Temporary Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Yau Ma Tei

Notice is hereby given that to facilitate construction works of Central Kowloon Route, the following temporary traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in Yau Ma Tei at the periods specified below:

I. Traffic Arrangements

From 1.00 am to 5.30 am on 31 October 2021

(a) Road Closure

The following road sections will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic:

- (i) The section of Lin Cheung Road southbound leading to Tsim Sha Tsui and High Speed Railway Station from its junction with Jordon Road to a point about 800 metres north of the same junction; and
- (ii) The slip road of West Kowloon Highway southbound leading to Lin Cheung Road southbound.

(b) Traffic Diversion

Affected vehicles on Lin Cheung Road southbound and West Kowloon Highway southbound heading for Tsim Sha Tsui will be temporarily diverted via Nga Cheung Road southbound and Jordan Road eastbound.

From 5.30 am on 31 October 2021 to 11.59 pm on 30 April 2022

(a) Change of Road Marking

The solid-cum-broken line on Lin Cheung Road southbound leading to Tsim Sha Tsui, Yau Ma Tei and Hung Hom from a point about 210 metres north of its junction with Jordon Road to a point about 440 metres north of the same junction will be temporarily changed to double white line.

(b) Traffic Diversion

Affected vehicles on West Kowloon Highway southbound heading for Yau Ma Tei and Hung Hom will be temporarily diverted via Nga Cheung Road southbound and Jordon Road eastbound.

II. Transport Arrangement

Bus Diversions

To cope with the above temporary traffic diversion, the following bus routes will be temporarily diverted from their first departure on 28 October 2021 until 30 April 2022:
