

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (CHAPTER 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN HIN KENG STREET, TAI WAI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 am on 31 July 2020, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Hin Keng Street from a point about 36 metres west of its junction with Keng Hau Lane to a point about 48 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the section of the unnamed road leading to Ka Keng Court from a point about 7 metres north of its junction with Hin Keng Street;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Hin Keng Street from a point about 40 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Keng Hau Lane from a point about 40 metres south of its junction with Hin Keng Street;
- (e) the eastern kerbside lane of Keng Hau Lane from a point about 16 metres south of its junction with Hin Keng Street;
- (f) the section of the unnamed road leading to Ka Tin Court from a point about 14 metres south of its junction with Hin Keng Street;
- (g) the northern kerbside lane of Hin Keng Street from a point about 70 metres east of its junction with the unnamed road leading to Ka Tin Court;
- (h) the southern kerbside lane of Hin Keng Street from a point about 88 metres east of its junction with the unnamed road leading to Ka Tin Court;
- (i) the western kerbside lane of Hin Tin Street from a point about 56 metres south of its junction with Hin Keng Street;
- (j) the eastern kerbside lane of Hin Tin Street from a point about 16 metres south of its junction with Hin Keng Street; and
- (k) the eastern kerbside lane of Hin Tin Street from a point about 37 metres north of its junction with the unnamed road leading to Helen Liang Memorial Secondary School.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
