Special Traffic Arrangements for Pok Oi Charity Walk 2017 in Yuen Long

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic arrangements will be implemented in Yuen Long to facilitate the event of Pok Oi Charity Walk 2017 on 10 December 2017 (Sunday):

(A) Road Closures

- (I) The following sections of roads will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic (except for emergency vehicles and police vehicles) from about 9.00 a.m. onwards until completion of the event on 10 December 2017. The actual implementation time of road closure may be advanced if necessary.
 - (a) The section of Chi Ho Road between Castle Peak Road Tam Mi and Shui Tau Road.
- (II) The following sections of roads will be intermittently closed from about 9.00 a.m. onwards until completion of the event on 10 December 2017. The actual implementation time of road closure may be advanced if necessary.
 - (a) Yuen Long Kau Hui Road from its junction with Long Yat Road to a point about 140 meters north of the same junction (including the lay-by);
 - (b) Ng Wo Road;
 - (c) Long Wo Road;
 - (d) Siu Sheung Road; and
 - (e) Shui Tau Road.

(B) Traffic Diversion

During period of road closure, motorists on Chi Ho Road heading for Castle Peak Road – Tam Mi are advised to travel via Kam Hing Road and Kam Tin Bypass.

(C) <u>Attention and Appeal</u>

Actual implementation of and adjustments to road closure, traffic control and public transport services diversion will be made by the Police at the time depending on the prevailing circumstances, traffic and crowd conditions in the areas.

Appropriate temporary traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. Motorists are advised not to drive to the affected areas, and to drive with utmost care and patience and take heed of the instruction given by the Police on site.
