Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements in Cheung Sha Wan for Ching Ming Festival 2026

Notice is hereby given that the following special traffic and transport arrangements will be implemented in the vicinity of Saint Raphael's Catholic Cemetery, Cheung Sha Wan, from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m., daily, on 28 and 29 March 2026, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11 and 12 April 2026 in connection with Ching Ming Festival:

I. Special Traffic Arrangements

(a) Temporary Road Closures

Wing Ming Street and the unnamed road between Wing Ming Street and Saint Raphael's Catholic Cemetery will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic (except for hearses, vehicles taking part in funeral processions, vehicles access by Cemetery Staff, emergency vehicles, Kowloon Green Minibus ("GMB") Route No. 45M and vehicles with permit issued by the Commissioner for Transport).

(b) Temporary Traffic Arrangement

- (i) Parking will be prohibited in the section of Yu Chau West Street between Castle Peak Road and King Lam Street;
- (ii) Passenger pick-up or set-down will be prohibited in the section of Yu Chau West Street near Wing Ming Street (outside "83 Wing Hong Street"); and
- (iii) "No Stopping" and "No Parking" will be strictly enforced on Ching Cheung Road.

II. Special Transport Arrangements

(a) Designation of Temporary Taxi Stand

Two temporary taxi stands will be designated in Wing Hong Street near its junction with Yu Chau West Street.

(b) Relocation of Terminus of Kowloon GMB Route No. 42

The terminus of Kowloon GMB Route No. 42 in Yu Chau West Street will be temporarily relocated to the point outside house no. 550 Castle Peak Road.

(c) Suspension of stops of Kowloon GMB Route No. 45M on Wing Ming Street and Yu Chau West Street

GMB stops of Kowloon GMB Route No. 45M on Wing Ming Street and Yu Chau West Street will be suspended, affected passengers please use the terminus on platform of Caritas Medical Centre.

(d) Suspension of On-street Parking Spaces

All on-street parking spaces (including metered parking spaces, disabled parking spaces and motorcycle parking spaces) in Yu Chau West Street, Tai Nan West Street, section of King Lam Street between Yu Chau West Street and Tai Nan West Street and section of Wing Hong Street between Yu Chau West Street and Tai Nan West Street will be temporarily suspended.

Appropriate temporary traffic signs will be provided on site to guide motorists. Public transport operators will display notices to advise the passengers of the above arrangements. For access to the Cemetery, members of public are advised to use the subway across Ching Cheung Road from the end of unnamed road between Wing Ming Street and Saint Raphael's Catholic Cemetery. No parking facilities in the Cemetery will be open to public use, members of public are advised to use public transport to the Cemetery.
