

## **TRAFFIC ADVICE**

### **Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements on Hoi Wang Road, Tai Kok Tsui**

Members of the public are advised that to facilitate Central Kowloon Route construction works, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from 11.00 p.m. to 6.00 a.m. on the following day daily on 27 January 2023 and 3 February 2023:

#### **(I) Temporary Traffic Arrangements**

##### **(A) Road Closure**

The road sections of Hoi Wang Road southbound between Lai Cheung Road and Yan Cheung Road will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic.

##### **(B) Traffic Diversion**

(i) Affected vehicles from Lai Cheung Road westbound heading for Hong Kong (West) via Hoi Wang Road southbound will be temporarily diverted via Hoi Wang Road northbound, Cherry Street westbound, Lin Cheung Road southbound and West Kowloon Highway southbound, before resuming to its original routing;

(ii) Affected vehicles from Lai Cheung Road westbound heading for Yau Ma Tei (West) via Hoi Wang Road southbound will be temporarily diverted via Hoi Wang Road northbound, Hoi Ting Road westbound, Hoi Ting Road southbound, Hoi Ting Road eastbound, Hoi Wang Road southbound, Lai Cheung Road eastbound, Ferry Street southbound, Canton Road southbound, Wui Cheung Road westbound, Wui Man Road northbound, Hoi Wang Road northbound and Yan Cheung Road eastbound, before resuming to its original routing;

(iii) Affected vehicles from Lai Cheung Road westbound heading for Tsim Sha Tsui via Hoi Wang Road southbound will be temporarily diverted via Hoi Wang Road northbound, Hoi Ting Road westbound, Hoi Ting Road southbound, Hoi Ting Road eastbound, Hoi Wang Road southbound, Lai Cheung Road eastbound and Ferry Street southbound and then following the existing directional signs for their destination;

(iv) Affected vehicles from Lai Cheung Road eastbound heading for Hong Kong (West) via Hoi Wang Road southbound will be temporarily diverted via Hoi Wang Road northbound, Cherry Street westbound, Lin Cheung Road southbound and West Kowloon Highway southbound, before resuming to its original routing;

(v) Affected vehicles from Lai Cheung Road eastbound heading for Yau Ma Tei (West) via Hoi Wang Road southbound will be temporarily diverted via Lai Cheung Road eastbound, Ferry Street southbound, Canton Road southbound, Wui Cheung

Road westbound, Wui Man Road northbound, Hoi Wang Road northbound and Yan Cheung Road eastbound, before resuming to its original routing;

(vi) Affected vehicles from Lai Cheung Road eastbound heading for Tsim Sha Tsui via Hoi Wang Road southbound will be temporarily diverted via Lai Cheung Road eastbound and Ferry Street southbound and then following the existing directional signs for their destination;

(vii) Affected vehicles from Hoi Wang Road southbound heading for Hong Kong (West) will be temporarily diverted via Lai Cheung Road eastbound, Ferry Street northbound, Cherry Street westbound, Lin Cheung Road southbound and West Kowloon Highway southbound, before resuming to its original routing;

(viii) Affected vehicles from Hoi Wang Road southbound heading for Yau Ma Tei (West) will be temporarily diverted via Lai Cheung Road eastbound, Ferry Street southbound, Canton Road southbound, Wui Cheung Road westbound, Wui Man Road northbound, Hoi Wang Road northbound and Yan Cheung Road eastbound, before resuming to its original routing; and

(ix) Affected vehicles from Hoi Wang Road southbound heading for Tsim Sha Tsui will be temporarily diverted via Lai Cheung Road eastbound and Ferry Street southbound, and then following the existing directional signs for their destination.

## **(II) Temporary Transport Arrangements**

### **(A) Bus Diversion**

To cope with the above traffic diversions, the following bus route will be diverted:

Route	Direction	Diversion	Bus Stop Location
Cross-harbour Route No. 914	Causeway Bay (Tin Hau bound)	Diverted via Lai Cheung Road eastbound, Ferry Street southbound, Canton Road southbound, Wui Cheung Road westbound, Wui Man Road northbound and Jordan Road eastbound, before resuming to its original routing.	The existing bus stops will remain unchanged.

Appropriate traffic signs will be erected on site to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above arrangements.
