- (i) The section of Kai Hing Road between Lam Chak Street and Hoi Bun Road will be converted from one-way southbound traffic to one-way northbound traffic; and
- (ii) Lam Chak Street will be converted from one-way westbound traffic to one-way eastbound traffic.
