## Extension of Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangement at Kam Sheung Road Station Public Transport Interchange, Yuen Long

To facilitate the Kam Sheung Road Station Phase One Property Development, the following traffic and transport arrangement will continue to be implemented at Kam Sheung Road Station Public Transport Interchange until 31 December 2020. Details are as follows:

## (A) Green Minibus

#### (B) <u>KMB</u>

Bus route nos. 54, 64K, 64S, 77K and 251A (drop-off only) will continue using the middle of the lay-by at the westernmost carriageway of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange (behind of Bus Stop of the Cross-boundary Coach).

Bus route nos. 54, 64K and 77K (To Yuen Long) will continue using the third easternmost bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

Bus route nos. 54, 64K, 64S and 77K (To Sheung Shui and Tai Po) will continue using the fourth easternmost bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

The exiting bus stop of bus route no.251A remains unchanged (at the second easternmost bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange).

# (C) The NT Taxi

The stand will continue using the front of the first easternmost bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

# (D) The Urban Taxi

The stand will continue using the rear of the first easternmost bay of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

# (E) The Cross-boundary Coach Service

The stand will continue using the front of the lay-by at carriageway at the westernmost side of the Temporary Public Transport Interchange.

Appropriate traffic signs will be placed on site to guide passengers and motorists.
