

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Tuen Mun District for Tin Hau Festival 2024

Notice is hereby given that the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Tuen Mun District on 1 May 2024 during the periods specified below to tie in with the celebration activities for Tin Hau Festival:

(A) Road Closure

Depending on the actual finishing time of the event and subsequent re-opening of the roads for traffic, the following road sections will be closed to all motor vehicles, except for emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police officers on site from 7.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.:

- (a) San Wo Lane;
- (b) San Tak Street;
- (c) The section of Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road southbound between Castle Peak Road – San Hui and Pui To Road; and
- (d) Luk Yuen Street.

(B) Traffic Diversion

Depending on the actual finishing time of the event and subsequent re-opening of the roads for traffic, the following temporary traffic diversion will be implemented, except for emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police officers on site from 7.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.:

- (a) Vehicles on Castle Peak Road – San Hui northbound heading for Yuk Hong Street eastbound, Choi Yee Bridge Road westbound, Tsing Yin Street eastbound, Ho Pong Street westbound and Yan Ching Street both bounds via Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road southbound will be diverted via Castle Peak Road – San Hui northbound, Tseng Choi Street southbound, Tseng Choi Street eastbound, Castle Peak Road – San Hui southbound, Pui To Road westbound and Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road northbound; and
- (b) Vehicles on Castle Peak Road – San Hui southbound heading for Yuk Hong Street eastbound, Choi Yee Bridge Road westbound, Tsing Yin Street eastbound, Ho Pong Street westbound and Yan Ching Street both bounds via Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road southbound will be diverted via Castle Peak Road – San Hui southbound, Pui To Road westbound and Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road northbound.

(C) Public Transport Arrangements

Depending on the actual finishing time of the event and subsequent re-opening of the roads for traffic, the following temporary transport arrangements will be implemented from 7.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.:

GMB Route Nos. 43, 43S, 43A, 43B and 43C	to Tuen Mun South	via Ho Pong Street westbound, Tsing Yin Street northbound, Tsing Yin Street eastbound, Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road northbound, Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road eastbound, Castle Peak Road – San Hui southbound, Pui To Road westbound and Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road southbound	The GMB Stop of the routes will not be affected

(D) Intermittent Road Closure

The following roads will be intermittently closed to all motor vehicles, except for emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police officers on site:

(I) From 7.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

- (a) The section of Tin Hau Road between Pui To Road and Yip Wong Road;
- (b) The section of Hung Cheung Road between its southern junctions with San Ping Circuit and Tin Hau Road;
- (c) The section of Hung Cheung Road southbound between its southern and northern junctions with San Ping Circuit;

- (d) The section of San On Street from its southern junction with Hung Cheung Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction;
- (e) San Hop Lane; and
- (f) The section of Hing Wong Street from its junction with Hung Cheung Road to a point about 30 metres north of the same junction.

(II) From 7.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.

- (a) The section of Pui To Road westbound between Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road and Tin Hau Road.

(III) From 1.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

- (a) The section of Pui To Road eastbound between Tsun Wen Road and Ho Pong Street; and
- (b) Ho Pong Street northbound.

(E) Traffic Control

The section of Hung Cheung Road between its southern and northern junctions with San Ping Circuit will be converted to one-way northbound with effect from 7.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m., except for emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by Police officers on site.

(F) Cycle Track Closure

The section of cycle track along the western riverside of Tuen Mun River Channel between Pui To Road and Yau Oi Bridge will be temporarily closed from 7.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

(G) Suspension of Metered Parking Spaces

The following metered parking spaces will be suspended except for emergency vehicles and vehicles permitted by police officers on site:

(I) From 7.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.

- (a) All metered parking spaces on San Wo Lane;
- (b) All metered parking spaces in the carpark on San Wo Lane;
- (c) All metered parking spaces on San Tsing Street;
- (d) All metered parking spaces on Luk Yuen Street; and
- (e) All metered parking spaces on Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road northbound opposite to San Hui Playground.

(II) From 7.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

- (a) All metered parking spaces in the carpark outside Tuen Mun Hung Cheung Road Sitting-out Area.

(H) Removal of Illegally Parked Vehicles

Any vehicles found illegally parked within the following locations from 7.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. will be prosecuted and towed away by the Police without prior notice:

- (a) San Wo Lane;
- (b) San Tak Street;
- (c) Tuen Mun Heung Sze Wui Road;

- (d) Yuk Hong Street;
- (e) Tsing Yin Street;
- (f) San Tsing Street;
- (g) Ho Pong Street;
- (h) Luk Yuen Street;
- (i) Yan Ching Street;
- (j) Pui To Road;
- (k) Tin Hau Road;
- (l) San Hop Lane;
- (m) San On Street;
- (n) Hing Wong Street;
- (o) Hung Cheung Road;
- (p) San Ping Street;
- (q) San Lik Street; and
- (r) Yip Wong Road.

(I) Attention and Appeal

Appropriate traffic signs will be provided on site and police officers will be on-site to guide motorists and cyclists. Actual implementation of and adjustments to the above traffic and transport arrangements will be made by the Police at the time depending on the prevailing circumstances, traffic and crowd conditions in the areas.

Motorists and cyclists should exercise tolerance and patience, and observe the instruction given by the Police.
