

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Extension of Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Yau Tsim Mong District

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate Central Kowloon Route construction, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will continue to be implemented in Yau Tsim Mong District from 1.00 am to 6.00 am daily from 1 to 31 October 2022: -

(A) Traffic Arrangements

(I) Road Closure

The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (i) The section of West Kowloon Corridor southbound from its junction with Arran Street to its junction with Gascoigne Road Flyover southbound;
- (ii) The section of Gascoigne Road Flyover southbound from its junction with West Kowloon Corridor southbound to its junction with Chatham Road South;
- (iii) The section of Ferry Street southbound from its junction with Gascoigne Road Flyover southbound to its junction with Public Square Street;
- (iv) The slip road of Ferry Street southbound near Dundas Street leading to West Kowloon Corridor southbound;
- (v) The section of Gascoigne Road Flyover westbound from its junction with Gascoigne Road to its junction with Ferry Street;
- (vi) The slip road of Ferry Street southbound near Shek Lung Street leading to Gascoigne Road Flyover eastbound; and
- (vii) The slip road of Gascoigne Road Flyover westbound near Kansu Street heading for Yau Ma Tei.

(II) Lane Closure

The following traffic lanes will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (i) The section of fast lane on West Kowloon Corridor southbound between Yen Chow Street West and Nam Cheong Street;

- (ii) The section of fast and middle lane on West Kowloon Corridor southbound between Nam Cheong Street and Tai Kok Tsui Road;
- (iii) The section of middle lane on West Kowloon Corridor southbound between Tai Kok Tsui Road and Maple Street;
- (iv) The section of fast lane on West Kowloon Corridor southbound between Maple Street and Arran Street;
- (v) The section of middle and fast lane on Tong Mi Road southbound between Shantung Street and Dundas Street;
- (vi) The fast lane on Ferry Street northbound from its junction with Kansu Street to a point about 45 meters south of the same junction;
and
- (vii) The fast lane on Lai Cheung Road eastbound from its junction with Waterloo Road to a point about 45 meters west of the same junction.

(III) Traffic Diversion

- (i) Affected vehicles on West Kowloon Corridor southbound heading for Hung Hom will be diverted via Prince Edward Road West eastbound, Lai Chi Kok Road southbound, Nathan Road southbound and Gascoigne Road eastbound;
- (ii) Affected vehicles on West Kowloon Corridor southbound heading for Kowloon East will be diverted via Prince Edward Road West eastbound, Portland Street northbound, Yu Chau Street northbound and Boundary Street eastbound;
- (iii) Affected vehicles on West Kowloon Corridor southbound heading for Yau Ma Tei will be diverted via Prince Edward Road West eastbound, Lai Chi Kok Road southbound and Shanghai Street southbound;
- (iv) Affected vehicles on Ferry Street southbound near Shek Lung Street heading for Hung Hom will be diverted via Ferry Street southbound, Jordan Road eastbound and Gascoigne Road eastbound;
- (v) Affected vehicles on Chatham Road westbound heading for West Kowloon Corridor northbound will be diverted via Gascoigne Road westbound, Kansu Street westbound and Ferry Street northbound;
and
- (vi) Affected vehicles on Chatham Road South westbound heading for Kwai Chung will be diverted via Gascoigne Road westbound, Jordan

Road westbound and Lin Cheung Road northbound.

(B) Transport Arrangement

Bus Diversion

- (i) KMB Route No. N368 (Central (Macau Ferry) bound) will be temporarily diverted via Prince Edward Road West eastbound, Lai Chi Kok Road southbound, Nathan Road southbound and Gascoigne Road eastbound before resuming its original routing; and
- (ii) KMB Route No. N368 (Yuen Long bound) will be temporarily diverted via Gascoigne Road westbound, Jordan Road westbound and Hoi Wang Road northbound before resuming its original routing.

Appropriate traffic signs and road markings will be erected on site to guide motorists. The public transport operators will display notices to advise passengers of the above temporary arrangements.
