre Street southbound, Pak Hok Ting Street southbound, Sha Tin Centre Street southbound, Lion Rock Tunnel Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound and Sha Tin Wai Road eastbound before resuming its normal routeing;
- xviii. KMB route no. 88 (Sau Mau Ping Central bound), 249X (Pok Hong B/T bound) and NWFB route no. 798 (Tiu Keng Leng bound) from Sha Tin Central Bus Terminus will be re-routed to operate via Sha Tin Centre Street southbound, Pak Hok Ting Street southbound, Sha Tin Centre Street southbound, Lion Rock Tunnel Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound and Sha Tin Wai Road eastbound before resuming its normal routeing;

- xix. KMB routes no. 86K (Kam Ying Court bound) and 89X (Kwun Tong Station bound) on Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- xx. Cross Harbour bus route no. 170 (Wah Fu bound) on Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Tai Po Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound and Sha Tin Wai Road eastbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- xxi. GMB routes no. 67A (Shek Mun Estate bound) and 67K (A Kung Kok bound) on Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- xxii. GMB route no. 809K (Shui Chuen Au Street bound) on Sha Tin Rural Committee Road eastbound will be re-routed to operate via Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound, Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound and Yuen Chau Kok Road eastbound before resuming its normal routeing;
- xxiii. KMB route no. 74A (Tai Wo bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound will be re-routed to operate via Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound and Yuen Wo Road northbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- xxiv. KMB routes no. 81C (Yiu On bound), 86C (Lee On bound) and LWB route no. A41 (Yu Chui Court bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound will be re-routed to operate via Sha Tin Wai Road eastbound, Sha Tin Road northbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound before resuming their normal routeings;
- xxv. GMB routes no. 803 (Lee On bound) and 804 (Kwong Yuen bound) on Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound will be re-routed to operate via Sha Tin Rural Committee Road westbound, Yuen Wo Road northbound, Fo Tan Road eastbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound before resuming their normal routeings; and
- xxvi. KMB route no. 85A (Kwong Yuen bound), N281 (Kam Ying Court Bound), Cross Harbour bus route no. 182 (Yu Chui Court bound) and N182 (Kwong Yuen Bound) on Sha Kok Street northbound will be re-routed to operate via Sha Tin Wai Road eastbound, Sha Tin Road northbound and Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound before resuming their normal routeings;

B. Suspension of Bus and Green Minibus (GMB) Stops

During the aforementioned road closure period, the following bus and GMB Stops will be suspended:

- i. the stop on Yuen Wo Road southbound outside Sha Tin Sports Ground for KMB routes no. 40X, 72, 72A, 80K, 80M, 81K, 85, 85K, 86, 88K, 88X, 280X, N73, N271and LWB route NA40; and GMB routes no. 60K, 62K and 810;
- ii. the stop on Yuen Wo Road southbound outside Sha Tin Jockey Club Swimming Pool for KMB routes no. 40X, 48X, 72, 72A, 80K, 80M, 81, 81K, 85, 85K, 86, 88K, 88X, 89, 269D, 280X, N73, N271 and LWB route NA40; and GMB routes no. 60K, 61S, 62K, 501S and 810;
- iii. the stop on Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound opposite Regal Riverside Hotel for KMB routes no. 49X, 74A, 81C, 85A, 86C, 86K, 89X, 284, 299X, N281, LWB route A41, Cross Harbour bus route no. 182 and N182; and GMB routes no. 65A, 67A, 67K, 803 and 804; and
- iv. the stop on Tai Chung Kiu Road northbound opposite to Belair Gardens for KMB routes no. 49X, 74A, 81C, 85A, 86C, 86K, 89X, 284, 299X, N281, LWB route A41, Cross Harbour bus route no. 182 and N182; and GMB routes no. 65A, 67A, 67K, 803 and 804.

C. Provision of Temporary Bus and Green Minibus (GMB) Stops

During the aforementioned road closure period, the following temporary bus and GMB Stops will be provided:

- i. Two temporary stops will be provided for KMB routes no. 49X, 74A, 88X, 284, 299X, and GMB routes 65A, 67A, 67K, 803 and 804 on Yuen Wo Road northbound outside Baptist Lui Ming Choi Secondary School and Wo Che Shopping Centre;
- ii. A temporary stop will be provided for KMB routes no. 40X, 72A, 80K, 85K and 86 and GMB route no. 810 on Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound outside Belair Gardens;
- iii. A temporary stop will be provided for KMB routes no. 40X, 72A, 80K, 85K and 86 and GMB routes no. 501S and 810 on Tai Chung Kiu Road southbound outside Garden Rivera;

- iv. A temporary stop will be provided for LWB route no. A41 on Sha Tin Wai Road eastbound outside Greenfield Court; and
- v. A temporary stop will be provided for KMB route no. N281, Cross Harbour route no. 182 and N182 on Sha Tin Wai Road outside Shatin Park.

Actual implementation of the road and cycle track closures, traffic control and public transport diversions will be made by police officers on site at the time depending of the traffic and crowd condition. Appropriate traffic signs will be provided and police officers will be stationed on site to guide public. Bus companies and Green Minibus operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above special transport arrangements.
