

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT NOTICE

Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Central

Notice is hereby given that, to facilitate the celebration of Halloween on Lan Kwai Fong, the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented from 30 October 2015 to 1 November 2015 in Central:

(A) Traffic Arrangements

I. Road Closure

The following special traffic arrangements will be implemented depending on the crowd situation:

Stage I

The following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic from 6.00 pm on 30 and 31 October 2015 to 6.00 am of the following day daily:

- (a) the section of D'Aguilar Street between Wyndham Street and Wellington Street;
- (b) Lan Kwai Fong;
- (c) Wing Wah Lane;
- (d) Wo On Lane;
- (e) the section of Wellington Street between Wyndham Street and D'Aguilar Street; and
- (f) On Lan Street.

Stage II

In addition to road closure in Stage I, the following road sections will be closed to all vehicular traffic from about 8.00 pm on 30 and 31 October 2015 to 6.00 am of the following day daily:

- (a) the section of D'Aguilar Street between Queen's Road Central and Wellington Street;
- (b) the section of Wyndham Street between Glenealy and Queen's Road Central;
- (c) the section of Stanley Street between D'Aguilar Street and Cochrane Street; and
- (d) the section of Wellington Street between D'Aguilar Street and Cochrane Street.

II. Suspension of On-street Parking Spaces

All parking spaces, motorcycle parking spaces and metered parking spaces at the following road sections will be suspended from 5.00 pm on 30 and 31 October 2015 to 6.00 am of the following day daily :

- (a) the section of Stanley Street near D'Aguilar Street;
- (b) On Lan Street; and
- (c) the section of Wyndham Street between Arbuthnot Road and D'Aguilar Street.

(B) Arrangements for Public Transport Services

The following bus route diversions and bus stops arrangements will be implemented from about 6.30 pm on 30 and 31 October 2015 to 6.00 am of the following day daily:

(C) Illegally Parked Vehicles

Any vehicles found illegally parked within the precinct of the special traffic arrangements specified above will be towed away without prior warning and/or may be subject to multiple ticketing.

(D) Implementation

- (I) Appropriate traffic signs will be provided on-site to guide motorists.
- (II) Bus companies will display notices to advise passengers of the above public transport arrangements.
- (III) Actual implementation of the above road closures, traffic and bus diversions will be made by the Police at the time depending on conditions in the area.
- (IV) Motorists should exercise tolerance and patience in case of traffic congestion, and take heed of instruction of the Police.
